London in which her son was declared a prisoner. The official files have no trace of a Lieutenant, but a Sub-Lieut. Carlo Degli Angelis, who was declared missing in letter 3222 dated 14/1/44 sent to the Cesena Podestà together with letter 1/2370/3064 dated 30/5/44 for forwarding to the parents of the officer.

Up to the present, no further news has reached us regarding Degli Angelis nor the rest of the crew.

We have received a letter from an Italian woman in Cesena enquiring about her son whom she believes to be a prisoner of war, but from whom she has had no news. It appears that the man in question, (Pilot) Lieutenant Carlo Degli Angeli, was shot down in an air battle between Syracuse and Cape Passero in Sicily during the night of 16th July, 1943. About the middle of August 1943 he was announced as a prisoner by B.B.C. London. Since then his mother has heard no more of him. He belonged to the 20th Squadron of the 41st (Bomber) Group which was at that time based on Lecce. The remainder of his crew were as follows. Second Pilot, Luigi Tabacco, Mechanic, Angelo Ceffa, Wireless Operator, Leopoldo Nobaldelli, Air Gunner, Mario Alliedo.

2. While there does not seem to be much hope that Degli Angeli is still alive after four years of silence, we feel that in view of the B.B.C. announcement giving him as a prisoner of war, it may be worth making enquiries. We should be grateful therefore if you could send this letter on to the appropriate department of the Air Ministry, asking them, if it would be more convenient, that they should reply to us direct.

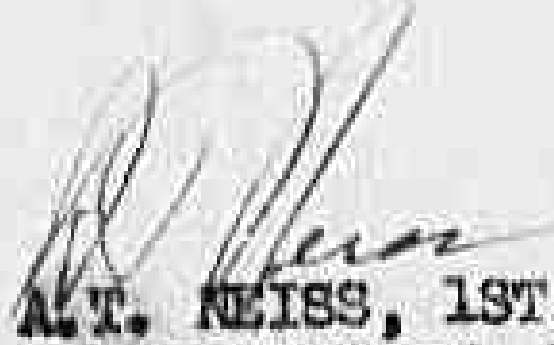

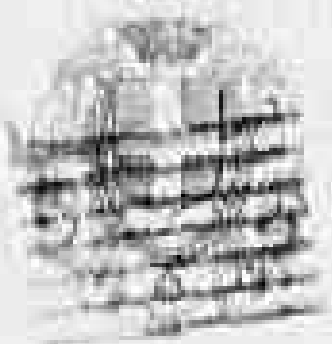

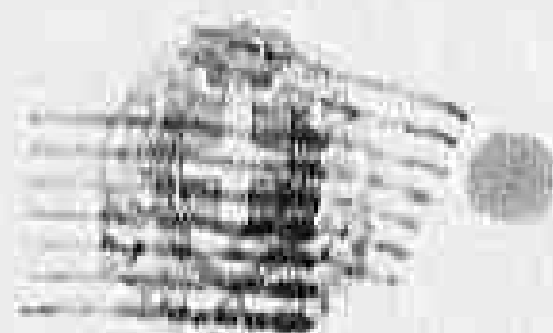

I am afraid I have no knowledge of the case of PERISINO as I only joined General Heydeman's Intelligence Staff in December, 1945. I cannot imagine, however, that General Heydeman's Intelligence Staff would have asked him to sign a letter on behalf of anyone without having been assured by the Allied Screening Commission, or some similarly responsible organisation, that the facts on which the letter was based were correct.

S/Ldr. Salter in his letter to the War Office AFB/914/1/P4 dated 25 March 1947 appears to assume that the fact of PERISINO being a deserter and the fact that he was killed while working for the Allied cause are mutually exclusive. This is not necessarily so; and from the evidence I should be strongly tempted to assume that PERISINO deserted from the Italian Air Force and was recruited for some Allied organisation, which was running covert activities in enemy territory.

The Allied Screening Commission could have helped you but I understand it has now disbanded. Full records should, however, be available at the War Office. It is conceivable that PERISINO was working for the Americans, and you may wish to initiate a parallel enquiry through their channels.

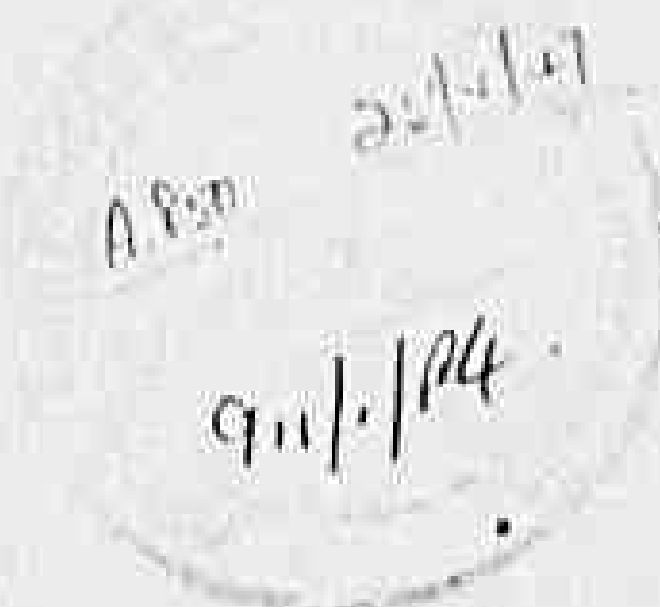

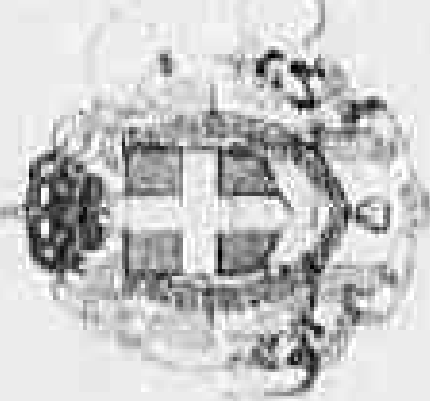

IDENTIFICATION OF CASUALTIES.

1. Further to our letter of even reference dated the 11th March, 1947; your minutes MEDME/4010/APLS of the 7th February and the 7th March, 1947 refer.
2. We have now received a report from our Searcher Party in respect of the casualty about whom the Reverend Luigi Vercesi is enquiring.
3. Apparently a single engined aircraft crashed at S. Pietro (M.R.331230, Sht 59, Italy I/100,000) on the 30th July, 1944. The pilot baled out but his parachute did not open effectively and he died soon after impact; his machine burnt out.
4. The Germans removed the personal effects from the body and informed the Municipio that it was that of an American named TOMMY HAIN and that the aircraft was numbered 226673.
5. An American Graves Registration Unit examined the body on the 7th July 1945 for re-interment at MIRANDEOLA, their receipt for the body refers to an 'Unknown American'.
6. In the opinion of our Searcher Party Officer there is no doubt that this casualty was a member of the United States Air Force, the exhumation N.C.O. was also quite satisfied on this point.
7. The Reverend Vercesi apparently removed a watch from the body which also bears the name HAIN; no doubt he wishes to return this to Hain's next of kin. It is therefore suggested that you contact the American authorities asking them if they can assist you in your enquiries.
