MEMORANDUM TO: Hq Commandant

- 1. It has come to my notice that the Italian Liaison Section, consisting of two officers and two enlisted men, are not entitled to draw any NAAFI or PX stores such as cigarettes, soap, etc.
- 2. For technical reasons I understand that it is very difficult for you to make such stores available to them, but at the same time since these men are also technically debarred from receiving Italian Army comforts I wish an effort to be made to overcome these difficulties, particularly in view of the proximity of the Christmas season.
