We have read on the "Corriere" of the 1st inst. that you are interested on the constructive possibilities of the Italian industries.

We want to draw your attention to the Firm we represent:-

Their particular activity was the manufacture of aeronautical precision instruments (electromechanic equipment), many of their own patent, having also a section specialised for the construction of models of electric ~~apparatuses~~ apparatuses of precision for the "Aeronautical Centre for Research and Experimentus". This Section is under the direction of Ing. Algeri Marino, who is well known also by the British H.Q. of the R.A.F.

This Firm is equipped with all the necessary sections for the manufacture in bulk of electric products of precision, with hundreds of very modern machines, and a department for fitting.

The Managers and workers have a high technical knowledge and experience.

They can have in normal periods 1500 workers in their premises in Milan and Lainate.

At present this firm is working only for a third of its possibilities and is constructing the automation switchboard "Siemens".

#### CONSTRUCTIONS IN ITALY OF BRITISH PATENTED MACHINES

Considering the present situation and the difficulties for commerce with foreign countries (difficulties which would last for a long period) our Firm "A.
