Rear W-56780 of 3 November.

Selection of suitable person for position of Vice President Economic Section Allied Commission is in my opinion of paramount importance in view of responsibility of the position and future economic problems in relation to ITALY on which he will have to advise. There will include such economic problems as those which will arise in northern ITALY, planning for first aid to Italian economy, rapid transfer to full Italian Government operation of distribution of food and supplies and reestablishment of Italian export trade.

I consider that in fairness to the Allied Commission and to the Italian Government it is imperative that the man selected should be an outstanding administrator experienced in international trade. He should preferably be an outstanding industrialist.

Mister MACMILLAN and I have discussed this question and the matter has been taken up with the U S Political Adviser. We hope that we shall be given the opportunity of considering possible candidates. Mister MACMILLAN hopes to go to WASHINGTON during the course of this month and would like the opportunity of discussing the matter with you personally.

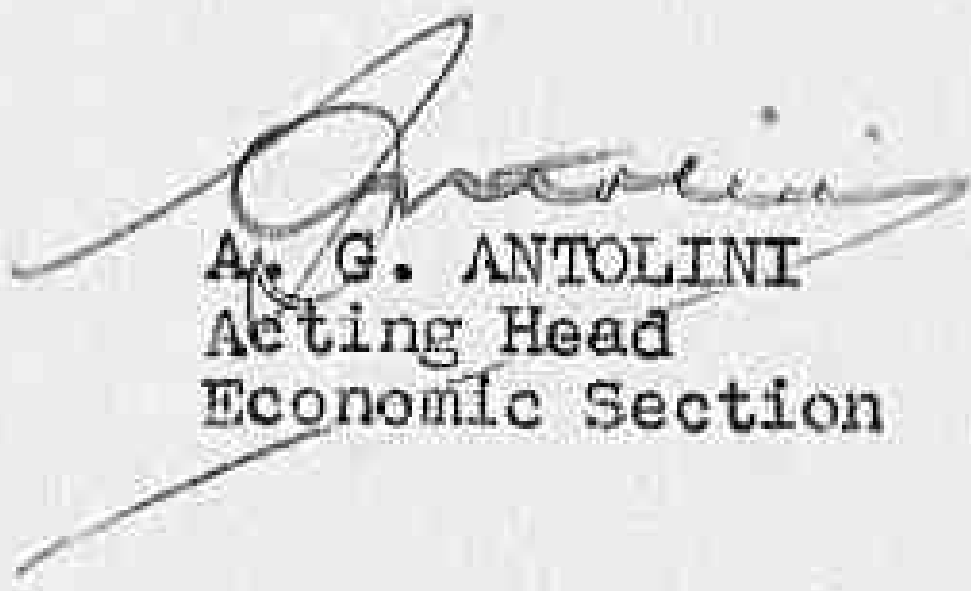

Dear Commodore: (12)

Message F48013 of 4 November to you from General Spofford is to the effect that immediate action is being taken in Washington to select a successor to General O'Dwyer, Vice-President, Economic Section, Allied Commission. It is anticipated that the new Vice-President will shortly arrive in Italy and take over the functions of the position which I now occupy as Acting Head, Economic Section. If agreeable to you, I will continue in my position until the new Vice-President arrives, at which time I shall request my recall to the United States.

In order that the new Vice-President may have a qualified official for the position of Executive Director -- one who has filled the job and who is familiar with the workings of the Section -- I request that I be relieved of my permanent assignment as Executive Director of the Economic Section and recommend that Mr. Harlan Cleveland be appointed to that position effective immediately. Announcement was made of my appointment as Executive Director by paragraph I B G.O. #21, HQ ACC, 10 July 1944.

former The Economic Section of this Commission was entrusted by the ~~late~~ Chief Commissioner with the approval of the combined Chiefs of Staff, to an American Vice-President as from January 31st. This Vice-President left Italy on leaving the direction of the Section to an Officer who was not competent to handle the important and complex problems especially in connection with supply and transport. Mr Grady returned after an absence of months and was succeeded by Colonel, now Brigadier-General O'Dwyer on . This Officer has now been recalled without reference to me at a most critical time when plans for the feeding of Northern Italy, rehabilitation of many thousands of possibly homeless and unemployed people, the reconstruction of power and industry have to be faced. I am informed that General O'Dwyer will return in three weeks time. I would ask for confirmation of this. I have received no instructions as to his replacement and have, therefore, appointed Mr Antolini temporarily to act for him.

former Both the ~~late~~ Chief Commissioner and myself have been seriously concerned about the efficiency of the Economic Section. My anxieties have diminished recently since General O'Dwyer took charge. His absence at this critical period renews those anxieties. The lack of permanency which has been quite rightly connected with the Vice-President of the Economic Section, not only is reflected in the work of the Sub-Commissions for which that Section is responsible, but may, I fear, impair the efficiency of the Section in dealing with the very great responsibilities for the feeding and economic maintenance of the population throughout Italy which this Commission has to carry.

It is essential, in my opinion, that this atmosphere of uncertainty be remedied without delay.

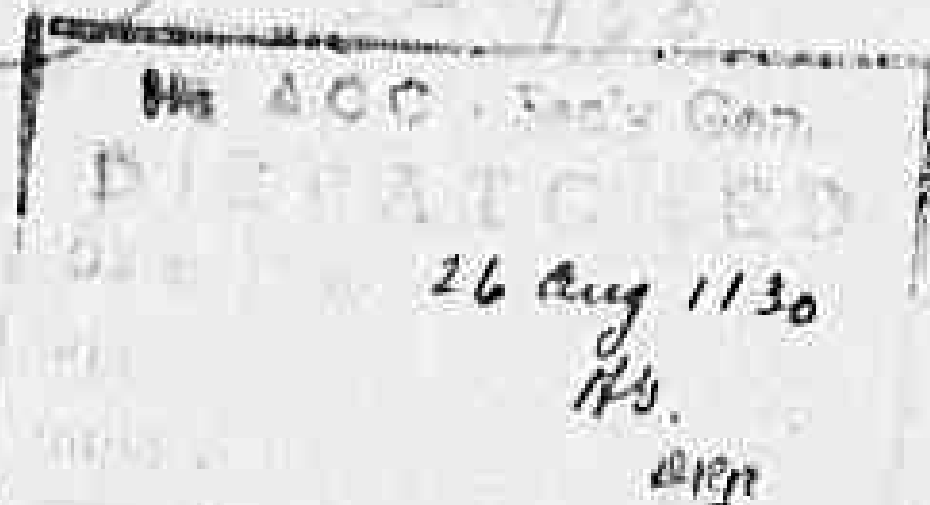

1. As you know, Colonel William O'Dwyer, O-464406, Air Corps, has been designated as Vice President of the Allied Control Commission for Italy. He is taking over the duties of Mr. Henry Grady as announced in General Orders Number 23 issued today, pursuant to MGS letter, MGS-387.4-1 of 23 December 1943. The only papers however, which Colonel O'Dwyer has received, other than travel orders, are letter of the Secretary of State, undated, and a memorandum from Under Secretary of War Patterson to Lieutenant General McNarney, dated June 19, copies of which are attached.

2. Under original directives, Vice Presidents in the Allied Control Commission are required to be designated or approved by the Combined Chiefs of Staff. Colonel O'Dwyer is not informed whether this action was taken.

3. I should be grateful if you would advise me whether our General Orders Number 23 are sufficient to constitute Colonel O'Dwyer's formal designation as Vice President, or whether you consider it necessary for AFHQ to seek further authority from ECS.
