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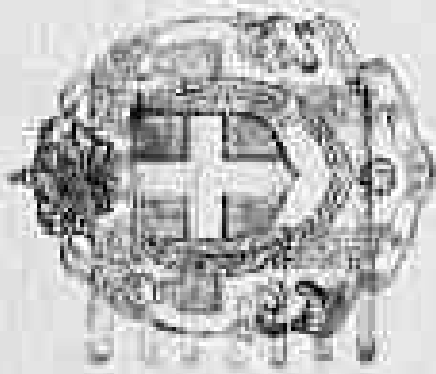

Reference is made to 6244/1/Q(Maint) dated 20 Dec 45.

A request has now been received for the release to the Italian Government of the Air Ministry Building.

This is required primarily to house the Italian Air Ministry which is at present distributed in various offices in ROME.

At the same time it is thought that the Air Ministry will not require the whole building and may be able to place some floors at the disposal of other ministries.

In the meantime the newly formed Ministry for Foreign Trade is in need of office accommodation and the provision of sufficient space elsewhere will present some difficulty.

It is understood that the British and U.S. Governments are deeply interested in this Ministry and HQ Allied Commission are requesting the provision of accommodation.

It is believed that the release of the Air Ministry Building would provide for the needs both of the Air Ministry and the Ministry of Foreign Trade.

Decision is therefore requested as to whether release can be granted.

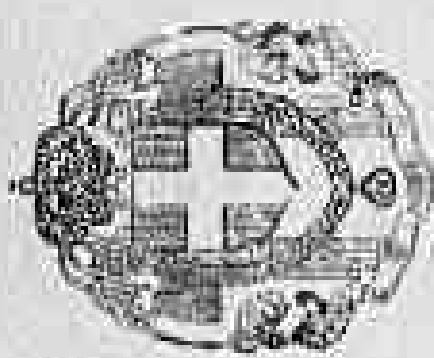
Authority to withdrawn furniture, in order to vacate the premises requested by the Allied Command.

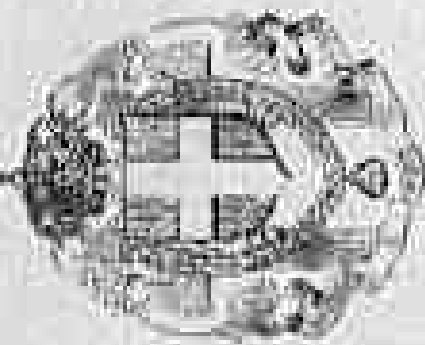

Dear Air Vice Marshal,

Your A.P.S.C. has recently requested my Ministry to empty 8 rooms in the Air Ministry building situated in Viale dell'Università.

While I can assure that 4 of the above rooms have already been cleared, I cannot but inform you of the great inconvenience which this request will cause in respect of the clearance of the other 4 rooms Numbers 268-306-308 and 316.

This is due to the fact that in these rooms are installed the heavy and voluminous archives comprising many publications and which are not transferable to another site owing to lack of accommodation of which you have already been informed.

On the other hand it concerns documents of great importance and delicacy which should necessarily be retained in a secure place.

I would be very grateful, dear Air Vice Marshal, if understanding the difficulties in which I am struggling as a result of the lack of accommodation, a lack which already impedes the functioning of the various departments of the Air Force, you would kindly re-examine the question in order that the 4 rooms might be left at the disposal of my Ministry, the numbers of which are mentioned above.

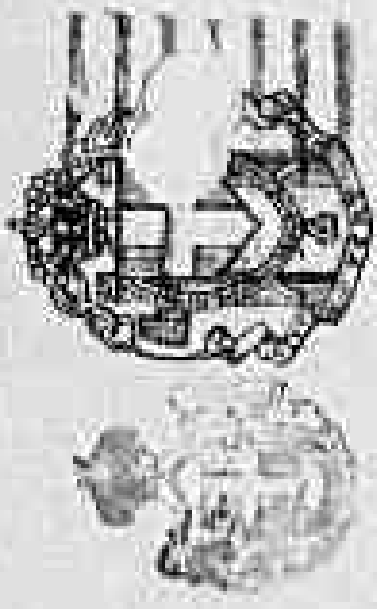
On 1st and 2nd November a senior English officer from M.A.A.F. attached to the advanced unit for the organisation of services at the old HQ of the Italian Air Ministry, visited the underground rooms among which are those in which are kept the various archives of the ex-Italian Air Ministry.

