SUBJECT: Replacement of British Troops
by II Polish Corps.

TO : Allied Force Headquarters.
Attn: G-5 Section.

1. In conversation the other day the Prime Minister asked whether he could be kept informed of the location of Polish troops in Italy. He said that he fully realized the necessity of maintaining them here, at any rate for the time being, but that because of the political implications of their presence he would like to know where they were located and any major changes that had to be made from time to time.

2. I think the Prime Minister's request is reasonable and I should be grateful, therefore, if you could send me the location statement of the Polish troops in Italy and keep me informed of any major changes, as, for instance, the taking over of train and railway guard duties by the 66 Polish Infantry Battalion from 53 I.A.A., R.A.
