Very painful reasons - among which, in particular, the very grave situation of the family of the prisoner, cause the present request to obtain that Mr. Scapparone be shipped home as soon as possible.

I beg you to intervene in this sense with the Commission, and shall be most grateful if you keep me informed on this matter.

2. The High Commissioner for Prisoners of War and the Comando Supremo have made several requests for information as to their EFA. Owing to the lack of information I have in this matter I find it difficult to answer the Italian Government to their satisfaction.

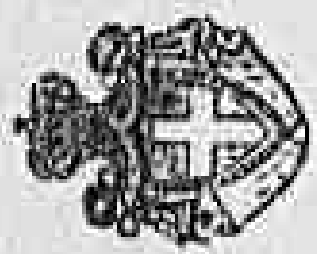

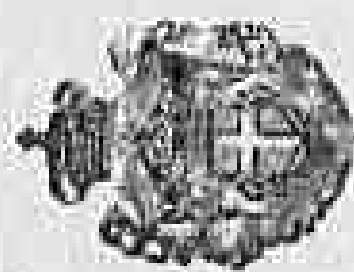

1. As the matter appears urgent, the Chief Commissioner may agree to consider this matter over and above the list of 25 names forwarded by the Deputy Chief Commissioner on 21 April (014.33). As the Generals concerned are in U.S.A. and KENYA, it is suggested a cable might be sent.

2. Reference attached letter from the High Commissary for PW, para 3, No. 13 Mil. dated 14 April. These men appear to be all disabled for life. From recent signals it appears that 170 sick PW are about to arrive in Italy. It thus appears that the principle of repatriation of non-active PW has been accepted, but in default of a policy, it is not known if they are to be limited to cases who are permanently disabled. For this reason it is suggested that the matter be represented to A.F.H.Q. and that a policy be asked for.

3. Reference attached letter from the High Commissary for PW, para 2, No. 13 Mil. dated 14 April. This matter is being represented at my request by the Naval Sub-Commission. It appears that many PW who have a high "civil" value but who (usually) hold comparatively low Army rank, would best be represented by Sub-Commission dealing with other Ministries than the Armed Forces. A fairer priority demand in regard to A.C.C. activities would then be secured, than if the names were submitted to the Comando Supremo whose lists naturally tend to have a high "Services" flavour. I have also represented this point to the Administrative Section.

Further to my memo Q3269 dated 18 April 1944.

I have been referring again to A.F.H.Q.'s (26) APP A signal of the 25th January (No. 42781) wherein the previous "liberal policy" in regard to the return of PW was rescinded. This signal inferred that the sole reason for holding Italian PW who had NOT been formed into service units was owing to Allied man-power shortage and the consequent necessity of forming further service units. From this it is difficult to understand how the retention of General officers and full Colonels who are only required to command and staff formation, can be justified. In fact the policy which now seems to have been adopted for a gradual return of certain classes of PW makes it appear that there never was the intention to hold the most senior officers.

Further, by now it seems possible that the Allies have decided on what service units they really require for the prosecution of the war in this theatre and that they therefore are more certain of which officers they require and which they do not.

After a recent talk with General INFANTE, I have suggested to the Adm. Sec. that they put up for consideration a list of PW that Ministries other than the Armed Forces require to be repatriated. It is considered that a fairer distribution of demand according to the civil value of PW, some of whom are comparatively junior rank, will thus be obtained.

Refer to our 30217 of 17 Jan and paragraph 9 of letter AG 400-1 (Italy) GUT-ANG, subject "Disposal of Italian Army" dated 2 Jan. As a matter of policy it is impractical to release any Italian PW, either officers or men, now in service units, and such requests from the Italian Government should be discouraged. Above letter should be amended accordingly. 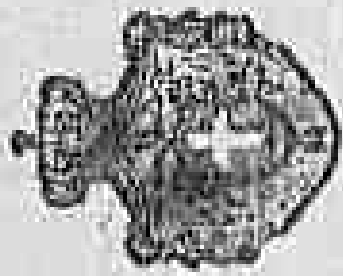

Reference is made to your letter of 26th February requesting information as to prospects of early repatriation of certain Italian P.W. Officers as desired by Marshal Messe.

As some delay has been encountered, I wish to advise you that three of subject officers are in U.S. custody in North Africa. Two of these (Lt Col Martinengo and Maggiore Lucia) will be repatriated immediately and the third (Capt Murero) in the near future.

Three of subject officers (Maggiore alpini Pistotti, Maggiore alpini Bianchi, and Tenente A.A. Pili Castoldi) are in French custody in North Africa. Separate action is being taken to endeavour to obtain French assent to their release.

Inquiries concerning the remainder of subject officers are being pressed and you will be advised further. Meanwhile you might wish to advise Marshal Messe of progress in this matter to date.

Dear Marshal Badoglio:

I very much regret the delay in replying to your letters of 20 and 22 February with reference to securing the repatriation of Colonel Natale Leopoldo and 2nd Lieutenant Lt Voti Pietro di Giuseppe.

