GLIDER CONSTRUCTION AND FLYING IN ITALY.

With reference to your letter AF90/53/1/Air dated 14th Nov. 1945, we notify you the details concerning what requested in para 2 of the above mentioned letter.

The gliders existing at to day's date in Italy are the following;

- N. 7 gliders of the type "Asiago" with numbers: 30111 - 30112 - 30113 - 30114-30115-~~30096~~ - 30098, which are at Milan at the Experimental Gliding Centre of the Politecnico, Mila.
- N. 1 glider of the type "AL. 12 P" N. 508 and
- N. 10 gliders of the type "Canguro" under construction at the CO. Ltd. Aeronautica Lebaria at Cento*.
- N. 1 glider of the type "CAT TM 2" at the CO. Ltd. Construzioni Aeronautiche at Taliedo (Milano).
- N. 1 glider under construction at the Aircraft model School "Pietro Sacilotto" at Pordenone.
(The ribs of the wings have been ended). The construction has been suspended further to the prohibition of the A.M.G. The said School is waiting for authority from the Allied Authorities in order to carry out the project.

CIVIL AVIATION IN ITALY

Permissive authority for running of Italian internal civil air lines has now been granted by the Combined Chiefs of Staff and notified to the Italian Government. The regulation of commercial aviation in Italy will henceforward be the responsibility of the Italian Air Ministry (Department of Civil Aviation), but all projects which may be brought to your notice should be submitted to this H.Q. for information and such action as this H.Q. may consider necessary.

2. The above-mentioned authority does not cover gliding, club or private flying which are still prohibited by the terms of the armistice.


- (a) There shall be no Italian civil aviation, non construction of transport gliders or aircraft engines pending the attainment of power to be laid down by the Peace Treaty. (The only exception to this ruling refers to firms specifically authorized by ASAC to complete certain work specially approved.)
- (b) Aircraft glider and engine contractors are to be informed that no permission for new construction can be given in the immediate future and that all work not specifically authorized as stated in (a) above must cease forthwith.
2. It is requested that Regie Aeronaute take steps to communicate this instruction to all firms engaged upon aircraft constructions in Italy, and to see that the decision is implemented.

It is recommended that the following decisions have been received from the Combined Chiefs of Staff:

- (a) There shall be no Italian civil aviation, nor construction of aircraft gliders or aircraft engines pending the statement of policy to be laid down by the Peace Treaty. In his presentation that the Air Ministry in Rome would like to have appointed Perrin in his position. The matter was submitted to the Local Committee of Liberators, but they did not object to the appointment of Capt. Perrin on the grounds that:

- 1) He was politically compromised.
 - 2) He has no service.
 - 3) His personality gives nothing about abilities, although he has a strength who has an outstanding reputation in the field of aviation.
- As a result of these objections, and upon the recommendation of the C.I.A., Colonel Sartorius was appointed to the position.
- The Project is not satisfied with Colonel Sartorius' abilities, stating that he has always discovered that his political knowledge, while a teacher of war in Germany was very unsatisfactory and further that his lackeys are very unreliable.

Italian Aircraft Construction.

Careful consideration has been given by his/her authority to a request for the construction of further SM.95s; it is however regretted that authority cannot yet be given for this work to proceed. It is requested therefore that you inform S.A.I.A. and that should they have begun work on more than the prototype civil and military versions of the SM.95 they are to cease work on these additional aircraft pending further instructions from the Allies.

2. I have also been instructed by higher authority to impress upon you that the Combined Chiefs of Staff have ruled that there is to be no Italian civil aviation nor construction of Italian aircraft pending a firm policy being laid down in the Peace Treaty.

3. As regards the construction of Italian aircraft where authority has already been given to you by this Headquarters this ruling does NOT mean that the construction of those aircraft which have been authorised is to be stopped but I think it would be as well for you to inform all firms which might sometimes request further construction that no such permission to build new aircraft will be given in the immediate future.
