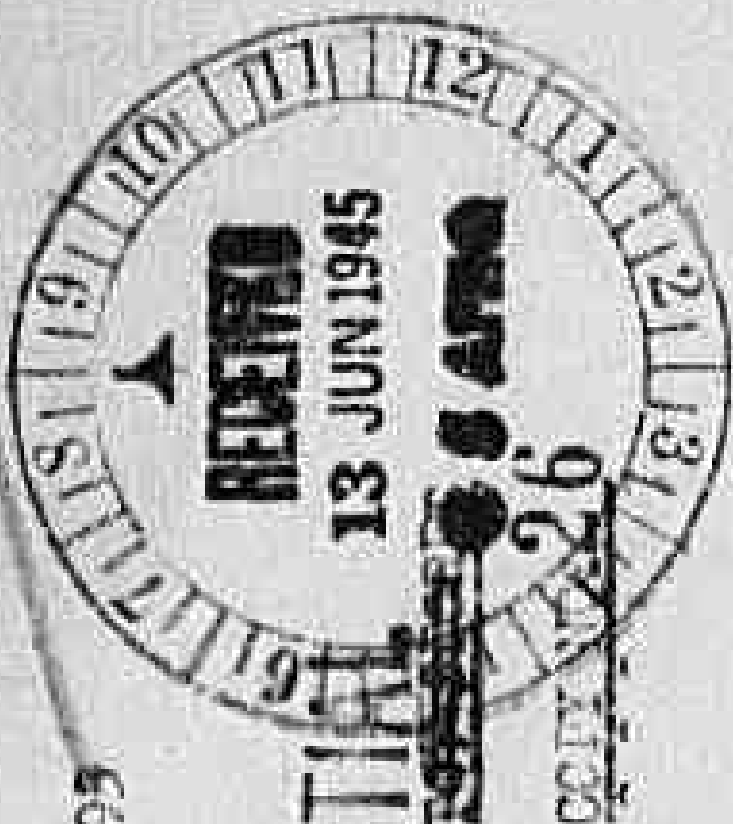

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REPORT

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2. BOMBING POLICY IN ITALY

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(Previous reference SAC (44) 104th Meeting - Minute 2)

THE SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER said that he had received representations from the Allied Commission urging that bombing attacks should not be directed against such Italian factories as were known to be used only for the manufacture of textiles.

BRIGADIER GENERAL CABELL replied that if factories were known only to be used for this purpose no deliberate attacks were made on them. If there was any doubt, however, they could not be exempted from attack, since MAF policy was to bomb factories producing warlike stores. He would welcome information from the Allied Commission regarding which factories were not engaged in the production of warlike stores. He added, correcting his statement recorded under Minute 2 of SAC (44) 104th Meeting, that there was in fact a restriction on air attacks against locomotives and other rolling stock within marshalling yards, but no restriction elsewhere. 76

THE SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER :

Directed that G-2, in conjunction with MAF and G-5, ensure that all relevant information regarding factories not engaged in the production of warlike stores in ITALY was in fact being made available to MAF.

1. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

(SAC (44) 99th Meeting)

THE CONFERENCE approved the minutes of their meeting held on 12th October 1944, subject to the following amendment :-

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(17)

6. RETURN OF PRINCESS OF PIEDMONT TO ITALY

(Paper No. SAC (44) 105)

THE CONFERENCE had before them two letters from the Principal ADC to the Lieutenant General of the Realm of ITALY requesting facilities for the return to ITALY from SWITZERLAND of the Princess of Piedmont with her family and retinue and of certain outstanding political figures.

MR. KIRK explained that the Prince had previously wished the political figures to be dealt with at the same time as his family and had disregarded a suggestion made to him that the transfer of the political figures was primarily a matter for the Italian Government. It was not known whether the Government had asked for these individuals, or whether the Allied Control Commission would approve their transfer, although Duke Gallareti Scotti was known to be required

X for the Italian Embassy in MADRID. He suggested that, without revealing that a request for the transfer of these individuals had been made by the Lieutenant General of the Realm, it should be ascertained whether the Italian Government had asked for the transfer and whether their transfer was considered by them to be necessary. He added that he had informed General Infante that the means of transport by which their transfer would be effected must be left entirely to the Allied authorities.

LIEUTENANT GENERAL EAKER said that their transfer could be effected by air but that he was strongly opposed to the use of Italian aircraft for this purpose as suggested by General Infante, since they might well be shot at over FRANCE.

ADMIRAL CUNNINGHAM observed that their transfer by sea would be likely to create embarrassment.

THE SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER :

- (a) Directed that G-5 ascertain, in accordance with the suggestion at 'X' above, whether the transfer of the four political figures referred to in General Infante's letter of 11th October should be carried out.
- (b) Directed that G-5 arrange with the appropriate authorities for the transfer by air to ITALY of the Princess of Piedmont and her family and retinue and, if desired by the Italian Government, of the political figures referred to under (a) above, and that the order in which these parties were transferred be agreed with the Allied Control Commission, taking into account General Infante's request in his letter of 11th October.
