On behalf of A.C. Mr. Dorkovich guaranteed that Services requirements would be met as in the past.

After considerable discussion it was decided that the best course to adopt when these plants were handed over to A.C., was for all Services to contract with the civilian contractor for the quantities of gases required and to hand over to the contractor free of charge sufficient raw materials to produce the quantities of gases required. In this manner the contractors would not include any element of raw material costs in their prices.

Since A.C. could not supply all the necessary raw materials required to produce Industrial Gases for civilian use and that Services could not issue raw materials to A.C. for this purpose under present Directives, A.C. undertook to request APTG for the necessary authority for the supply of raw materials in bulk to A.C. by Services for the production of gases for civilians. By this method, civilian needs would be satisfied from the surplus production capacity and the raw materials supplied by A.C. from their bulk receipts from Services.

6. It was unanimously agreed that the Sub-Committee meetings should continue to safeguard Service requirements and as a means of fairly and satisfactorily allocating the productive capacity of the various Gas Plants to all Interested Services.
7. Capt. Shimwell stated that he had handed over to Ordnance (British) these Gas Plants under his control.
8. The Sub-Committee expressed their warmest thanks for the many services which he had so ably rendered and also their good wishes for his future.

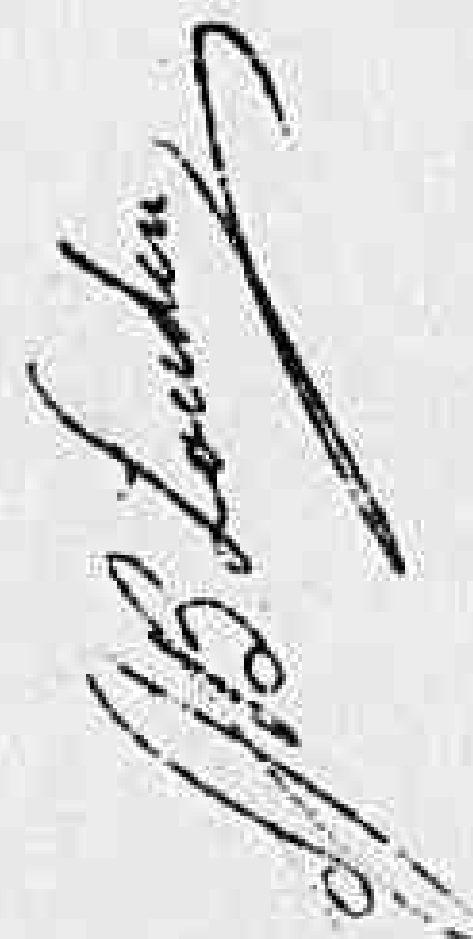
