

Declassified E.O. 12356 Section 3.3/NND No. 7850/5 Thanks La Lon 2 December 1945 The Chief of Usvermant Brindisi No. 136 My dear General, May I confirm what I already said verbally in regard to the coming meeting in Brindisi of the Advisory Council for Italy. You are aware with what interest Italian cublic opinion follows this question. It is therefore superfluous for me to repeat once more what a strong and natural disappointment would come from the knowledge that a Committee, expressly formed for the purpose of studying Italian affairs, located in Italy and in the very city where the Royal Government has its Seat, should start its work with absolute exclusion on our part. And it is for this reason, dear General, that I would be deeply grateful if you would use all your authority and weight in obtaining authorization to have an Italian member also sit is at the meetings, under whatever circumstances you may see fit. I personally believe that the title of 'observer' would be sufficient for the time being. In this event, I would choose the General Secretary of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Minister Prunes, to fulfill the assignment. He would naturally be at the disposal of the Council la any capacity which would facilitate its work and activity.
