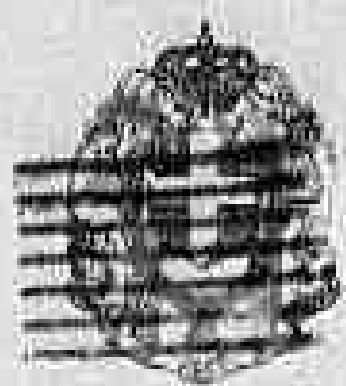

1. Attention is made to letter, NMIA, AG SD/201, subject: "Air Force Detachments on Duty with the Allies", dated 26 October 1946, and 1st indorsement thereto, your headquarters, AG 383.6 HP AXTC (26 Oct 46), dated 2 November 1946.

2. The Chief Commissioner, Allied Commission, has forwarded this correspondence to Allied Force Headquarters. He requests that an AFHQ policy be established to the effect that formations of the Italian Army, Navy and Air Force are to be placed under command of ITALIAN officers of their own service only unless otherwise directed by SACMED.

3. Your reasons for not wishing to make any change in the existing situation are not clear. It is not believed that the type of work being done by these units has any bearing upon the point at issue.

4. There are obvious advantages to maintaining a direct chain of command for these Air Force Units as described in NMIA's original letter.

5. However, before a decision can be made on this matter information is needed as to the effect on your command of altering the existing organization so as to establish this direct chain of command. Will you please provide this information.

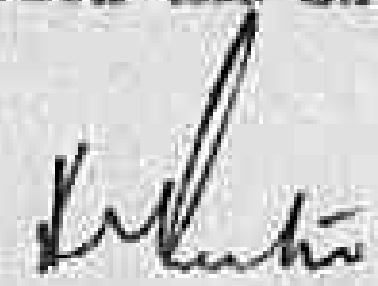

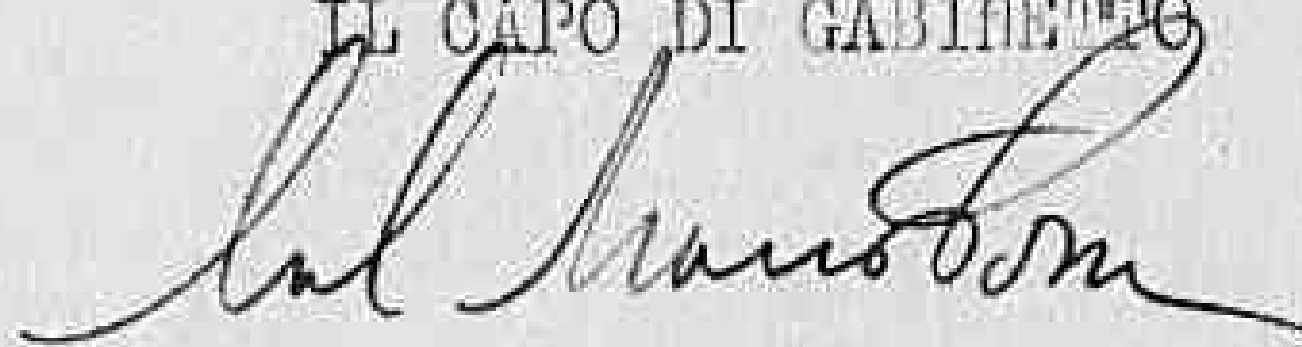

As verbally explained by Capt. Berarducci of this General Directorate we would like to inform you that:-

1. Since May 1946 an I.A.F. Unit composed of 14 Officers, 100 N.C.Os and 240 O. Rs have been serving with the American Air Base on Ciampino. These men have been employed in the various technical services of the Base, as shown by the following per centage figures in comparison to American personnel employed in the same services.

Military Police	64%
Firemen	85%
Commissariat	33%
Garage Technical Services	45%
Electrical Connections	33%
(Services) Works Section	45%
Telecomm. (Wireless Ofcs)	35%
Met. Services	41%

2. From the above it is possible to consider the importance the American Command at Ciampino attributes to the I.M.A.F. personnel.

3. As already brought to notice by Captain Berarducci, the position of the I.A.F. is not very clear in the eyes of the American General Headquarters. The latter, in answer to a request for material (tents, stores etc.) for distribution to Italian personnel (considering the coming winter season) replied that they could not do so as it did not know of the existence of the I.A.F. Unit on Ciampino to be on their strength.

