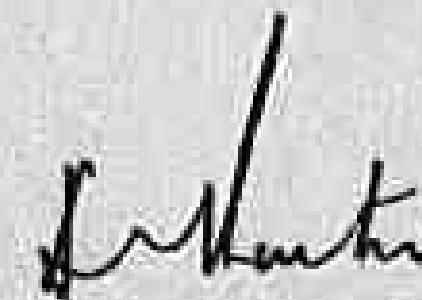

RECRUIT TRAINING.*Minutes of a Conference M.M.I.A representative attended.*

Recruits for I.A.F. : This question has now come to a head. Chief Staff of the Air Force sent a D/O letter to Cadorna to give weight to the Air Force's request that the Army train 5000 recruits for the Air Force at the forthcoming call-up.

LIUZZI negotiated the matter and arrived at the following compromise:

Army to recruit 1000 men for the Air Force and for this once to give them two months basic inf trg at CARs. This will be done after the first month of the new intake, when the men for the Central Schools have already left the CARs and the NCOs who were trg them are available to deal with the Air Force personnel. Liuzzi would have preferred to have been rid of the whole thing, but feels that some gesture of assistance must be made towards a sister service, and in exchange he has insisted that the airmen now in Falange Barracks at Bari (formerly assigned to the Air Force) be removed elsewhere forthwith, as the buildings are required for the C.A.R.

The 1000 Air Force recruits will probably be divided between the C.A.R.s at ORVIETO, AVELLINO and BARI. Liuzzi has also agreed to train Air Force NCO instrs at the Central Schools at a later date convenient to the Army.

Inf'd Liuzzi that MMIA would also have preferred the Army to be rid of the whole thing, but agreed on this limited measure of compromise. SMRE will commit the terms of the arrangement to paper and give a copy to MMIA for information. - A.F.S.C.

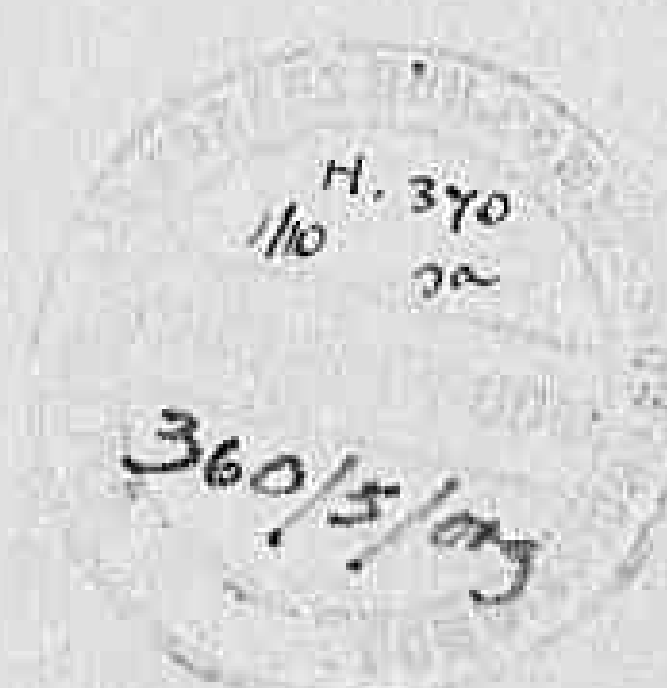

1. It is undesirable to allow the ITALIAN Army to undertake any activities in VENEZIA GIULIA West of the MORGAN line until the peace treaty is concluded. This area is at present under the jurisdiction of AMG.
2. It is similarly undesirable at this time to approach the JUGOSLAV government with a view to moving ITALIAN Army units from that part of VENEZIA GIULIA East of the MORGAN line.
3. It is regretted therefore that the Ministry of War must be informed that the request in their letter of 13 July cannot be granted.

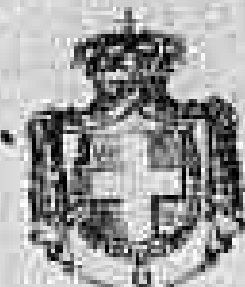

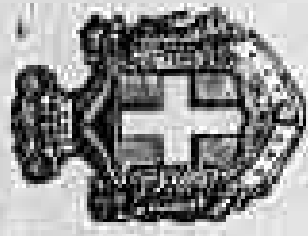

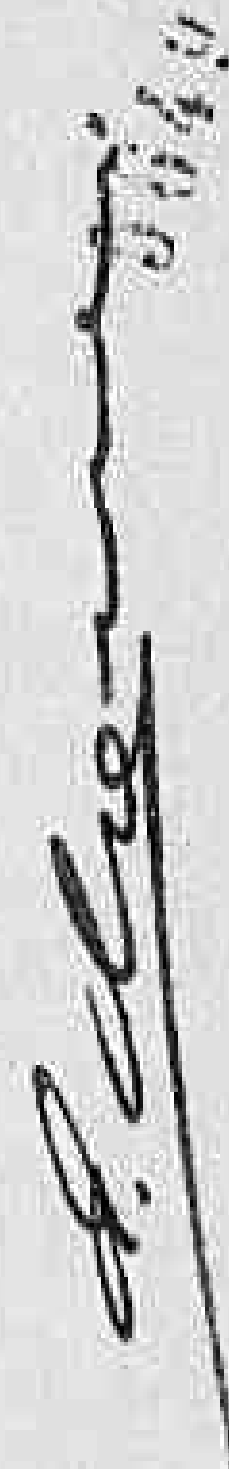

1. The Air Force Sub-Commission, Allied Commission, has requested authority for setting up of Italian Air Force CERSA and CERSETI units, similar to those detailed in MMIA letter SD/25 of 17 March 1945 and approved for the Italian Army by 15th Army Group cable SD/1399 of 27 March 1945.

2. Units will be self-contained except for POL and will consist of six (6) to ten (10) officers and NCO's with their own transport. Their duties will be as follows:

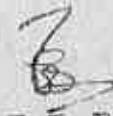

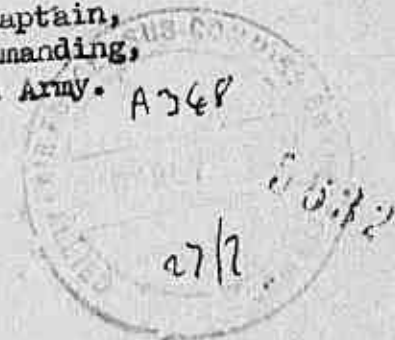

2. This HQ has no objection to the Italian Air Force personnel shown in above quoted letter, establishing an advanced Posto di Raccolta at Ravenna.
3. It should be noted, however, that prior consent of this HQ must be obtained before the establishment of such centres.
4. A copy of your letter has been forwarded to GSI(b) Main Eighth Army.
