Italian Air Force Personnel employed by the Allies who are entitled to draw rations and equipment from Allied units are those personnel who were part of the original British-Italian (Br-Iti) and U.S.-Italian (U.S.-Iti) units authorized under the Armistice. These units were originally located in Sardinia but were brought to the mainland as Allied Forces moved north. Their authorized strength was 2,500 Br-Iti's and 6,500 U.S.-Iti's.

3. Any units activated at a later date and attached to R.A.F. or American units are not (R) not entitled to draw rations and equipment from the Allies but are supplied by the I.A.F.
