REQUEST FOR D.D.T. POWDER AND AEROSOL CYLINDERS FOR THE FIGHT AGAINST
MALARIA.

1. The supplying of antilarvae substances, green Paris type or green Caffaro type, to be used in the campaign against malaria during this year, by the I.A.F. appears to be difficult under the present conditions.

2. It would be, therefore, essential that an adequate quantity of D.D.T. powder be supplied, as this has in general, as it is known, an insecticidal and antilarvae strength, as well as aerosol cylinders (aerosol piretrus) for the fight against malarial anopheleses to be used in malarial areas where an extensive fight against insects which carry the malarial parasite cannot be effected.

3. The above material is not available commercially as it is of Allied manufacture.

4. It would be, therefore, appreciated if your Sub-Commission could supply to the I.A.F. for the imminent beginning of the fight against malaria the following material:

100 kgs. of D.D.T. powder
1000 aerosol cylinders.

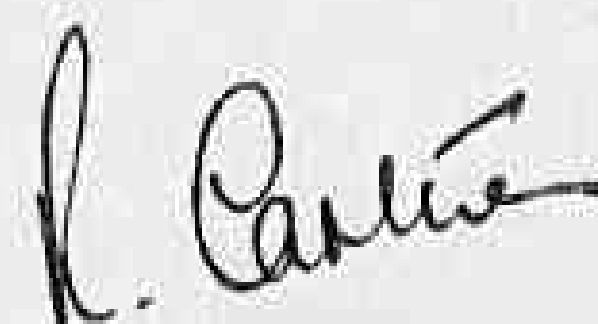

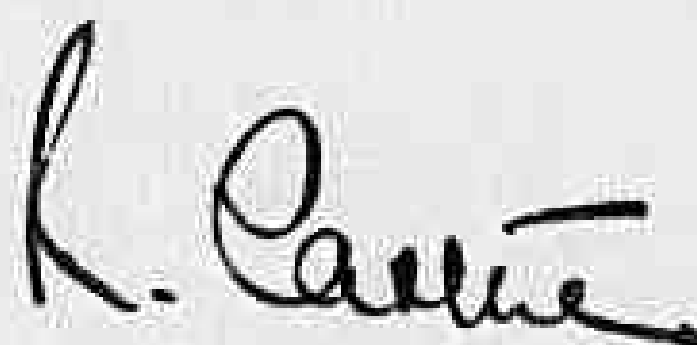

WASHING-SOAP

1. At the meeting held on the 18th of January at the Ministry of industry, commerce and work with the representatives of Military Ministries to establish which soap-manufacturing firms of Liberated Italy had to manufacture the necessary soap for the Italian Armed Forces, it appeared that the Allied Commission has undertaken to issue the necessary soda in the required quantities in order to enable the above-mentioned Armed Forces to obtain a sufficient quantity of soap for a monthly distribution of 300 gr. to every soldier.
2. Particularly should there be issued for 1945 to this Administration the necessary soda to manufacture 1.116 q. of soap, which means 3,600 kg. a year for 31.000 persons.
3. With this letter we are reminding this Sub-Commission that the quantities are now insufficient for all requirements, as this Ministry is not able to issue soap to infirmaries and hospitals and a larger amount that should be distributed to the specialists and personnel belonging to special services, in view of the 300 gr. of ration that should be delivered to each soldier for their own personal neatness and to wash their linen.
4. We are begging then this Sub-Commission to arrange to issue a sufficient quantity of soda, through the Ministry of industry, commerce and work, for the above-mentioned necessities, and so to enable this Administration to manufacture for this year at least 2.000 q. of washing-soap containing 60-62% of acid greasies.

2. Information is given that the Granili Paint Factory has been taken over by British Ordnance and that there is no civilian interest in the Factory.
3. Common paints only are manufactured and allocations are made to the Services, including the R.A.F., in proportion to output.
4. Demands for common paints and specialist requirements will therefore have to be raised on 114 M.F. and passed to this Headquarters for scrutiny in the normal manner.
5. In this connection it is mentioned that requirements will need to be confined to standard R.A.F. items and these will be issued according to availability.
6. It is noted that cty. 430 lbs. of Acetone are stated to be required monthly, whereas in reply to this Headquarters letter 214G/3323/3/65A dated 17th February, a M.I. return was rendered in respect of Units in the Naples area.
7. Before demands are raised for section 33B/548 Acetone, it is requested that the purpose for which this is demanded be given, as HQ MAAF Algiers letter MAAF/3.7317/1/AS dated 6 February copy to you, instructs that Acetone must not be used for removing dope from aircraft.
