1. Provinces

Torino - The Provincial Commissioner of Torino asked that it AMG officer be appointed to the APB. It was stated that the interests of AMG have been neglected at recent meetings of the Board.

Cuneo - P.C. Cuneo reported that he has discovered what is apparently a racket in that a firm known as URACI contracts to trace missing cars for owners. A charge of 10,000 lire is required as a deposit and a further charge made if the vehicle is found.... Demobilized Italian soldiers are also presenting a problem in Cuneo, since there is no employment, nor do they have a bonus arrangement. The Regional Commissioner suggested that they be given priority in the labor offices.

2. Special Divisions

Finance - The Regional Finance Officer stated that all financial problems would be solved shortly with the departure of the last remaining finance officer.

Public Works - The Regional P.W. Officer announced that each city has now been allocated a small amount of coal for the purpose of preheating in gas-works. In case the allotment exceeds the amount needed, it should be held, so that furnaces may be kept heated in case of non-arrival of future allocations.

Agriculture - Amassing is continuing, with 62.9 of AMG wheat figures having been turned in at warehouses. 54,600 quintals of seed wheat is expected from Alessandria for distribution, and P.C.'s. were informed that farmers must sacrifice a like amount of wheat which they have retained in order to receive this choice seed.... UBSEA has again asked for the assistance of Italian soldiers in the corn and rice amassi. In light of the good results of the wheat amassing campaign, P.C.'s. also favor their use.

Public Safety - The Regional Public Safety Officer announced that the Ministry of War has undertaken the responsibility of clothing and fitting the CG RR. A further improvement in the attitude and coopera-

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Public Safety - The Regional Public Safety Officer announced that the Ministry of War has undertaken the responsibility of clothing and fitting the CC RR. Welfare - Coal is needed for the heating of hospitals, and linen and medical supplies, although here in warehouses, have been practically unobtainable. The Commerce Officer will aid in the procurement of these items.

ISO (E) - Returns of outstanding expenditures have been requested, but have been slow in arriving, especially from the provinces. All were asked to make these returns as soon as possible..... The Prefects report from Torino and Vercelli has not been received.

3. Regional Commissioner

Personnel - The Regional Commissioner gave a brief resume of the gloomy personnel picture, which, between British IIAF and American redeployment, is fast becoming critical. With the next American draft, there will be but 15 U.S. officers in the region. All were asked to continue operations until the last, however, keeping a skeleton staff in each province as long as possible.

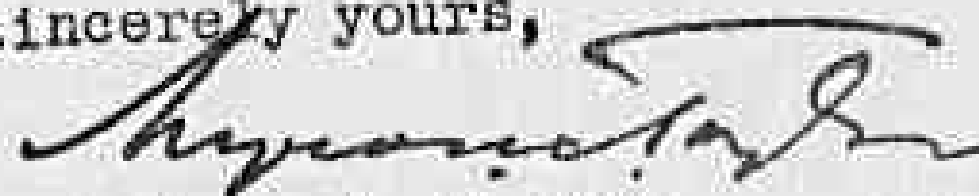

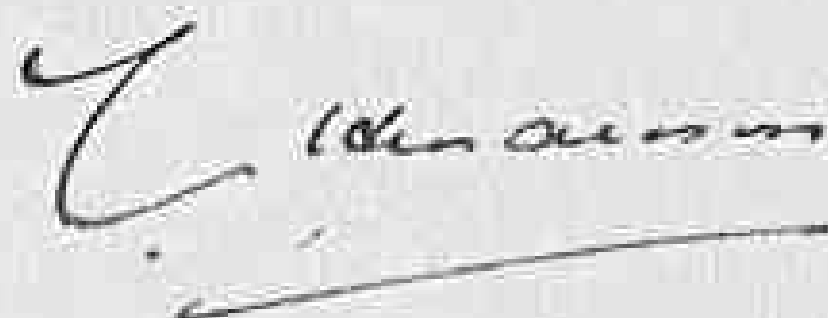

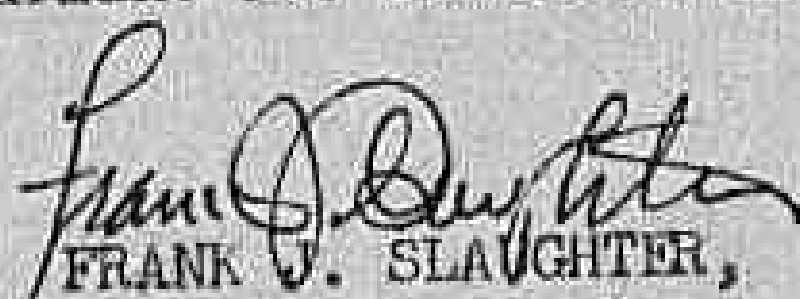
