SUBJECT: Comune of Sanremo--sale of property.

18 August 1945

TO : EC Liguria Region (with copy for EC Imperia).

1. Herewith copy of English translation of a letter addressed by the Prefect of Imperia to the Ministry of the Interior on 14 June, as to the sale of certain landed property made by this Comune for the purpose of reducing its deficit, and which the Prefect now seeks to have formally approved. The enclosures referred to in the Prefect's letter have been retained in this office.
2. Any Governmental approval to this transaction which might be required cannot, of course, be given by the Italian Ministry of the Interior: only A.B. has the power to do this. On the other hand, A.B. could of course request or authorize the Ministry to act in the matter.
3. The question appears to this Sub Commission to be entirely one of Italian administrative law. It is proposed, therefore, to authorize the Ministry of the Interior to give or withhold the consent required and to communicate direct, though through channels, with the Prefect thereon. Before this step is taken, however, it is desired to know whether you or EC have any objection to it, or any other observations to make.

Subject : Sale of a communal lot in the rear of the Popular Houses.

The commune of Sanremo in order to restore the precarious financial situation of the communal treasury, burdened with liabilities for an amount in excess of five million lire, asked some time ago for authorization to sale some real estate property owned by the Commune among which there was a lot located in the rear of the popular houses for the price of Lire 2,200,000.

The Ministry of the Interior of the late Republic, by letter dated 12/10/1944 forwarded copy of the resolution taken by the "Comitato Interministeriale per la Finanza locale" dated 19/9/44 whereby authorization was given for the sale of the aforesaid lot, through a public auction, taking into account the bid of 2,200,000 lire already entered.

The Commune, while waiting for a ministerial decision, owing to the increasingly pressing necessity to obtain cash and inasmuch as it had obtained an improvement on the price from 2,200,000 to 2,500,000, by a resolution dated 28/6/44 n. 259 decided to sell said lot to Messrs. Vergano Giuseppe and Chiesa Giannina after private negotiations dealings.

Such resolution was approved by the G.P.A. (Giunta Provinciale Amministrativa at the meeting of 24/8/1944 and by the Prefectural Council under date 9/9/1944.

Inasmuch as the provision forbidding the sale through private dealings, which had been sanctioned by the aforesaid Comitato Interministeriale remained in force, this Prefecture by letter dated 7/12/44 n. 13299 forwarded a copy and the original of the Real Estate sale deed - drawn by Notary Brigida Minia - under date 19/10/944 n. 4162 for approval.

On 8/5/1945 this Prefecture, in order to comply with the solicitations of the interested parties, urged the aforesaid Ministry of the Interior to let know their decision in this matter and to return the original deed.

As up to day no reply has reached us and the settlement of this matter is more and more urgent, owing to the disastrous financial conditions of the Commune, we beg your Ministry to inform us as to the provisions it intends to adopt on the subject, taking into consideration that the Commune of Sanremo has already started proceedings with the Treasury of the Debitor Pubblico in order to obtain a mortgage for the amount of 7,900,000, which has not yet been granted.

SUBJECT : Note of interview with AV. ANDRÉO VILAS, Prefeito Regente of Imperia - on 22 July 1945

TO : Director, Local Government Sub Commission

FROM : Captain, S.I. GUMMELMAN.

1. The Prefect is a pleasant mannered person. He appears to be efficient and to know how the Prefecture should function. It is difficult to form an opinion of such a man on one short interview but I think he is lacking in drive. He leans rather heavily on the Vice Prefect Vicario. He appears younger than the general run of Prefectos.

2. The Vice Prefect Vicario Vitti. Vitti is a very good worker and the Prefect is very pleased with him and thinks a lot of him. He is a career official who came from Benvenente recently where he assisted in preparing the electoral lists. He is the only senior career official.

3. Vice Prefect Inspector. There is no career Vice Prefect Inspector but there are two "Politicians". One is Vitti's former leader of the Local Partisans and AV. Another is a local lawyer. The province has been divided between them and they are playing round the benches and paying particular attention to the preparation of the electoral lists. The Prefect says they are both good workers.

4. Other officials. There is only one Consiglieri in the Prefecture but there is another Consiglieri for the "Fondi del Culto" and he has been asked to sit on the GSA when necessary. There is one Segretario. The Prefect has written to the Ministry asking out his requirements. He would like two more Consiglieri, a Segretario and a I' Regimeiro.

