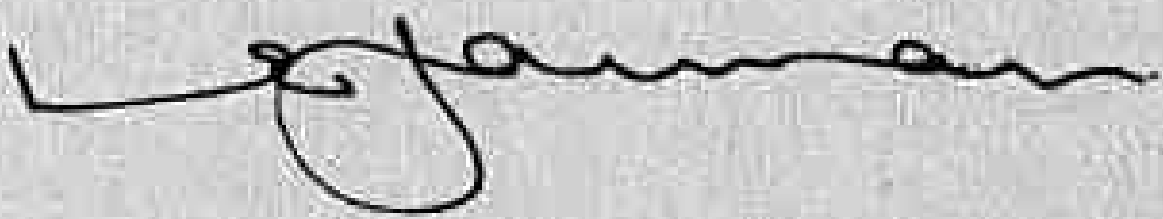

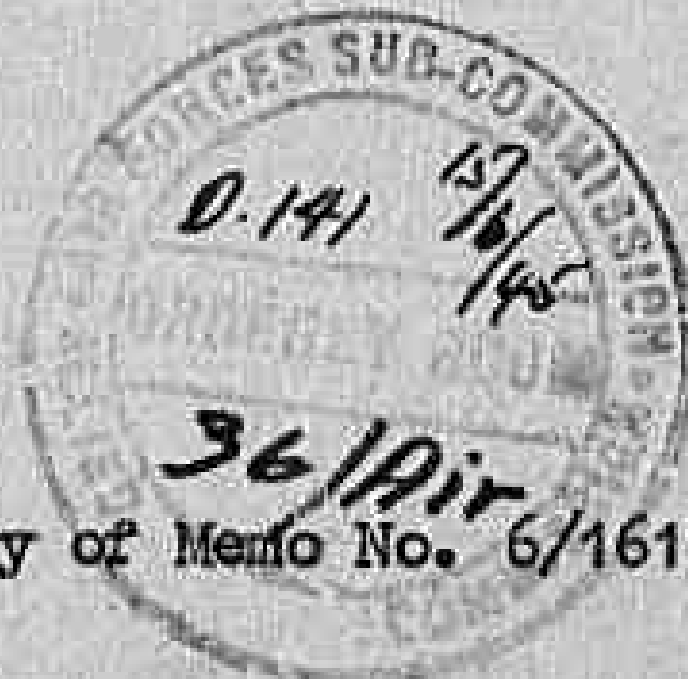

SUBJECT: Repatriations from Switzerland.

1. The Italian Legation at Bern informs that the Swissair is arranging the voyage from Zurich to Rome of a plane of which also some families of repatriation officials would avail themselves.

2. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs would be very grateful if the Allied Commission would kindly interest the competent Authorities in granting the authorization for the flight of the plane over northern Italy which has already been requested by the Italian Legation at Bern to that American Legation.