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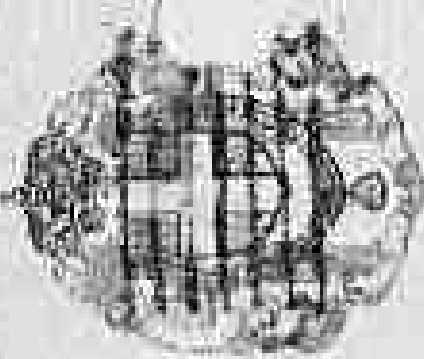

INSPECTION TOUR OF 4TH GROUP I.A.F. - FOGGIA

On the 20th September, 1946, Lt. Weiss and Lt. Favano made an inspection tour of the 4th Group I.A.F. stationed at Foggia. We found H.Q. and the surrounding area in excellent condition in view of the fact that the 4th Group H.Q. Company had only moved into their location in the first part of September. The Commanding Officer was anxious to help us and accompanied us on our tour of inspection.

After a visit in the H.Q. area we drove to Amendola to inspect the 3 (three) Italian Air Force Companies employed by P.B.S. (American). Accommodation were adequate and the major complaint made by the Italian Air Force Companies, concerned the drawing of fresh meat. ITI - ITI Units draw fresh meat four (4) times a week, while US - ITI Units draw only canned meat three (3) times a week. With the exception of this complaint every thing else seems to be satisfactory.

P.B.S. is also well satisfied with the present companies and their work. (Conversation with Major Stevens, P.B.S). No change in I.A.F. personnel stationed in the Foggia Area is contemplated at this time.

Reference my conversation with Capt. BERARDINI and several I.A.F. Officers regarding Italian Air Force Units working with P.B.S. at Leghorn.

2. The present position arose when U.S.A.A.F. C.D. was deactivated and all U.S.A.A.F. installations were taken over by P.B.S. for disposal. All Italian Military personnel were then turned over to M.T.O.U.S.A. and then to P.B.S. P.B.S. did not realize that some of these Units were Italian Air Force and not Italian Army Units.

A separate Liaison Group has been or is being established under Colonel SARTORI of the I.A.F. to coordinate all Italian Air Force Administration under P.B.S. Headquarters.

3. These I.A.F. Units are doing extremely essential work and P.B.S. HQs would appreciate that these arrangements continue. Approval is granted by this Headquarters.

4. The suitability of Colonel SARTORI as Commanding Officer is a matter for you to decide, the essential fact being that these I.A.F. Units will be self controlled, receive their instructions from P.B.S. direct and not through the Italian Army units at Leghorn.

5. Trusting these arrangements will be satisfactory to you and no further troubles arise.

On 2nd August, 1946 called on Lt/Col. Tasker of Auxiliary Troop Command at P.B.S. HQ. Leghorn pertaining to I.A.F. personnel assigned to them to find out how they were transferred to P.B.S.

Lt/Col Tasker stated that when N.A.F.G.D. was deactivated all A.A.F. installations were taken over by P.B.S. for disposal. All Italian military personnel used by N.A.F.G.D. were turned over to M.T.O.U.S.A.. These units were turned over to P.B.S. for urgently required guard duty.

P.B.S. accepted the air service units numbered from 1 to 41 not knowing there was I.A.F. units included in the number. Later discovered air service units numbering from 1 to 17 were ground Force units. Numbers from 17 to 41 were I.A.F. units. All these units were under the administration of Ground Forces.

Owing to the differences of administration between Military and Air Forces a separate Liaison Group under Command of Colonel SARTORI of I.A.F. is being established under P.B.S. Headquarters to co-ordinate all Italian Air Force administrations. To conclude, Lt/Col Tasker expressed the opinion that as these units are doing essential work, in most cases guarding A.A.F. equipment, H.Q., P.B.S. would appreciate that arrangements continue.

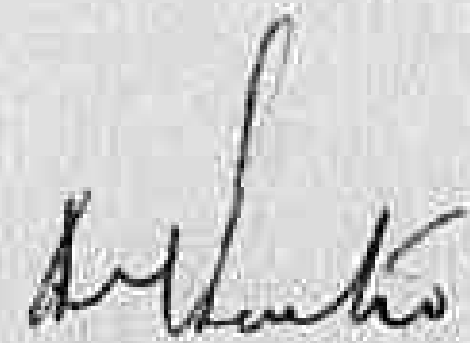

6. This Ministry suggests to create at Leghorn a Group or Battalion formed by I.A.F. personnel with the task of directing, administering and coordinating the activity of the 2 above mentioned Companies.

7. Our request is strongly recommended also in view of the forthcoming transfer to Leghorn of other two I.A.F. Companies.
