SUBJECT : Note on interview with Dott. Pietro LIGGI - Prefetto Raugendo for  
LA SEXTA - on 1st July 1945

TO : Director, Local Government and Colonization

FROM : Captain W.I. GUNTERMAN

1. I had to wait some time before I could see the Prefect and during our interview his telephone kept ringing. He apologised for the frequent interruptions and explained that he had a general strike of workers on his hands. The Prefect appears to be a strong man and he dealt quickly and decisively with the ~~questions~~ raised by the persons who kept telephoning him.
2. Vice Prefect Vicario Lotti. Giovanni D'ALBANEDO is a career Vice Prefect and is very helpful. He was a C.I.E. candidate for the position and is not liable to be separated.
3. Vice Prefect Inspector Dott. Romano SARTORIO is a career official and is very efficient. The Prefect is going to give all the work in connection with the preparation of the electoral lists to him and would like another Vice Prefect Inspector for the ordinary duties. I said it would be very difficult to get another career official.
4. Other officials. There is one Consigliere and one primo Segretario who is acting as a Consigliere. The Prefect had been in Rome recently and had asked the Ministry for some more career officials to make up his establishment.
5. Dipartimento Provinciale was established and was functioning very well.
6. Comune Cannelli had been established in all Comunes except two. There were claims of a sort at there but the Prefect was not satisfied and was getting other nominations.
7. G.P. had been formed and was meeting.
8. Sindaci had been appointed by his decree in all Comunes.
9. Segretario Comunale. There are 20 career officials for 22 Comuni. Non career officials are in 10 Comunes while the other 12 are being looked after by the career Segretari or the neighboring comunes. The Prefect said that examinations had been held recently for Secretary and the papers returned to Rome. He hadn't received the results yet. He had given the oral portion of the examination himself and had picked out the 10 best answers and appointed them temporarily pending the official results. About 20 persons had sat for the examinations.
10. Preparation of Electoral Lists. The forms have arrived and been distributed to all comunes. He was giving the matter particular attention as he thought it of some importance. He had set up an electoral office in the prefecture and had engaged a few men to work in it.

3. Vice Prefect Inspector Dotti. Giovanni RAVAGLIO is a career official and is very efficient. The prefect is going to give all the work in connection with the preparation of the electoral lists to him and will like another Vice Prefect Inspector for the ordinary duties. I said it would be very difficult to get another career official.

4. Other officials. There is one Consigliere and one primo segretario who is acting as a Consigliere. The prefect had been in Rome recently and had named the Ministry for some more career officials to take up his establishment.

5. Department Provinciale was established and was functioning very well.

6. Comune Comunali had been established in all Jeanines except two. There were Comuni of a series there but the Prefect was not satisfied and was getting other nominations.

7. G.P.O. had been formed and was meeting.

8. Sindaci had been appointed by his decree in all Comunes.

9. Segretario Comunale. There are 20 career officials for 20 Comunes. Non career officials are in 10 Comunes while the other 10 are being looked after by the career Segretari or the neighboring commune. The prefect said that examinations had been held recently for Segretari and the papers returned to Rome. He hadn't received the results yet. He had given the oral portion of the examination himself and had picked out the 10 best answerers and appointed them temporarily pending the official results. About 20 persons had sat for the examinations.

10. Preparation of Electoral Lists. The forms have arrived and been distributed to all communes. He was giving the matter particular attention as he thought it of prime importance. He had set up an electoral office in the Prefecture and if he found any communes getting behind in the work he would send an official out to assist. The Cassellario Giudiziare had been destroyed by an explosion about a month ago.

11. Education. The Provincial Commission was functioning.

12. The prefect had been to Rome recently to get a new passport and was worried because he had not arrived yet. The present situation was very irregular and could not function efficiently on that account.

and Captain J. MULHEED Legal Officer on 12th July 1945.

1. The PG has a rather poor opinion of the prefect reagent, who was a C.L.N. nominee and who is still too much involved with them at present. 9. C.I.N. - As usual had tried to take executive action at first but their position had been made clear to them by the PG. They now only offered advice to him but they brought a lot of pressure to bear on the Prefect and were working unmercifully.

10. Preparation of electoral lists. The forms had arrived and were distributed of the lists. The Legal Officer had not yet received the forms. He was going to Regional H. Court on 13th July and would ask the Regional Legal Officer for it. The Casellario Giudiziare had been broken into and set on fire on 17th June and the records destroyed. The Prefect was going ahead and getting names for the Electoral Commission and these would be set up in good time.

11. Spurvention. The Provincial Commission had been set up and was functioning.

The Prefect was going ahead and getting names for the Electoral Commission and these would be set up in good time.

11. Preparation. The Provincial Commission had been set up and was functioning.
