Please give following message most immediately to Field Marshal Alexander from Macmillan.

Begins.

The Chief Commissioner informed me this morning that as a result of the decision to entrust the greater part of the American sphere of Austrian occupation to SHAEF, an order has been received by General McNarney to send immediately to SHAEF 124 U.S. officers originally belonging to A.C./A.M.G. for civil affairs. These fall into four groups.

(a) 39 officers attached to Fifth Army and 2 to the Eighth Army for Allied Military Government purposes as the army moves forward.

(b) 37 officers belonging to Allied Commission who will be dropped off by the army as it moves forward for A.M.G. work in forward areas.

(c) 36 officers transferred to the permanent planning staff for Austria and now in the Naples area.

(d) 10 officers similarly transferred but temporarily made available to A.C. and now employed in Italian Government territory, rear regions, and H.Q. A.C.

2. A suggestion has been made that SHAEF's needs might be met for the time being by surrendering officers in (c) and (d) but retaining for Italy those in (a) and (b). The Chief Commissioner and I are very alarmed at the effect upon the carrying out of the order as received by MFOUSA since it would destroy the whole plan which has been made for the occupation of Northern Italy. It would be a major disaster.

3. The British and American Ambassadors who were present at this meeting are naturally not concerned with the military side but are gravely preoccupied with the political ill effects which would follow from this decision. You know how worried we all are already about the political dangers in the North of Italy upon liberation.

4. Would you consult with General McNarney and see whether he will agree to the proposed compromise measure and send an agreed telegram to the CCS from yourself and him setting out the position and asking urgently for reconsideration of the order. It is not within my province, but I cannot help feeling that SHAEF could produce additional bodies, especially from those originally allocated for work in France.

5. I feel that you have a right to take a position since the ultimate responsibility for law and order and efficient administration in Northern Italy rests on you.

Memorandum of telephone conversation during evening of Saturday, 3 February 1945, between Brigadier General R.E. Hume, speaking from Parco Hotel, Naples, and Col. Alfred C. Bowman, speaking from Headquarters Emilia Region. (Prepared from memory the following morning but believed to be substantially accurate.)

(There was considerable difficulty in making the connection.)

Gen. Hume: Bowman, this is General Hume. Can you hear me?

Col. Bowman: I can hear you quite well but you may have difficulty hearing me. This is not a very good instrument.

Gen. Hume: Bowman, we have been having a conference down here and I am going to do the same job on the American side in Austria as Con Benson is doing on the British side. I would like you to be my Number Two. How do you feel about it? You remember we talked about you before as my Chief of Staff and possible successor in the Fifth Army.

Col. Bowman: I am willing to have my name considered but I wonder whether the people at A.C. have been consulted about it.

Gen. Hume: I heard the first part and then I heard you say, "I wonder", but I couldn't hear the rest. . .

(At this point the connection deteriorated and balance of conversation was relayed through operator.)

Col. Bowman: Ask General Hume who, in a general way, have participated in the conference.

Operator (after a pause): He says he has talked to all the top people, but not to Admiral Stone.

Col. Bowman: Tell him that, as I said, I should be glad to be considered but do not feel that I can say "yes", unequivocally, without talking to the people I am working for now.

Operator (after a pause): He says he will present the matter and will call you later when he gets back to his headquarters.

Col. Bowman: To whom does he say he is going to present the matter?

Operator (after prolonged pause): The General has gone off the line and I cannot get Naples again now.

Col. Bowman: Thank you.

EXTRACT**I - ESTABLISHMENT OF UNITED STATES GROUP CONTROL COUNCIL (AUSTRIA)**

1. In compliance with the provisions of JCS 1169/2, subject: "Planning for Military Government in Austria," dated 16 December 1944, and of JCS 1169/3, subject: "Acceptance by the United States of Zone of Occupation in Austria," dated 25 December 1944, and Message WX-83322, there is hereby established a US nucleus planning staff designated as the US Group Control Council (Austria).

2. The Commanding General, Mediterranean Theater of Operations, U.S. Army, assumes command of the US Group Control Council (Austria).

