



Herewith please find copies of letters without reference, dated the 1st of September, 1945 from Maj. General C.A. HEIDMAN and the letter No 30630 dated 31st December, 1945 from the General Staff of the I.A.F. - Office "I" in regard to /Or PIRISINO GIUSEPPE.

According to the letter of the Allied Military Command the airman died in military operations against the Germans while under the orders of this Command.

The letter from the General Staff announced him to be posted as a deserter by the Commission for I.A.F. personnel.

It is requested that you may clarify this matter with the Allied Office who were the originators of the above mentioned letter; this with a view to ascertain the facts and the actual fate of PIRISINO.

Meanwhile he will have to be shown as having fallen as an "ad honorem" member of the partisan movement.

This change of status will bring about the liquidation of the dependant's allowance normally paid to the family of personnel killed "On Active Service".



REPATRIATION OF ITALIAN P.O.W's EMPLOYED BY THE BRITISH
METEOROLOGICAL SERVICE IN EAST AFRICA.

A further urgent request for the repatriation of Italian personnel at present working for the British Met. Service in East Africa has been received from the Director of the Italian Met. Service.

2. The last correspondence on this matter took place in May, 1946, when the Chief Met. Officer, H.Q., MHD/ME, requested that arrangements be made for the rapid return of these meteorologists to Italy, and we were informed that they would all be in Italy by August. Since that time nothing further has been heard.

3. I earlier (in April, 1946) had a conversation with Wing Commander Chambers in Cairo, when it was arranged that Met. P.O.W's would have priority for repatriation.

4. The commitments of the Italian Met. Service to International Air Traffic are becoming increasingly heavy and the presence of Met. personnel trained in allied methods will increase the efficiency of the Met. facilities provided at the main Italian airfields. It is requested that everything possible be done to get these personnel back to Italy.

5. A list of the personnel concerned is attached.

2. After the liberation the Italian Met. Service was organised and is now operating for national as well as international purposes.


