Reference your 77/7 Coll., dated 2nd January, 1947.

2. The above-mentioned Aviere was captured in Addis Abeba on 6th April, 1941 as 1^o Aviere in the I.A.F. and was sent to a P.W. Camp in Kenya.

3. On August 14, 1943 he was released to civilian status and went to Somalia to work for Azienda Elettrica di Vincenzi, Mogadishu, which is a private enterprise and not a P.W. Camp.

4. He is now a civilian at liberty and there is nothing to stop him being repatriated if he so desires.
