TO: EXECUTIVE COMMISSIONER.

Reference minute 8 it appears that although the numbers awaiting trial in the Italian Air Force compared to those in the Italian Army are considerably less, we are informed by the Italian Air Ministry that the period over which personnel await trial is anything from six months to 12 months; from about 15 to 20 cases are tried per month. It seems, therefore, that it is the general law machine of the country which need investigation, rather than any one Service.