5. Deputacion Provinciale was meeting regularly and was established according to the Law with 6 members and 2 suplentes.

6. G.S.A. was also functioning. The four citizen members were appointed and meetings were held with the assistance of the second Consiglieri from the "Fondi del Culto".

7. Giunta Comunale. There are 55 Communes in the Province and all have Giunta but in 23 Communes this has not been organized in office. The Prefect is examining the position and confirming them as quickly as possible. Several Communes had been occupied by the French until 10th July and this had delayed the setting up of Giunta.

8. Sindaco. Every Commune has a Sindaco regularly appointed by Decree of the Prefect.

9. Segretario Comunale. There are 74 career officials. See the following after two Communes. All Communes have the services of a Segretario and the Prefect is satisfied that the service is working reasonably well.

2. The Vice Prefect Vicario, Peral is a very good worker and the Prefect is very pleased with him and thinks a lot of him. He is a career official who came from Benevento recently where he assisted in preparing the electoral lists. He is the only senior career official.

3. Vice Prefect Inspector. There is no other Vice Prefect Inspector but there are two "Politicos". As stated previously formerly leader of the local Partisans and now a local lawyer. The province has been divided between them and they are seeing round the towns and paying particular attention to the preparation of the electoral lists. The Prefect says they are both good workers.

4. Other officials. There is only one Consigliere in the Prefecture but there is another Consigliere for the "Fondi del Culto" and he has been roped in to sit on the GSA when necessary. There is one segretario. The Prefect has written to the Ministry setting out his requirements. He would like two more Consiglieri, a segretario and a I. Regimiere.

5. Deputazione Provinciale are meeting regularly and are established according to the law with 6 members and 2 supplenti.

6. C.P. was also functioning. The four officials were appointed and meetings were held with the assistance of the second Consigliere from the "Fondi del Culto".

7. Giunta Comunale. There are 53 Communes in the Province and all have Giunte but in 23 Communes this has not been constituted in office. The Prefect is examining the position and convincing them as quickly as possible. Several Communes had been occupied by the French until 10th July and this had delayed the setting up of Giunte.

8. Sindaci. Every Comune has a Sindaco regularly appointed by Decree of the Prefect.

9. Segretario Comunale. There are 34 career officials. ²¹⁹² Looking after two Communes. All Communes have the services of a segretario and the Prefect is satisfied that the arrangement is working reasonably well.

10. Preparation of electoral lists. I had a special meeting on this subject with the Vice Prefect Vicario, and Vice Prefect Inspector and the Consigliere. As stated before the Vice Prefect Vicario has already had experience of the preparation of the lists and he seems to have everything working smoothly. The work has commenced in all Communes and he is getting the two Vice Prefect Inspectors to visit them regularly to see how it is going on. They have put in an application for a 60 day extension of time as in several Communes the records (censuses) were completely destroyed. I stressed the importance of sticking to the time-table and the Vice Prefect Vicario said that the extension might not be necessary but that they had applied to keep the schedule. He assured me that they were paying particular

attention to this work and that there would not be any avoidable delay. In Casellario Giudiziale was intact in Liguria Province but they had a lot of people born in other provinces resident in Liguria now and it would take a considerable time to get their records from all over Italy and Sicily especially as many Casellari had been destroyed. The electoral Commissions were being established soon. The Prefect had already named his nominees and the other names were being obtained.

11. The Provincial Election Commission had been set up. There was a difference of opinion between the career Vice Prefect Vicario and the Partisan Vice Prefect Inspector as to how it was functioning. The Vice Prefect Vicario was satisfied but the Vice Prefect Inspector thought it was too slow and too soft.

Major L. D. GONZALEZ - Legal Officer
on 22nd July 1953

TO : Director, Local Government Sub Commission

FROM : S. L. GONZALEZ, Captain.

1. The PC. explained that he was short of officers and had had to give priority to other functions over local Government. The supply situation for example was very difficult and he had no supply office. The legal officer was lacking after local Government administration and the preparation of the electoral lists. On the surface things are quiet in Imperia Province but the PC. says this is due to the fact that it is known that A.I.S. will soon be going. The trouble makers are therefore waiting.

