SARDINIAN COAL PRODUCTION.

A partial strike started 18th October in the Sardinian coal mines which caused production to fall almost 50% of normal, i.e. from 3,800 tons daily to approximately 2,000 tons. This was brought to the notice of Coal Branch, UNRRA, on the 23rd October, and was regarded with no slight degree of apprehension, and Regional Director, UNRRA Sardinia, was cabled for full explanation and notification was passed to the Ministry of Industry & Commerce.

On 26th October at a meeting with Chief of Mission, Mr. S. Keeny, this matter was referred to and instructions given to Coal Branch, UNRRA, for a letter to be prepared to Mr. Morandi, the Minister for Industry & Commerce. This was duly prepared but was not cleared from this Branch until the following Monday, 28th October. Yesterday, 29th October, a signal was received that as from 25th October the strike had ceased, consequently the letter pointing out the urgency of the situation and its detrimental effect in regard to obtaining coal from sources other than Italy was withdrawn and not dispatched.

The exact reasons for the stoppage have not yet been advanced by the Ministry of Industry & Commerce, but from information obtained from officials attached to the High Commissioner in Sardinia visiting Rome the last weekend, it would appear that there has been considerable dissatisfaction as to the assessment of the piece rates in the existing wage structure. What remedies have been taken are not known, but, presumably, from the information received yesterday, it would appear that the miners are adopting a more conciliatory attitude.

SUBJECT: CIP Strike.

TO : The Chief Commissioner
Allied Commission

1. Meeting was held this morning in PBS Petroleum Section, in this building. Present, in addition to A.C. representative, were: UNRRA, British Embassy (Mr. Hird, Labor); American Embassy; PBS; A. & N. Pet. Board; American Relief for Italy; Ministry of Industry & Commerce; Ministry of Labor and Ministry of Interior.

2. Effect of Strike on Allied Forces.

There should be no effect on the Allied Armed Forces because of the existence of adequate stocks and because the petroleum workers at Livorno, Venice and Naples are working under military control.

3. Effect of Strike on Venezia Giulia/Udine.

There should be no effect on Venezia Giulia/Udine because of the above and because the Trieste workers, not CIP, have been back at work since Monday.

4. Effect of Strike on Italian Armed Forces.

There may be some effects on Italian Armed Forces, but the Prime Minister has informed Morando, new Secretary of Industry & Commerce, that he is calling the representatives of the Federation of Labor today and stating that unless they settle immediately the Government will requisition and operate the installations, using specialists of the Italian Armed Forces.

5. Mr. Keeny stated that the UNRRA program of imports will be handled as follows:

- (a) Off-load oil where it is needed.
- (b) Off-load oil where storage space exists.
- (c) Divert tankers.
- (d) Cancel loading.

These steps - (a) through (d) - are in a sense a priority of treatment, (b) being resorted to in case (a) won't work, and (c) in case (a) and (b) don't work.
