SUBJECT: 1944-45 Production Program for Italian Agriculture,
Forestry and Fisheries.

TO : Chief Commissioner.

1. Attached is a copy of printed report entitled "1944-45 Production Program for Italian Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries" which has just come off the press. This report, which was prepared jointly by the Agriculture S/C and the Ministry of Agriculture, sets up a proposed plan of production and requirements for Italian agriculture.

2. The report is being forwarded to all the following officials in Liberated Italy: Prefects, Compartmental and Provincial Agricultural Inspectors, Forest Corps, and Fisheries officials for study and suggestions. It has also been sent to Allied Regional Commissioners and Regional Agricultural Officers

3. A letter from the Minister of Agriculture, copy attached, accompanies the report sent to Italian officials. It suggests their thorough study of the plan and invites them to attend a conference in Rome 30 November-3 December to discuss it. The Agriculture S/C, in turn, is sending a similar letter, copy attached, to all Regional Commissioners and Agricultural Officers in the field.

4. The forthcoming conference - the first of its kind to be held by the Ministry of Agriculture since the Allied landing - will not only help coordinate thinking between the Ministry and their field officials, but will serve to create better working relations and a clearer understanding between members of the Agriculture S/C and Italian agricultural officials at various levels.

5. This meeting will also serve immediate needs of the Agriculture S/C, however, by giving field officers an opportunity to help the S/C in screening their requirements for agriculture.

6. The Agriculture S/C is now working with the Ministry of Agriculture officials in the preparation of the program for November-3 December conference. A copy of this program is sent to you shortly.

SUBJECT: Crop Production Plan for 1944-45 Season

TO : All Regional Commissioners and Agricultural Officers

1. Enclosed is translation of a letter which H.E. the Minister of Agriculture, Fausto Gullo, sent to his compartmental and provincial representatives with "1944-45 Production Plan for Italian Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries."

2. This printed publication which was attached to the September report sets forth:

- a. The objectives, policies, procedure and important factors affecting the 1944-45 Production Program.
- b. Crop production plan and priorities,
- c. Requirements of fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides, and farm machinery based upon the proposed supplies.
- d. Forestry program and minimum imported requirements.
- e. Fisheries program and minimum imported supplies.

3. In order to implement this program, a meeting of the Regional agricultural personnel, together with the members of the Agriculture Sub-Commission, will be held in Rome on 30 November-3 December to discuss:

- a. Changes in the suggested provincial requirements.
- b. Problems and procedure to implement the program in co-operation with Italian officials at compartmental, provincial and communal levels.
- c. Major agricultural production problems for 1945 and 1946.
- d. Most important agricultural supply requirements (domestic and imported) for 1944-45 and for 1945-46.

4. At least one day of the meeting will be spent in joint conference with members of the Italian Ministry of Agriculture and its field representatives at the various levels.

- c. Requirements of fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides, and farm machinery based upon the proposed supplies.
- d. Forestry program and minimum imported requirements.
- e. Fisheries program and minimum imported supplies.

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- b. Problems and procedure to implement the program in co-operation with Italian officials at compartmental, provincial and communal levels.
- c. Major agricultural production problems for 1945 and 1946.
- d. Most important agricultural supply requirements (domestic and imported) for 1944-45 and for 1945-46.

4. At least one day of the meeting will be spent in joint conference with members of the Italian Ministry of Agriculture and its field representatives at the various levels. A complete program will be forwarded to you.

5. Any assistance which will facilitate the transportation of compartmental and provincial officials to this meeting will be appreciated.
