SUBJECT: Advisory Council to Italy.

TO : G-5, AFM.

1. Referenced your G-5:09.1 Italy of 22 December 44.

2. While the addition of the Advisory Council would be welcomed by the American and British representatives on it, this HQ would like to point out that the Council was not created by the Armistice Terms and that it is not subject to the disposition of SAC or CCS. Its basis of legality is the Moscow Declaration of 1943, and there is nothing in this Declaration which says it should not continue in being after the conclusion of the peace with Italy. It would appear therefore that the first sentence of your para 2 is not applicable.

3. In August 1945 the Foreign Office raised with the State Department the question of abolishing the Advisory Council. However it was agreed by them that the Council should continue owing to the probable attitude of the Soviet Government, and to the fact that the liquidation of the Advisory Council might deprive the Greek and Yugoslav Governments of their only possibility of influencing Italian affairs. It was also feared that its abolition might cause a deterioration in the position of the American and British elements in the Control Commissions in the satellite States under Soviet occupation.

4. This HQ is, however, in agreement with the suggestion contained in your letter under reference. It is suggested that in the communication to CCS you are now considering attention might be drawn to the fact that under the terms of reference of SAC, SAC should turn over direction of Allied Commissions to the Advisory Council when it is possible "to bring direct military control of the Italian administration to an end." Since that phase is clearly at hand, the unfortunate consequences of such a course could be pointed out and a suggestion made that the best means of avoiding it would be for the American and British Governments to agree to abolish the Council. It is also thought that the views of the State Department, as expressed in para 3 above, may have changed since last summer.

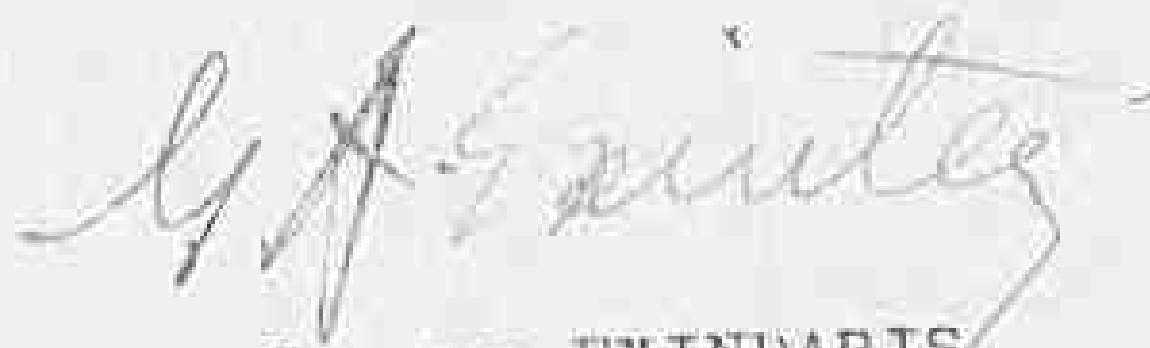

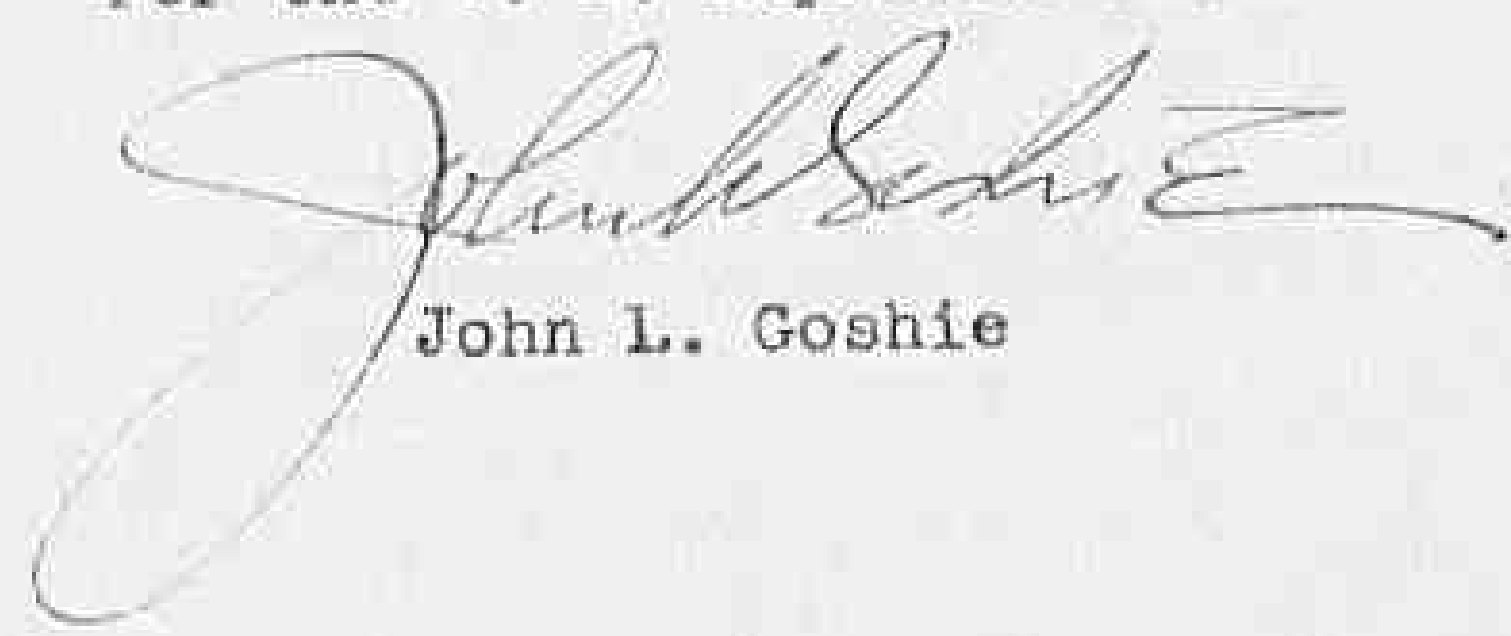