This officer pointed out that they had need of all the underground rooms there including those of the archives to use them probably for stores.

Since there are no other rooms vacant and if it should be necessary to move all the documentation, which is at the moment in process of being reorganised, there would arise the inconvenience of having to muddle up all the documents with the consequent impossibility of research.

This information is being sent to you so that the A.F.S.C. may approach the Department which is to take possession of the ex-Air Ministry in order to cancel the removal of the archives.

On the other hand it includes some most important and "delicate" correspondence which must, of necessity, be stored in a safe place.

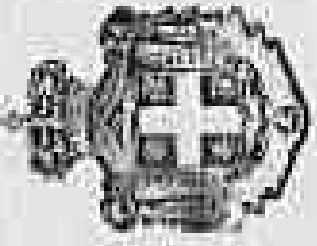

Memorandum

A request was made of this office on 29 October 1945, by the Real Estate Section, RAAC, to investigate the possible transfer of the publications division of the I.A.F. from their present location, in the I.A.M. Building, to new premises. AFHQ, in contemplating a move to Rome, requested that the printing facilities in this building be allocated to them, and RAAC had located a substitute printing press to which I.A.F. offices might be moved. This Sub-Commission was asked to investigate as to the difficulties which might be entailed by such a move and make recommendations from the Italian point of view.

A visit was made by the undersigned on 30 October to the present location. The officer-in-charge is Captain Mastrolanni. The plant is very large and extremely well-equipped. There are six linotype machines, thirteen printing presses of various sizes, a very complete stock of type faces, complete engraving and lithographing units, ~~and various other equipment~~ as well as facilities for binding of books and color printing. While it is difficult to put down accurate figures as to the capacity of such a plant, the equipment would, roughly, be sufficient for publishing a large daily newspaper of a circulation of well over 100,000 daily. The machinery is modern, in good condition and manned by competent, trained personnel. The only restricting feature on production is paper and ink shortages.

In view of this, it seemed that there was every reason for NOT moving the installation. Capt. Mastrolanni pointed out the following facts and suggestions:

- 1) He had previously handled all printing for the Austrian Allied Commission (former occupants of the building), as well as his own, and was confident that he could do the same for AFHQ. He expressed willingness to work his men overtime in order to accomplish this, rather than move. He showed commendations from the AAC to support this belief.
- 2) He said that there was one room which could be turned over to AFHQ entirely. This room, formerly used for printing classified documents, contains two linotype machines and one press.

Presently, this installation handles all I.A.F. printing in addition to numerous booklets and reports put out for other government agencies. The plant seems to keep busy, but is not overworked. There is only one shift, working from 0930 until 1400.

While I was unaware of the requirements of AFHQ, it seemed that there was no necessity of the I.A.F. moving. With such excellent facilities, and the willingness on the Italian's part to do extra work in order to prevent leaving, the case seemed strong. The fact that the Austrian AC had been accommodated proved ~~known~~ that it could be done. Logically, an organizing AC should utilize more printing than an established and diminishing headquarters.

A check with RAAC later in the day showed the substitute premises to be entirely too small and completely out of the question for the proposed transfer.

I then went to see the Real Estate Section at RAAC and pointed out our case. They agreed, but pointed out their position as being only the middle men. However, they promised to do what they could.

Upon the visit of the AFHQ parties involved, they agreed in substance to the plan put forth, that is, to leave the Italians as they are, to take over the small or confidential press room, call on the lithographing and engraving offices for only such small requirements as would be necessary, and to use the general press room as required. Knowing neither what is required or what can be done, it was extremely difficult to say exactly what per centage of the capacity this would be. But I have no doubt that it can be worked out.

