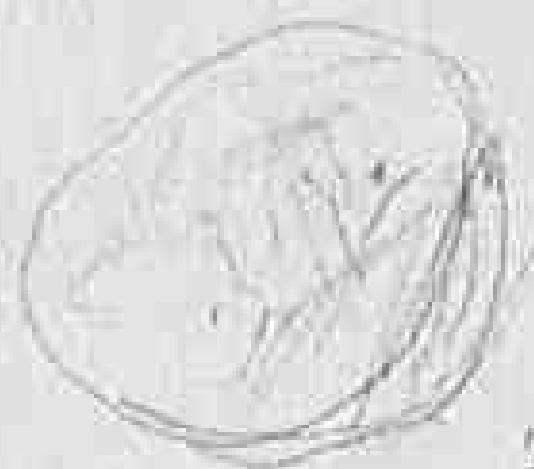

a) abbattimento di muri di ricinzione; b) danni alle murature, intonaci e pavimenti; c) danni alle caldaie per alimentazione termosifoni e macchinari di cucina; d) distruzione di materiale di guardaroba e materiali vari nonché di quantità non rilevante di viveri; e) spese ingenti per la pompatura dell'acqua e per la rimozione della melma dai giardini e dagli edifici.

1. Reference your AG/1/8/4/IG dated 5 Feb 45.
2. The Regional Finance Officer has approved of assistance grants in the Prefect's Budget for PISA Province for over Lit. 10,000,000 in the last thirty days. On the advice of the Minister of Treasury the original amount was reduced from Lit. 10,000,000 to Lit. 2,000,000 and the cut of eight million has just been restored, and an additional Lit. 2,000,000, making Lit. 12,000,000 total grants.
3. All projects for flood reconstruction or repair of bonifica which have been submitted in accordance with existing instructions have either been approved or are in process of being examined and approved.
4. The Regional Finance and Engineering Officers and Provincial officials have been alive to the unusual distress suffered in PISA and are doing everything in their power to alleviate.
5. If the Minister will suggest any additional means through which this assistance can be given where the need is real, his suggestions will be sympathetically examined.

SUBJECT : Pisa - Flood -

The serious situation of the town of Pisa has been pointed out to us again, because having suffered very much already because of the war, has had new destructions as a result of the flood of the Arno on the 2nd of November, 1944.

It appears that the Prefect of that Province has already asked the local Allied Military Command for subsidies to be distributed amongst the most needy families and to the hospitals which have an urgent need of being put again in conditions to function.

Also considerable are the damages caused by the flooding of the zone of draining (bonifica) of Bientina ; where the cultivators could be relieved with some help, of all the losses they have suffered and thus encouraged to begin work again.

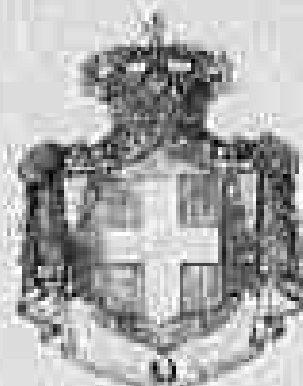
We ask the Commission to kindly take into consideration this serious situation so as to meet the necessities of the population

Risulta che il Prefetto di quella Provincia si è già rivolto al locale Comando Militare Alleato per invocare la concessione di sussidi da distribuire sia alle famiglie maggiormente colpite e sia agli istituti ospitalieri che hanno urgente bisogno di essere rimessi in condizioni di poter funzionare.
