NOTE VERBALE. NO. 21248/107

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has the honour to inform the Embassy of Great Britain that on June 8th of this year the British aircraft G-AHK landed on the airfield of Rio al Serio and that the captain of the aircraft in contravention of the regulations in force, refused to appear before the authorities of the airport.

2. Since the regulations in force, apart from making possible the necessary functions of the customs and police, are designed to secure the proper working of the ground services in the interests of the aircraft, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs would be grateful if the British Embassy would draw the attention of the competent authorities to the fact that, in the interests of these services, the normal relationships between the captain of the aircraft and the authorities at the airport should be observed.
