SUBJECT : Note of Interview with Prof. VITTORIO RINDIA - Prefetto Reggente of
PIACENZA - on 5th July

TO : Director, Local Government and Commission

FROM : Captain, S.I. GUININCHE

1. The Prefect is an old man and lacks drive. He appears indecisive and wants the Allies to do everything for him.

2. Vice Prefect Vicario Romano COLUCCI has only come recently. The Prefect said it was too early to express an opinion. I saw COLUCCI and consider him a better man than the Prefect. He likewise has little drive but as a career official knows the administration.

3. Vice Prefect Inspector Mag. Guido BUCHIONE 7th grade has been denounced to the Epuration Commission but is still working. If he has to go another Vice Prefect Inspector will be required.

4. There is also a Vice Prefect Politico who has been going round setting up Giunta Comunale and etc. He is a man career man Dott. GIANNI.

5. Other personnel. The Prefect has sufficient at present with two I. Segretari functioning as Consigliari but he is afraid that Epuration will reduce his staff. He has written a letter to the Ministry, setting out the whole position and he will forward it through the usual channels.

6. Deputazione Provinciale is functioning, contains representatives of all parties.

7. G.P.A. The fear citizen members have been nominated but it has not held a meeting yet.

8. Giunta Comunale are meeting in 14 out of the 47 Communes. In the other the Prefect has appointed Consigliari Prefettini. He has done this in order that there will be a legal head of the Comune to produce the electoral lists. In the meantime the work of getting Giunta Comunale is going on.

9. Sindaci. Each Comune with a Giunta has a Sindaco. All others have Consigliari Prefettini.

10. Segretario Comunale. Each Comune has one. More than half the members are career officials. The Prefect is in favour of holding examinations as soon as possible.

11. Preparation of electoral lists. The necessary forms have been delivered to all Communes and preliminary work has started. The Casellario Giudiziale are

The Prefect is getting on with the appointment of the Electoral Commissions and has asked for names of proposed members.

1. The PO Major Lewis W. McINTYRE had not returned from Venice and the Executive Officer had returned to England for release from the army. Major Hills was carrying on until PO's return possibly today. Naturally he was not fully acquainted with the administrative position as his police work kept him fully occupied.

2. The Prefect NINJA AVV. V. G. was a weak old man rather under the thumb of the C.L.N. He was honest however and Major Hills thought he was trying to get clear of the C.L.N. He is a Christian Democrat and is the C.L.N.'s choice as Prefect. He was inclined to worry about taking action in case the C.L.N. didn't approve.

3. Major Hills was not aware of the position regarding other officials; Deputations of G.P.A.

4. Sindaci. 14 Sindaci had been appointed in the 47 Communes. In all the others a Commissario Prefettorio had been appointed by the Prefect's decree in order to legalise the compilation of the electoral lists.

5. Giunta Comunale. There were properly constituted Giunta Comunale in the 14 Communes with Sindaci.

6. Segretario Comunale. All Communes had one and they appeared to be good men. A good proportion were career officials.