As you may know, we have been endeavoring to secure on behalf of Marshal Messe a revision of the present restrictive policy of AFHQ in this respect, and with that objective in mind it has been arranged with Marshal Messe to submit specific lists of 25 officers at a time for whom repatriation is being urgently pressed. The first of Marshal Messe's lists has already gone forward to AFHQ and the remainder are being held pending, we hope, favorable action on the first list. In order to have a coordinated program with some prospect of favorable handling by AFHQ, our suggestion would be to have the names of officers in which your office is specially interested included in subsequently revised lists of Marshal Messe.

If you concur with this suggestion, we can return to Marshal Messe for such revision the five remaining lists which we are holding here pending action on his first list.

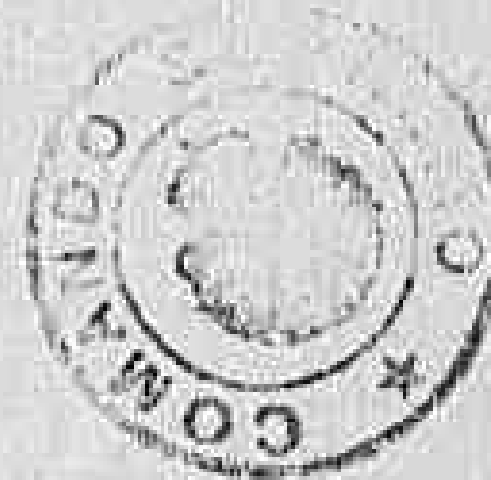

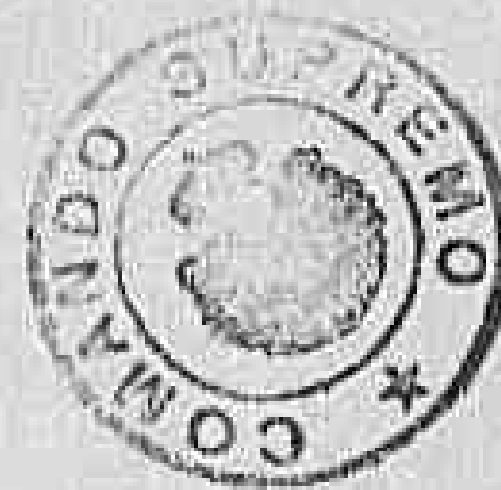

1. Reference the list of Italian POW Officers in the first category of priority to be returned to Italy, (forward to you by Lieut-Colonel Quin-Smith and sent on by you to me). This list is altogether too long for me to hope to press with success for the immediate return to Italy of the Officers named in it.

2. I suggest that Brigadier Duchesne should ask Marshal Messe to let him have to start with a list of approximately 25 Officers in order of priority definitely and urgently required by Marshal Messe for duty in Italy, Sicily or Sardinia with the Italian army. I think that with any luck I will be able to get most, if not all, of a short list of this size returned to Italy reasonably quickly. Having succeeded with one short list I would then be prepared to submit another one. If, therefore, Marshal Messe likes to give me three or four similar short lists in every case in order of priority I would automatically set to work to do my best to get them repatriated list by list.

With note No. 3962/Op of 22 December last, I asked for the repatriation of all Royal Carabinieri - Officers and ORs - who are at present still in North Africa.

The repatriation of at least a part of this personnel at the earliest possible date is a matter of necessity.

30 Officers, 200 NCOs and 500 Carabinieri would be required.

The enclosure gives the names of a few Carabinieri Officers now in North Africa, who should be included in the first lot to be repatriated. To these officers could be committed the choice of the remaining officers and of ORs.

SUBJECT: Repatriation of Psow

At various times I have so far requested the repatriation of a total of 679 POW Officers: of these, only 39 have come back up to now.

I wish to point out the absolute necessity that at least a part of the Generals and Colonels in question should be allowed to repatriate as soon as possible, because this directly connected with the promptness with which I intend to carry on the technical and political purge of high ranking Officers.

Otherwise, this purge would be subject to a considerable delay, and might indeed become impossible, as I have not at my disposal the proper personnel to replace the Officers I wish to dismiss from the Armed Forces.

As, on the other hand, such a purge is necessary, for many reasons and in the interest of the Allies themselves, I shall be grateful to you, General, if you would take an interest in the request for repatriation.

In order to facilitate retracements and to stagger their movements, I have divided the Officers requested by name in three groups (vide the enclosed lists): the first of these consists of those Officers whose repatriation we should like to be carried out with priority.

At various times I have so far requested the repatriation of a total of 679 POW Officers: of these, only 39 have come back up to now.

I wish to point out the absolute necessity that at least a part of the Generals and Colonels in question should be allowed to repatriate as soon as possible, because this directly connected with the promptness with which I intend to carry on the technical and political purge of high ranking Officers.

R. NAVY: 106 Officers - (enclosure N. 3) - Officers belonging to the Staffs or special craft are listed separately.

R. AVIATION: 9 Officers and 3 NCO (enclosure N. 4)

The Officers already returned to Italy are not included in the above mentioned lists of the four enclosures. Enclosure N. 5 shows name and number.

Besides the given lists it would be very useful to obtain the repatriation of all Royal Carabinieri, Officers and ORs, still war prisoners in North Africa.

I should be very grateful, General, if you would be kind enough to point out the usefulness of a speedy repatriation.
