1. Col MILLER has been the Chief Liaison Officer of this Commission at BOLING and has been held against that appointment on MR CM/1204/1.

2. When MR CM/1204/1 was written, it will be noted that the appropriate appointment for Col MILLER was set down as Staff Officer 1st Grade (civil affairs) but a note was added to the effect that Col MILLER, while holding that appointment, would be promoted in his existing rank of Colonel.

3. Col MILLER's duties at BOLING are now at an end but it is desired to bring him to this HQ to become the head of the Captured Enemy Material Division. The difficulties which the head of this Division will have to meet may well be known to you already. In case they are not known, it is suggested that information can be obtained from the DAG CM.

4. Owing to the heavy responsibilities which Col MILLER will have to undertake, and also in view of the fact that he will have to deal with a number of senior officers and representatives of various interests, it is considered that it would be unfair to ask Col MILLER to accept the work but to relinquish his temporary rank which he has held for eighteen months. It is therefore strongly urged that you will agree to post Col MILLER to this HQ in his existing rank.

Dear General,

Lush and I have been concerned for some time about the capability of Lt Colonel BRIGHT now Provincial Commissioner at UDINE. He does not seem to have a grip on his work or the knowledge about his Province which I should expect from a Provincial Commissioner; this impression was confirmed the other day when I visited UDINE. He showed particularly bad political judgement when he was last in HOME.

I understand that Lush has mentioned him to you and he tells me that your reply was that BRIGHT had always done what you wanted and you had no feelings in the matter.

I consider that the time has come for a change but naturally before taking any action, I should like to know whether you feel strongly about it and whether you have such confidence in BRIGHT that you consider a change undesirable.

If you have no objection to a change I should propose to replace BRIGHT by Colonel S.W. MILLER who has been Chief Liaison Officer at BOLZANO, or if you would prefer SMUTS, and he can be persuaded to stay, I should be quite happy to have him.
