SABIAN 202 AIRCRAFT No MM 52156.

Reference is made to your letter A/370425/ST.3/28/1684/Call. written as long ago as the 3rd April 1946 in which you requested news as to the whereabouts of the above mentioned aircraft which you reported as having landed on Rivolto airfield on the 28th May, 1945. After a telephone request from your office a few days ago asking that this matter be looked into, the Air Staff have searched through the previous correspondence on the matter and ascertained that although the British Air Forces were asked to give all news which they might have concerning the Sabian no definite information was forthcoming.

2. Steps have now been taken with Air Headquarters Italy to locate the missing aircraft but it is felt that in view of the fact that the landing was made over two years ago and enquiries made one year ago were fruitless, it is not expected that the whereabouts of this aircraft will come to light.

3. Any information which this office receives will be passed to you immediately.
