On March 1st 1947 a visit was paid to R.A.F. Ciampino by Col. De-Vincenti and W/Ldr Ray in order to inspect the radio equipment and to decide what facilities would be handed over to the I.A.F.

2. It was decided that the H/F D/F, V/T Point-to-point and Telephone exchange would be taken over and manned exclusively by the I.A.F. by May 31st 1947.
3. To ensure that this could be done Col. De Vincenti agreed to send sufficient I.A.F. personnel to Ciampino as soon as possible to work in conjunction with R.A.F. personnel in order to learn the operation and maintenance of the equipment.
4. No I.A.F. personnel have as yet reported to Ciampino and some concern is felt at the delay.
5. It is requested therefore that the necessary I.A.F. personnel be instructed to report to R.A.F. Ciampino as soon as possible.