2. The Prefetto Reggente Avv. Attagio VALLI is absolutely straight and honest and the PC. has a very high opinion of him. He is a Christian Democrat. He cooperates fully with A.I.S. but the PC. thinks he is too weak to carry on alone when A.I.S. goes. The Italian Government should be warned to put in a strong career Prefect as soon as A.I.S. goes.

3. Vice Prefect Vicario Dott. Emanuele PIRAL. Arrived from Benevento about four weeks ago. The PC. was not impressed with him at the first but he had got down to work well and had made himself popular with the people. He was not afraid of saying what he thought and the PC. thought he might be suitable as a Prefect for Imperia. Dott. PIRAL had been in charge of the preparation of the electoral lists in Benevento and was supervising the work here.

4. Vice Prefect Inspector. There are two non career Vice Prefect Inspectors. One AG. VALLI is a partisan leader. He is a good honest chap - one of the good partisans. The other is Paolo Manuel GIANINI a local lawyer. Both are going around the Communes checking appointments and supervising the preparation of the lists.

3. Vice Prefect Vicario Dott. ENRICO PERI. Arrived from Benevento about four weeks ago. The PC. was not impressed with him at the first but he had got down to work well and had made himself popular with the people. He was not afraid of saying what he thought and the PC. thought he might be suitable as a Prefect for Imperia. Dott. PERI had been in charge of the preparation of the electoral lists in Benevento and was supervising the work here.

A. Vice Prefect Inspector. There are two non career Vice Prefect Inspectors. One AGOSTINO VITTORIO is a partisan leader. He is a good honest chap - one of the good partisans. The other is Paolo Manuel GIROTTI a Israel lawyer. Both are going around the Common checking appointments and supervising the preparation of the lists.

5. Other officials. Are very scarce. The Project has written for more. Position is set out in Form A which was forwarded.

6. Deputacion Provincial was functioning regularly. Obtained from C.I.P. and if acceptable was approved by AG.

7. G. D. A. The four citizen members have been appointed and the ²7669a was functioning.

8. Bindaci and Giunto Councils were in all Communes.

9. Secretariat Council. Some Secretaries were looking after the Councils but all Councils were being served by Secretariat.

10. C.I.N. The PC, had not had much trouble with them. They understood their position and that they could only offer advice. He found them quite cooperative.

11. Preparation of electoral lists. The forms had all been received and delivered to Communes and the work commenced. Some of the Communes were occupied by the French until 10th July and the forms were distributed to these Communes immediately the French moved out. The Prefect has applied for an extension of time of 60 days owing to destruction of Communal records in several Communes but this application is being held up pending receipt of instructions from us. He is being urged to get the work finished as soon as possible.

The Electoral office has been set up in the Prefettura and names are being obtained for the electoral Commissions.

12. The Provincial Deputation Commission has been set up and is functioning.

13. The PC. doesn't think that the Provinces or any of the Northern Provinces should be handed back to the Italian Government for several months as the Public Safety position requires a lot of attention and he is afraid there will be trouble when AMI. goes.

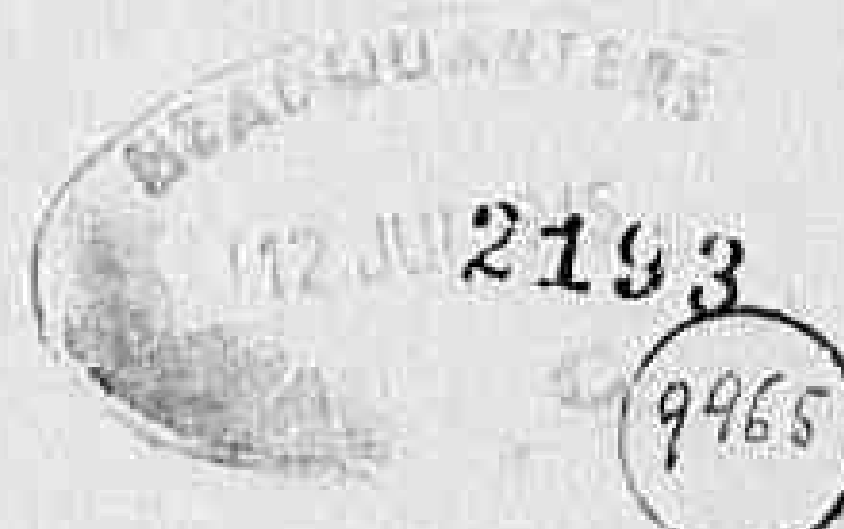
