2. This equipment must be destroyed immediately or anyhow made unserviceable for air warfare as it is not authorised for use by the I.A.F.
3. It is requested that confirmation may be forwarded to this Directorate and to the above Units when the destruction of the material in question has been completed.

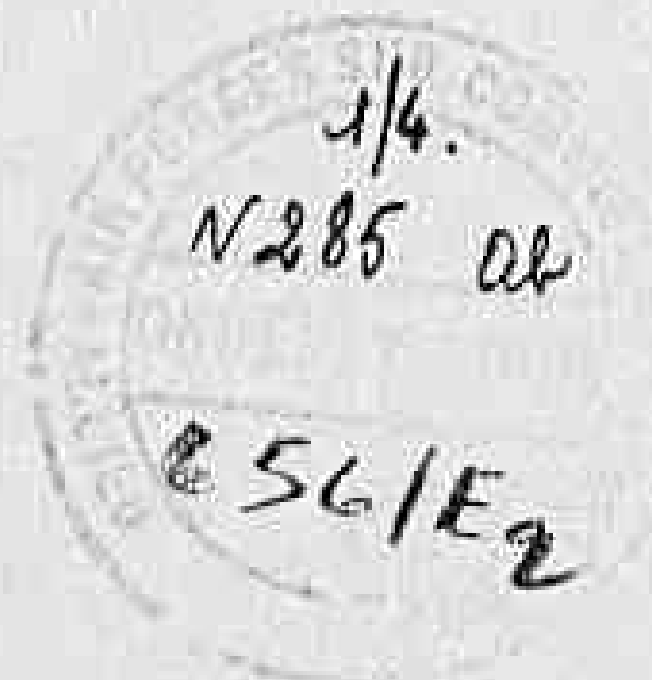

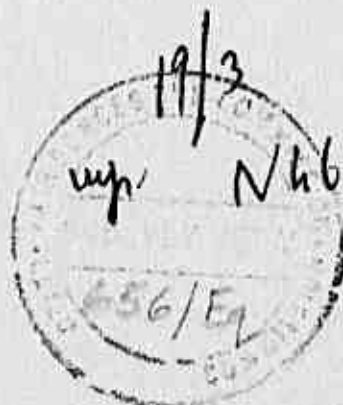

ARRANGEMENT OF TERRITORIAL STORES FOR COMMISSARIAT MATERIAL
1st Z.A.T. MILAN.

1. The present arrangement of the Territorial Stores ~~for~~ for Commissariat material of the 1st Z.A.T. (Milan) appears to be badly organised as the stores are subdivided between Gallarate and Milan.
2. A part from the duplication of the guard duty and general services in respect of the two above locations it is also noted that these premises are without installations required for the running of the Stores (laboratory for analysis, tailor's workshop, laundry).
3. As the main Commissariat Stores of the 1st Z.A.T. were detached before at Taliedo, in the premises - that appear in good condition - at the present moment occupied by the Allies and U.N.R.R.A. it would be much appreciated if your A.F.S.C. would kindly ask the Allied office concerned to return these premises to the Aeronautical Administration, in order to make possible a definitive arrangement of the Commissariat Stores in question.
4. We should like to point out the particular necessity for the availability of the above articles bearing in mind the fact that some fixed installations which were constructed either for the analysis laboratory or for the laundry are still in good condition (as conducting pipes, exhausts pipes, drying chamber etc.) and immediately available in place of those which with considerable economic disadvantage we should have to construct afresh on the premises ^{as} previously mentioned do not offer satisfactory final arrangement of the Commissariat Stores of the 1st Z.A.T.
5. We count very much upon the action that you will be kind enough to take with the appropriate Allied Authorities.
