I am sorry that I have not had the opportunity of coming down and saying good bye personally before I go, but I would like to take this opportunity in thanking you for your sympathetic help and cooperation in assisting me in the job that I am about to leave.

When his employment commenced he was informed
by 94 area that all necessary arrangements had
been made with the I.A.F. at Naples & his release
should eventually be obtained through them w/c.f.
the date he ceased to be employed by the British
Army.

The Naples I.A.F. however stated they had no record
of his having been authorised by the I.A.F. to serve
with the British army & gave his release date as 31.5.44.

He saw Col. Rizzo - 5^a Legione Liva e Matricola
who accepted his claim & wrote to Naples but
Naples still refused to pay.

They state that he reported to Major Sheridan Russell, of No. 1 B.C.I., at Centocelle airfield near Rome on 15th January 1945, for a special mission in occupied Italy; and that he was assigned to this duty following a verbal request made through the Air Forces Sub-Commission to the Italian Air Ministry.

3. Since that date no further news of him has been received by either the Italian Air Force authorities or his own family.

4. There is no trace of the assignment amongst our records, and it is requested that if your Office, or the second addressee, has any information concerning Sgt. Major RICCOMINI, we may be notified.
