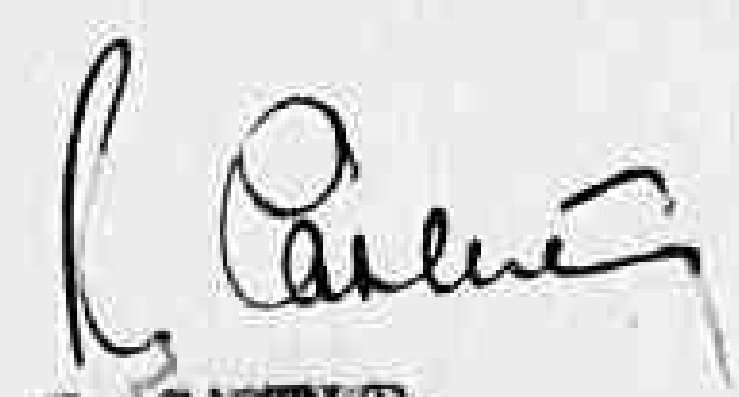

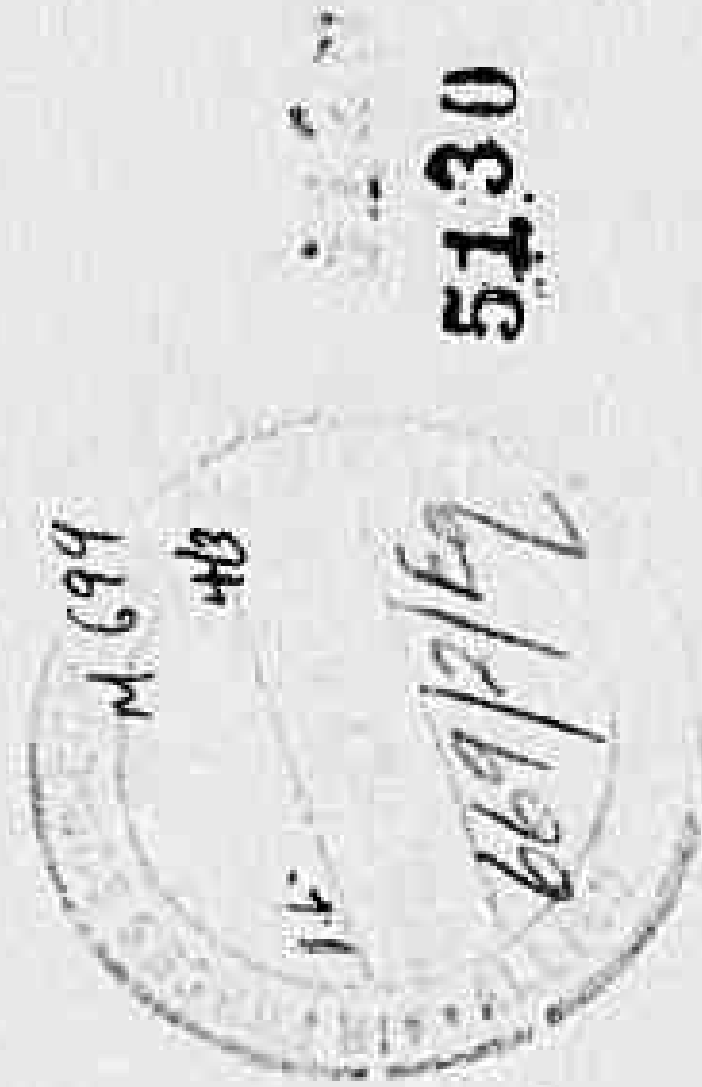

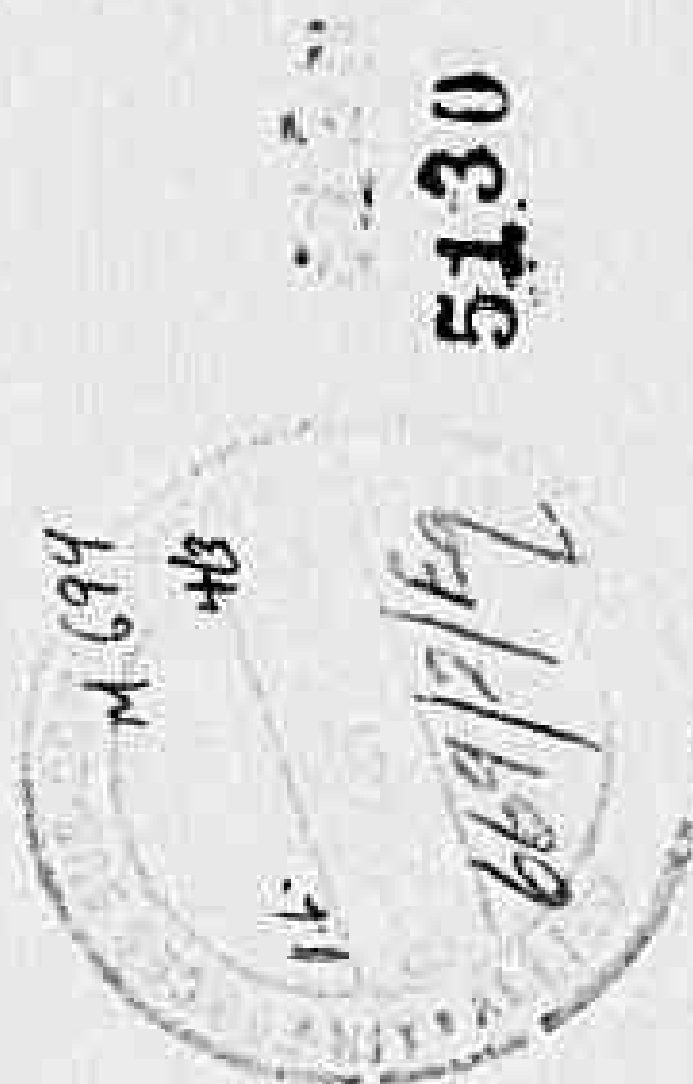

AVIATION PETROL STORAGE - FROSINONE AIRFIELD

1. With reference to your letter 50607/TEM/3155 Coll. dated 25th May, 1945, it is notified that it was not the intention to attempt to put the whole petrol storage installation into original working order. All that is required is to make bulk storage facilities available on FROSINONE airfield to avoid unnecessary road journeys to NAPLES.
2. The A.F.S.C. liaison officer at FROSINONE has stated that if the two storage tanks were cleaned out and sealed petrol could be pumped out by hand. If there is any difficulty in the way of this proposal would you please inform this Sub-Commission. Alternatively it is requested that action may be taken to have the work carried out as requested in our letter of 15th May.

PROSINONE - E.O.I. DEFOT

With reference to letter AFSC/669/2/24, dated 19th May, 1945.

This Directorate is aware of the existence of two tanks, under-ground, which could be made serviceable on the Airport, in question. Such tanks, therefore, have not got the security and distribution installations; and it has resulted, after investigations made, that these cannot be supplied in the territory of Central Italy.

The above-mentioned tanks, therefore, cannot be used until the necessary security installations will be supplied from Northern Italy, where this Directorate will search as soon as possible.

Aviation Petrol Storage - Frosinone Airfield.

1. Owing to the inadequacy of the aviation petrol storage facilities at Frosinone airfield a large number of unnecessary road journeys have to be made to Naples to collect petrol by road.
2. It has been reported, however, that there are two bulk storage tanks on the airfield which could be taken into use if these were properly cleaned out and sealed.
3. In order to effect greater economy in the use of transport and to provide better refuelling facilities at the Training School it would be appreciated if arrangements could be made to have the two tanks referred to above cleaned out and made serviceable for the storage of aviation petrol.
4. Your confirmation is requested.
