Your Excellency,

1. Reference your letter of October 12th, File 8499/2615 and this Sub-Commission's letter of 20th October, No. AG/1/5/3/LG.

2. We have been informed that two members of the Education Commission appointed by the Prefect were nominated upon the recommendation of the Committee of National Liberation, while the third was appointed by the Deputy High Commissioner for Education.

3. As we have already informed you, Avv. MAGNO who was a member of the Commission has already been removed from the office of Vice-Prefect.

4. In view of the fact that under the new decree the members of the Provincial Education Commissions must be appointed by a president of the council of ministers who has the discretion of appointing a new commission or confirming the existing one, this matter is purely academic now and consequently no action need be taken by us.



2. It is agreed that the removal of MAGIO from office has relieved the Province of one of the main causes of discontent.
3. As regards the constitution of the Provincial Defascism Commission a report on this has already been submitted under this letter CP/2/2 dated 1 Nov 44. There have been numerous changes of Provincial Commissioners and Provincial Officers since the Commission was first constituted, but the following information is submitted showing all the facts that can be ascertained from the Prefect and present Provincial Officer:-

- (a) On receipt of MI 159 dated 1st Jul 44, the Prefect of PESCARA obtained the approval of the then Provincial Commissioner to proceed with the appointment of the Provincial Commission. It will be noted that this was previous to this HQ having received any instructions from higher authority.
- (b) At that Vice Prefect MAGIO was also the leader of the local Committee of National Liberation, which was consulted by the Prefect with regard to the nomination of the Commission, and was recommended by the Committee for the appointment to be filled by an official of the Prefettura.
- (c) It is understood that the second member of the Provincial Commission, acc. MANCINI, was also appointed on the recommendation of the Committee of National Liberation.
- (d) The third member, the representative of the High Commissioner, Sig. ORTINIA, was appointed by the deputy High Commissioner, Dott. Mauro Scoccimarro, under his letter No. 617/II/4-1 dated 18 Aug 44.
- (e) Owing to the delay in the appointment of the third member by the High Commissioner, it was not until 23 Aug 44 that the Prefect of PESCARA was able to issue the necessary Prefectural Decree appointing the Provincial Defascism Commission. The decree was duly approved by the Provincial Officer of PESCARA on behalf of the Provincial Commissioner.
- (f) On 23 Aug 44, this HQ received, under ref R5/507/3 dated 22 Aug 44, HQ AC letter 313/I67/CA dated 4 Aug 44 outlining the policy to be adopted in the setting up of the Provincial Commissions. These instructions were communicated to Prefects by this HQ on 25 Aug 44. 1512

- (g) That the Commission was not functioning satisfactorily was made apparent owing to its failure to submit the necessary progress reports as called for in the above quoted HQ AC letter. An investigation into this was made and it was discovered that this was in a great part due to Vice Prefect MAGIO, who had since been

replaced by Vice-rector H. D. M. A report to this effect was submitted to you with this letter on 20/8/1944.

4. From the above, it will be seen that the Commission was legally constituted in accordance with S.I. 1939 and with the approval of the Government, although it is now apparent that at the time the reflector was more or less under the influence of R.G.M. (as mentioned in Captain Gilligan's report dated 1935/1/31/LG dated 21 Oct 46).

" In the Province of Pescara recently discontent has arisen in regard to the Vice Prefect Mr. Vagno Tassanale, who appointed himself after the Allies' liberation of the Province, because though declaring himself independent, in reality he directs the people towards communism, and evading himself of the career, he actively works in racing at the head of the Administration communist elements.

All this causes deep resentment in the members of the other parties, who would also like to take active part in the public life of the Province.

Resentment is also caused by the manner in which the provincial commission of enquiry was constituted. The art. 18-3 comma - of the D.L. of the 27th of July 1944 for the sanctions against fascism fixes that the provincial commissions must be composed by a magistrate, in active service or retired, by an official of the Prefecture and by a member designated by the High Commissioner.

The Commission of the Province of Pescara, through the action of Mamo, is so composed : Mr. Mancini Giovanni, retired magistrate, Mr. Vagno Tassanale - abovementioned - and of a certain Camerra Guerrino of the communist party, nominated by the High Commissioner.

The other parties object that the composition of the Commission is illegal because the Mr. Mancini, though a magistrate, in the past was forced to resign for morality reasons, and the Vice Prefect - as we have already mentioned, self-appointed, can not be considered a real official of the Prefecture.