3. Brigadier General LESTER D. FLORY, 012320, USA, is designated as Acting Deputy USGCC (Austria), and is charged with the following mission:

a. Developing, for approval by the Commanding General, MTOUSA, detailed plans for:

- (1) The organization, personnel, and equipment requirements of USGCC (Austria).
- (2) The requirements of army, navy and air disarmament, demobilization and related agencies to be employed in the US zone of occupation.

b. Acting as the Theater Commander's agent in carrying out liaison with the US Delegation on the European Advisory Commission with respect to the development of US policy in Austria.

c. Developing, for approval by the Commanding General, MTOUSA, policies consistent with those of higher authority which will give effect to US views with respect to Austria and which will serve as the basis for US negotiations and conversations.

d. Coordinating with Military Government planning agencies at AFHQ the preparation of plans for initial functioning of elements of the USGCC (Austria) introduced into Austria during the period of the Supreme Allied Commander, Mediterranean Theater's responsibility.

e. Liaison with the Allied counterparts of the US Group and with USGCC (Germany).

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SECRET**General Orders #21 (cont'd)**

4. To facilitate initial planning and to maintain close liaison with the European Advisory Commission, with the Allied counterparts of the staff referred to in paragraph 1 above, and with the USGCC (Germany), the US Group Control Council (Austria) will be located temporarily in London at a place to be designated by the Commanding General, ETOUSA. Liaison will be maintained with this Headquarters.

5. General Flory will report periodically to the Commanding General, ETOUSA. The assistance of the General Staff at this Headquarters will be available to him in formulating plans for the organization of the USGCC (Austria) and in the procurement of the necessary facilities and personnel therefor.

6. With the concurrence of the Commanding General, ETOUSA, General Flory is authorized to deal directly with the Commanding General, Communications Zone, ETOUSA for accommodations, personnel, and equipment to the extent available. Such additional personnel as may be needed will be requested from this Headquarters.

TO : Headquarters, Allied Commission, APO 394 (12 copies)

1. Previous letters on the above subject are brought up to date by this letter which is in confirmation of verbal arrangements with HQ A.C.

2. It is now the policy that only a very small nucleus of the G-5 Staff shall be assembled at this time. The remainder of the staff will be earmarked now in order that they may be available to be "called up" with the minimum of delay. Appendix "A" shows in Col(a) those officers who have been selected for initial planning. Col(b) shows those officers who have been earmarked for future planning requirements or details of appointments for which officers are to be earmarked.

3. Personnel requirements of the GAUE of AUSTRIA which are a British responsibility are contained in Appendix "B". None of the GAUE personnel will be assembled for the time being. It may however be necessary to assemble part of the Military Government Staff of the GAUE (Serial 2 Appendix B) at an early date.

4. Personnel for the GAUE (including the British element of the GAU of VIENNA) will however continue to be earmarked under the following headings

(a) Those required for initial GAUE planning and to be available at 14 days notice. Names of officers selected will be forwarded to G-5 AFHQ as soon as possible. Any subsequent amendments will be notified to AFHQ immediately they occur.

(b) Remainder of the personnel to fill the GAUE establishments. Names will be earmarked now as far as is possible under the following categories

(i) Those whom you could release at any time on 14 days notice

(ii) Those whom you could release at any time after the completion, or the virtual completion of the occupation of N. Italy.

(iii) Those for whom a replacement would be required.

A list of those officers who have so far been selected will be forwarded to G-5 AFHQ by 21 Nov. Thereafter additions and amendments will be notified as at the last day of each month, or when specially called for.

5. It must be appreciated that no guarantee can be given that an officer will be finally selected for the particular appointment for which he has been provisionally earmarked. This applies in particular to the GAU of VIENNA for which it is expected that a limited number of officers well qualified for a post in that GAU may be available from other sources.

6. It is the policy that new officers should continue to be sent to Allied Commission and thus make available experienced officers for release for duty in AUSTRIA. It is accepted that A.C. Italy which is a going concern, can take some untrained officers as replacements for those released for AUSTRIA which requires the very best that are available.

G-5 agree that we can make no further plans until we know the Establishment laid down in Austria planning and the numbers coming from U.K., but in an emergency I should recommend to you that we pick up Southern Region almost in toto and move them as a Region in the wake of 8th Army.