Final details will be completed between AFHQ publications division and the undersigned and RAAC in the near future. I have made two more trips to the press to keep Capt. Mastroianni informed and he seems satisfied. The main point is, I believe, that ~~the press room is being used~~ in leaving the Italians in the installation, rather than having them move, put some men out of work, have insufficient accommodations for their own work, and go through the difficulty of again getting the plant back.

Finally, in case there is too much work to be done, the smaller press is being held in ~~reserve~~ reserve, and the possibility of running two shifts is being investigated.

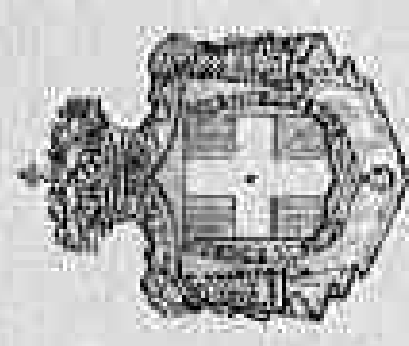

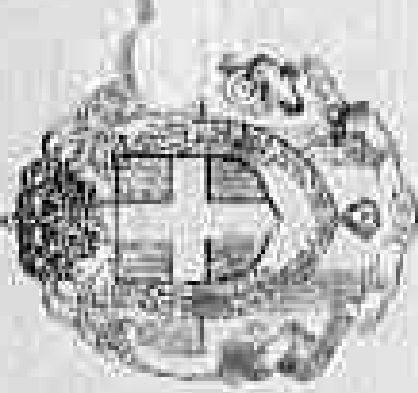

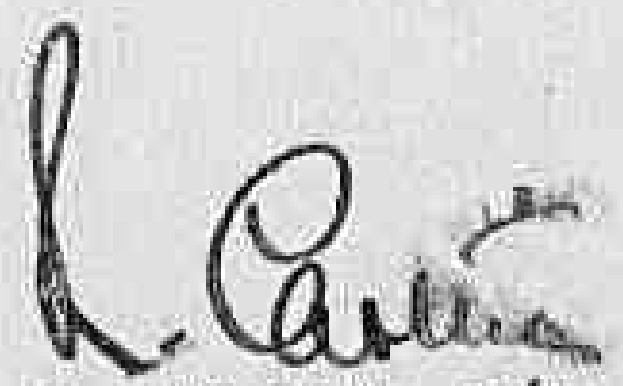

From the latest information which I have just been able to obtain it appears that you are unlikely to be able to get the proper Air Ministry building back for some time to come. I am sorry that this is so because as you know I am the first to realise that when various Air Ministry Departments are scattered about in ROME as they are now, co-ordination between Departments is not made easier.

2. In order to carry out your latest directives quickly and efficiently, the Air Ministry will have to take very considerable action so as to implement your instructions. At the present moment the Air Ministry is farmed out into 8 separate buildings in Rome covering a considerable area. It is impossible, therefore, to work quickly and to have full co-ordination between departments.

3. Apart from this the question has always been considered on a morale basis. The Italian Air Force knows perfectly well that the Ministries of War and Marine have managed to stay in their own buildings, and that they alone have suffered the sequestration of their Ministry. This is always at the back of their minds, and from personal experience I know how often it crops up in ordinary conversation with flying personnel in the units. This is something that we may find it rather difficult to understand, but with the Italian for some reason it does assume considerable importance.

4. I have had the building examined and find that it is virtually empty, and this waste of a large building comes in for a good deal of criticism. The Minister has promised that if he gets the building back he will be able also to house the War Veterans Association Committee, which is an important body, and may well have a considerable effect by its sober influence on the future of Italy.

5. I am unable to say whether the building is being reserved to accommodate any Allied H.Q. in the future, but I certainly feel that if this is being held in view, the question of the accommodation of the personnel would certainly cause enormous difficulties, as Rome appears to be almost full to overflowing at the moment.
