War Office letter 103/Gen./7166(Q.2.b) of the 29 December 1943 defines persons entitled to deal with N.A.A.F.I. establishments overseas.

It excludes Italians, but in view of the wish of the Chief Commissioner to meet the requirements of two officers and two men of the Italian Liaison Section (as a special case and without prejudice), I would recommend that an exception be made and that N.A.A.F.I. rations should be issued to them this Christmas.

TO: Headquarters Commandant, Headquarters Allied Commission, APO 394, US Army

1. Sales cannot be made to the above personnel.
2. Paragraph 11a and 11b, Circular No. 3, MATOUSA, dated 1 January 1944, is quoted herein for reference:

"11. Sales by Army Post Exchanges and unit exchanges may be made only to the personnel shown below:

a. Commissioned, warrant officers, and enlisted personnel of the United States armed forces.

b. When stocks permit, representatives of the following agencies who are citizens of the United States may purchase required items for their personal use upon presentation of a certificate of necessity and the statement by their respective bureau chief or other officer having immediate jurisdiction over them that they cannot procure the equivalent articles from other sources:

- (1) American Red Cross Workers.
- (2) Accredited and recognized war correspondents, photographers, radio news commentators, technical observers and entertainment personnel.
- (3) Federal officers and employees of executive departments and agencies of the United States Government. "

MEMORANDUM TO: Hq Commandant

1. It has come to my notice that the Italian Liaison Section, consisting of two officers and two enlisted men, are not entitled to draw any NAAFI or PX stores such as cigarettes, soap, etc.

2. For technical reasons I understand that it is very difficult for you to make such stores available to them, but at the same time since these men are also technically debarred from receiving Italian Army comforts I wish an effort to be made to overcome these difficulties, particularly in view of the proximity of the Christmas season.
