- a. Under COSMED 251 the ceiling of the Italian Air Force was fixed at 34,000, of which the British were responsible for meeting the Allied Military Element of the ration for 27,000 and the U.S. were responsible for meeting the Allied Military Element of the ration for 6,500.

Present strengths which are being provided with the Allied Military Element of the ration are as follows:-

British	-	27,000
U.S.	-	6,500

Rations are delivered daily in bulk to Italian depots at TARANTO, and are thereafter an Italian responsibility.

RETURN OF EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES TO ITALIAN GOVERNMENT

1. Articles, stores, supplies, vehicles and other equipment that have been requisitioned from Italian sources will be returned, when no further need exists, to the Italian Government, in accordance with policies and procedures set forth herein.

2. The units holding such articles, stores, supplies, vehicles or equipment will comply with directives of services normally responsible for such items, in obtaining authority and instructions for making dispositions.

3. a. When it is established that there is no further need for the items, arrangements will be made by Areas/Base Sections for them to be delivered to the Collection Centers established by the Italian Direzione Lavori del Genio Militare at Italian Territorial Military Commands which are established at:

PALERMO (SICILY)
BARI
NAPLES
ROME
FLORENCE

GENOA
TURIN
MILAN

b. Motor vehicles will be delivered to the Ispettorati Compartmentali della Motorizzazione Civile in the following cities:

4. A receipt will be obtained from the Italian Direzione Lavori del Genio Militare/Ispettorati Compartmentali della Motorizzazione Civile for each item returned. The Italian Direzione Lavori del Genio Militare/Ispettorati Compartmentali della Motorizzazione Civile will be furnished with full particulars concerning the item returned, including the name or names of the person from whom requisitioned, together with a statement as to the status of any payments. Statements as to payments should include information as to any invoices or unpaid requisitions presented by vendor and forwarded to the Italian Government for payment.

AFHQ Administrative Memo #10 (cont'd)

5. Instances have occurred of units returning requisitioned items to the person from whom they were requisitioned. - This practice is irregular and will be discontinued. The unit remains accountable for the item and there is a possibility of the owner receiving total value payment in addition to the returned item. Units that have made such returns prior to issue of this memorandum will immediately report full facts to formation, area, or base section headquarters, so that status of the item may be regularized.

6. Receipts will be obtained and records maintained and distributed in accordance with directives of the respective services (US and British).

7. Allied Commission will be responsible for maintaining a central record of the reports made by the services as to the items or the value of the items returned to the Italian agencies.

8. When requisitioned items which are no longer required, are installed in factories or other premises which are about to be derequisitioned, and such items are not a part thereof, they will be disposed of in accordance with policies herein either by:

a. Removal to Collection Centers.

b. Leaving on premise, with notification to Comando Genio Militare and Italian Direzione Lavori del Genio Militare/Ispettorati Compartimentali della Motorizzazione Civile at the time the premises are derequisitioned.

9. This Administrative Memorandum does not apply to real estate.

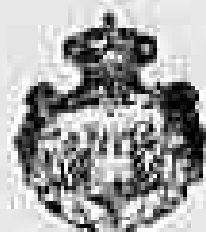

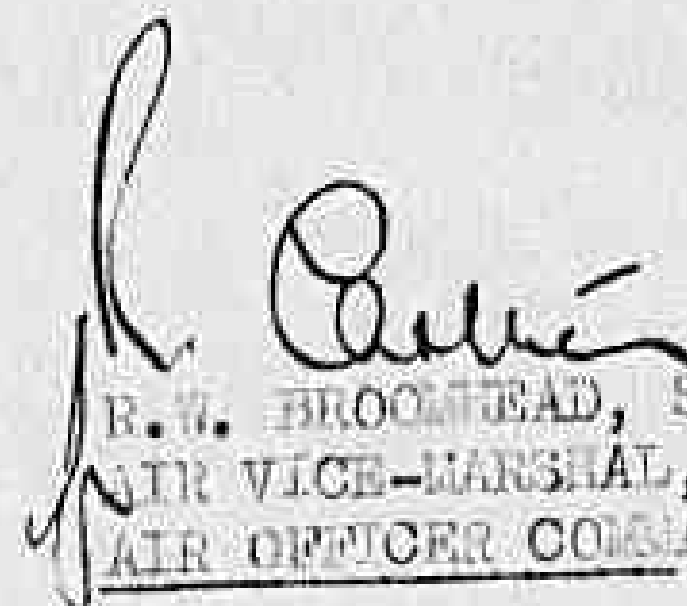

PROCEDURE DEMANDS FOR MATERIALS.

- 1)- So as to obtain a more rapid and secure assignment for the R.A., of the indispensable materials for their needs, the previous dispositions issued for the demands of material from the R.A. to the A.F.S.C. are particularly modified as written in the following paragraphs.
- 2)- The Allied burocratic organization has only one section that provide material and equipment. In accordance with the same system to this organization, it has been found necessary to start on the same grounds for the R.A.. The collection of all demands are gathered together by the R.A. and AFSC. thus avoiding uncertainties, guide and delays. Will provide an easier procedure, offer guarantees for a faster supply of materials and at the same the logistic functions of the R.A. will have to provide a more sensible advantage.
- 3)- This agreed upon, looking at the circumstances that all the material that is usually demanded to satisfy directly or indirectly the necessities of the supplied Units, it has been disposed temporarily that all the demands would be sent to the Intendenza of the UNITA, AFSCA. This Intendenza, so as to complete with the attributions imposed for it, forwards:-
 - a)- Gathers, authorizes and coordinates, forwards to the AFSC. all the demands of material of the UNITA, AFSCA.
 - b)- Forwards to the AFSC. all demands of the sections of the Ministero that are forwarded by this Stato Maggiore so that these may be checked and examined.
 - c)- Provides to furnish the demands forwarded to the Intendenza, of all possible explanations so as to avoid that the Sub-Commission may have to take them in consideration for the different defects or elements of valuation.
 - d)- Making certain that the materials demanded does not exist in the R.A. Stores (though this has to be previously seen to by the Unit demanding).

e)- Has full control over the material supplied, so as to secure disposal to the demanding sections for priority and urgency.

f)- Compiles and adjourns a comparative situation of the supplies obtained and those demanded, in a way that every new demand may be accompanied by an exact illustration as given in the above mentioned. Communicates monthly to the S.M. the return of the situation in question.

4)- This formula is the new procedure to be complied by all the Offices of the Ministero with the exception of the Direzione Costruzioni (works and buildings) for which we are showing a particular procedure, whenever they have to demand material from the Allies or Italian material that is blocked by the Allies. They will have to make their demands in triple copies of the attached form No 1 as mentioned in para. 3, letter "(b)".
