Dear Ellery:

This acknowledgement your letter of 4 July regarding Major DeGaid and Captain Hammond. I will pass on your views to General Millering. If Captain Hammond is available without replacement, I will ask that he be sent down.

I received in the same mail with your letter a long letter from Colonel Newton. Apparently it had been indicated to him that I had inquired into his activities, which I am afraid he took somewhat amiss. I am writing him a personal letter to straighten the matter out. I gather that Major Ward Perkins was the individual who did us the favor of mentioning the matter to Colonel Newton.

I wired you today on the changes in the Subcommissions. These seemed to me a decidedly good move from the organizational standpoint and they will clean up the record of the Subcommissions somewhat. I discussed the changes informally with the SAC and with the two Ministers, all of whom approved. You may not know that we have been fighting off repeated and very real attempts on the part of SHAEF to get Boarding away from us. I wrote yesterday to General McHenry explaining the importance of Boarding to your area and asked that he be left alone.

I presume that the reason for the delay in the confirmation of your promotion is the fact that Congress is in recess for the convention. I hope that they get back and discharge this bit of business very promptly. You need the rank more than ever now.

4377 I hope to get over your way before very long, possibly a week or in advance of our permanent move.

SUBJECT: Organizational and Personnel changes within the Economic Section.

Pursuant to our conversation regarding certain adjustments in the organization of the Economic Section, I hereby request your approval of the following changes.

Industry and Commerce Sub-Commission: It is apparent that with the Northern areas of Italy about to be liberated, the potential development of Commerce is so important that it should be separated from Industry and be established on its own as was contemplated in the original organization chart. Its basic function is to stimulate the flow of consumer goods and other end products both for domestic consumption and for export. Industry, on the other hand, will point directly to the production of these goods. With this in view I request your authorization to set up two Sub-Commissions as follows:

- a) Commerce Sub-Commission
- b) Industry Sub-Commission

I further request your authorization for the following staff changes to take effect immediately.

Colonel W.S. Evans be appointed Director of the Commerce Sub-Commission.
Major W.E. Scotten be appointed Deputy Director

Dear Chuck:

1 A lot of things have happened since I saw you last. The big news for me was to learn from the State Department News Bulletin, and subsequently from newspapers from home, that the President had sent my name to the Senate on June 5th to be Rear Admiral while serving as Deputy Head of the Allied Control Commission. However, the Senate appears to have recessed for a period so I'm not certain when my confirmation will come through. It is certainly needed now that I'm serving as Acting Chief Commissioner in General MacFarlane's absence. I understand that General Devers and Admiral Hewitt both sent off messages this week pressing for my early appointment.

2 With Henry Grady returning and with my taking over my new job, there are some changes that he and I would like to make. I am of the opinion, however, that it may be necessary to secure certain approvals and the purpose of this letter is to ask you for procedure in obtaining them.

3 For some time, we have rather felt that Colonel Adams (A), who acted for Henry Grady in his absence, would do a better job in the field of transportation which is his civilian occupation

PERSONAL AND CONFIDENTIAL

6 These appointments would have the added advantage of increasing the number of American Sub-Commissions, since of the present 21, 14 are British, 6 are American, and one (Finance) is joint.

7 By other point is with reference to Lord Stansgate. He received news last night that his son, an RAF officer, was killed and he requested permission to be with his wife. I granted him leave to the U.S. on compassionate grounds. As you know, the General and others have for some time felt that the job was too much for a man of his age, much as we all like him personally. While he is away, I am appointing Col. Upjohn (Br) as Acting Head of the Economic Section, making Colonel R. H. Wilmer (A) Acting Director of the Legal Sub-Commission.

7 Although I realize that Lord Stansgate was a political appointee, I should like very much to have these appointments made permanent. Upjohn is an excellent man, gets on well with both Americans and British, and I am certain can do the job. There would be the added advantage of making one more Sub-Commission American if Dick Wilmer were made the permanent director of the Legal Sub-Commission.

8 I have discussed these appointments and proposed appointments with Henry Grady who is in complete accord. Since this is urgent, I should appreciate your comments either by return mail or by dispatch ("eyes only").
