Reference is made to your letter IMAS/360/ORG/A.P. dated 7th Feb., 1947, regarding your request to follow the instructions received from the Allied Supreme Command on the retirement of military personnel from zone 'A'.

2. As from October, 1946, this office had instructed the Intelligence Section to see that the number of IAF personnel authorized to remain in zone 'A' (2 Officers and 4 ORs) be increased.

3. It is therefore requested that the following IAF personnel be assigned to zone 'A' to carry out Welfare Activities.

4. It must also be taken into consideration that the above-mentioned requests have been made according to the clauses contained in the Morgan Agreement, which are now no longer in force due to the "Peace Treaty" signing.

SUBJECT : Italian military personnel in Venezia Giulia.

Further to letter 200740/II dated 12 inst. regarding the a/m subject.

1. The Udine Military Territorial Command has informed us that, possibly, during the first days of February, they will forward proposals and lists of military personnel, as requested by you with letter 028 A dated 3/12/46.

The delay is due to the necessity of having to carry out an accurate selection of the personnel to be left there.

2. From the agreements made between the Military Territorial Command of Udine and the Allied Authorities, the a/m Military Territorial Command has obtained the impression that the question of limiting the number of military personnel in Trieste to 10 officers and 25 NCOs has been overcome.

In fact, during the meeting held in December 1946, the American Colonel Beard of AMG Finance, ordered that an estimate (for the year 1947) of the expenses for the personnel in all the civilian and military offices in the area, be made. All the personnel under the command of the AMG (in reserve or released) and of the military offices has been included in said estimate and up to the present moment no objections have been made.

3. Further information will be forwarded as soon as the lists, mentioned in para 1 above, arrive.

SUBJECT : Personnel of the Italian Armed Forces in Zone "A" of Venezia Giulia.

Further to letters 232634/II, 200740/II and 202025/II of 23 December 1946, 12 January last and 4th inst respectively; in reply to letter 54 A of 4th inst, relative to the subject in question.

1. Instructions already issued to Udine Military Territorial Command for the immediate withdrawal of officers and NCOs on active service in Zone "A" of Venezia Giulia have been confirmed today.

The officers and NCOs of this category who will remain on the spot for the functioning of the Italian Military offices, will immediately be transferred to the release category.

2. As stated in letter 202025/II of 4th inst, the delay in the carrying out of the instructions previously issued is due to the need to effect an accurate selection of the personnel to be left on the spot and the difficulty for Udine Military Territorial Command to carry out the instructions in the area of Zone "A" of Venezia Giulia.
