Please consider our request with good will as this Establishment is in absolute want of a linotype machine, complete with its matrices, in order to carry on with the remarkable quantity of work caused by the unusual necessities of the Aeronautic Administration.

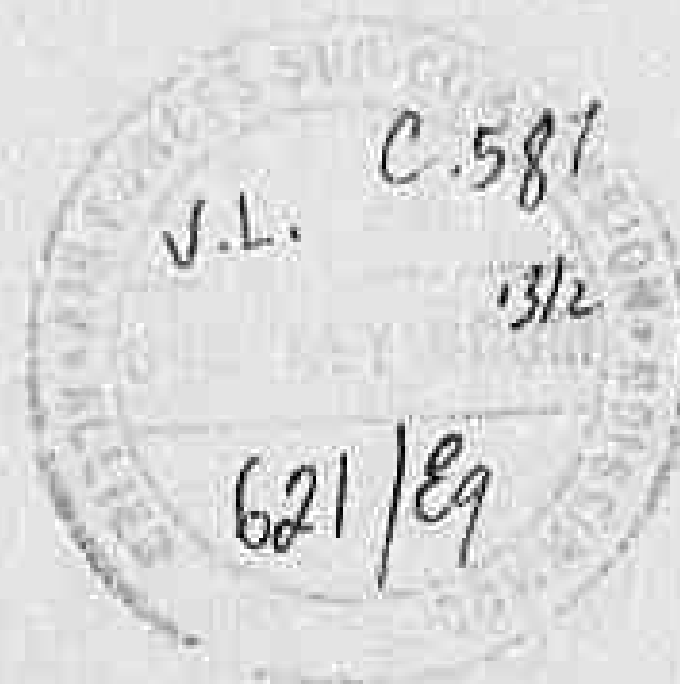

SUBJECT : Request for Leather Belts for Machinery.

For the operating of a stone crusher, needed for the construction of internal roads at LECCE Airport, the following leather (natural) belts are required :-

^{50th}
15 metres of belting 12 cms wide X ^{4 3/4"} 7-8 mms. (approx) thick.
^{50th}
15 metres of belting 5 cms. wide X ^{2"} 4-5 mms (approx) thick.

As all leather belting has been requisitioned by the Allies it is requested that this Sub-Commission authorize the issue of this material from Allied Stores, as the work at Lecce is of an urgent nature.