We add likewise that of the members of the Commission the ex-magistrate is a politician while the other two are communists; it would indeed be desirable, for reasons of balance, that one





SUBJECT: Local Government Report (Pescara)

TO : HQ, Region V

1. I should like to express my appreciation of your Local Government Report dated 11 August for Pescara. Without wishing to flatter anybody, it is a report of this sort which makes the work of this Sub-Commission easy, interesting, and practical, and I cannot thank Col. Holmes sufficiently for the manner in which he has put it up.

2. I would comment as follows, as Director of the Interior Sub-Commission:

Punto 2. Giunta Provinciale Amministrativa - I regret that this doubt has existed, and there is no question, of course, that the R.D.L. no. 111 of 4 April is the authority, and I am glad to see that it is now in the hands of the Prefect.

Giunta di Pescara - The professions of the Giunte members are a great advance towards democratic government and it is a most salutary sign that the old rule-of-thumb method of appointing only avvocati is dying out, at least in the province of Pescara.

Punto 4 - As you know, the Prefetto Raggente is being removed, and a new nominee, whom we hope will be able to assist Colonel Holmes more effectively, is under review at this moment.

I will have immediate enquiries made as regards the Vice-Prefect Inspector Costantini ARONICA.

3. I will not comment further, as I think it will be admitted that without a good Prefect, it would not be possible to get "Pop".

4. If we from this end could do anything to help the Provincial Commissioner of Pescara or Region V, you may be sure it will be the endeavour of this Sub-Commission to do so.

8. SPECIAL PROBLEMS

The prefecture, situated in a town which is no badly damaged that it has had to be evacuated, is functioning with difficulty owing to lack of accommodation for the staff. The administration is beginning to move slowly, but much "spreading" will have to be done before it is satisfactory.

The influence of the present prefect Roger - who has served under 3 previous Commandants before I came - is not good and he should be removed.

Owing to the suspension of the Civil Postal Service, there is no organised system whereby the Italian Administration can communicate with its subordinate officials throughout the province. It is particularly important that some skeleton system of communications be restored as early as possible.

Com. Cesare Pace Di Vincenzo at present Prefect Regent of Pescara Province entered into his career 15 May 1909, as Subprefect in Lanciano.

No. Transferred to the prefecture of Salerno 1909 as secretary, he remained there until 1918.

In the same year he was transferred as Subprefect in Castellammare di Stabia and in Jan 1920 he was transferred to the prefecture of Naples, where he remained till 1921 being promoted as First Secretary. In 1921 he was promoted to Counsellor and sent as Subprefect to the district of Nola where he remained till September 1925. Inscribed as member of P.N.F. 20 June 1926.

In 1927 he was named Section Head of the corrons by the General Direction of the Civil Administration (Home Ministry) and remained there till 15 July 1928, when he was promoted as Vice Prefect Inspector to prefecture of Benevento.

In 1930, he was transferred to the prefecture of Palermo and in September 1933, he was named Vice Commissioner of Palermo and in September 1934, he was sent as Vice Viceroy of Toledo.

In 1937, he has was been named R. Commissioner of Pistoia where he remained till June 1938 when he was assigned to the prefecture of Pescara.

The 5 January 1939, he was transferred as vice prefect viceroy to the prefecture of Pescara. In the same year he directed the extraordinary administration of Pescara, charge which he had since end of Aug. 1940. Since Aug. 40, he held office as Vice Prefect Viceroy both under Prefect Orsi, appointee of the Badoglio Government and also the Republican Prefect Monti, collaborating as required, with the Germans.

On 15 July 1943 he was confirmed as of Prefect Regent by the Regional Commissioner on the recommendation of Lt. Col. Ishoorn.

2.) Vice Prefect Viceroy - Pasquale Bellalio Segno Di Longo-Lawyer.

Sindaco in 1920 in Orsogni (Orsogni) was attacked and wounded by the Socialists of Orsogni during the political election 1921. In 1937, he has been named R. Commissioner of Pistoia where he remained till June 1938 when he was assigned to the Prefecture of Macerata.

The 5 January 1939, he was transferred as Vice Prefect Vicar to the Prefecture of Pescara. In the same year he directed the extraordinary Administration of Pescara, charge which he had since end of May, 1940.
