SUBJECT : Giunta Comunale of Tenda, Cuneo Province 13 October 1945  
TO : The Ministry of the Interior

1. On 2 October 1945, Dott. SCANGELATO, Consigliere of the Cabinet of the Ministry, called upon this Sub Commission to make inquiry as to certain proceedings of the Giunta Comunale of Tenda. A report has now been received on the subject.

2. Upon the establishment of the Giunta immediately after liberation, it was constituted of 6 members, 3 being representative of the French-speaking element and 3 of the Italian-speaking population.

3. At a meeting of the Giunta on 26 July, a resolution was proposed that no flags other than the British and American should be flown within the Commune; an equal number of votes were given for and against this proposal. Thereupon the Provincial Officer of Allied Military Government in charge of the Commune gave directions that Allied flags would be flown and that the Italian flag could be flown as well, but that the French flag could not.

4. The 3 Assessors who voted for the resolution above-mentioned have since been removed from office and the Giunta has now been reduced from 6 to 4 members as prescribed by law.

1. Ref your letter PR/CGO/014.2 DATED 4 Oct 45, forwarding copy of HQ AG letter AG/1/10/12/LG dated 3 Oct 45, relating resolution of Giunta Comunale of TENDA calling for the Italian flag to cease to be displayed in the commune.
2. A Giunta meeting was held on the 26 Jul 45, when it was voted that no flags, except the British and American, should fly in TENDA. The voting was even by the Giunta. The MIG Prov Offr then ruled that the Allied flags would be flown and the Italian flag could be flown, but not the French flag.
3. The French Liaison Officer has a small flag, about 12" long, but very faded, flying from his office at the Hotel.
4. The whole affair arose only a fortnight after the departure of the French from the Commune and at a time when the Giunta Comunale was formed on a modified basis on the instructions of General HUME SCACO Fifth Army and consisted of 3 pro-French and 3 pro-Italians.
5. The three Assessors who voted for the resolution were pro-French and have since been removed from office. The Giunta Comunale is now legally constituted.

1. The Sindaco and C.I.N. of Ventimiglia, in conjunction with a French committee in MONACO, have prepared a petition to be submitted to A. G. the Italian and French Governments. The petition requests that an area in the Roia Valley, partly French, partly Italian, approximately 15 Km wide and 40 Km long, be made into a free economic zone.
2. Area involved:
  - a) French territory - 11 Communes, approx. 30,000 people
  - b) Italian " - 19 " , " 60,000 "
3. Petitions suggested:
  - a) Present boundary line remains intact,
  - b) sovereignty remains as is.
  - c) Italian area and French area of Zone to have separate Administrative Autonomy.
  - d) Free exchange of merchandise between each area
- (Inform)
4. Sindaco and a representative of C.I.N. of Ventimiglia came to BRIGA last evening. Sindaco of eleven Italian Communes, including Briga and Tenda, have signed. Mayor of Menton reported considering, Mayor of Sospel reported favourable.
5. Copies of petition have been given to CAO Ventimiglia. Copy to be sent to me within a few days, will forward it.
6. Movement appears peaceful, orderly and in the open. Appears to be an idea of political opportunists with an economic appeal rather than a boundary dispute.

1. Cuneo is the largest and probably the most difficult Province to administer in Italy. It has 206 communes and the roads run out like spokes of a wheel from Cuneo in the center. There are no cross roads as it is impossible to make a reasonable tour of the communes. There are only three Provincial Officers and it is very difficult for them to get around. Major Gardiner had just taken over as Acting FO the day before my visit.

2. Prefect. Avv. Guido VERRONE is the nomine of the GIA and was appointed on 1st June 1945 by A.I.F. as Prefetto Reggente. He belongs to the Liberal Party. I was not impressed by the prefect who appears to me to be a rather ineffective little man. He has little drive and seems to rely a lot on the V.P.V. On the other hand, the IC says he is honest and that there has been no trouble with the GIA while he has been in office.

3. V.P.V. Dott. Guido CIBERIO is a career official. He seems a good official and appears to be the prefect's right hand man.

4. Prefecto Munizzi is a Maggiore Gapp nothing as V.P.V.

5. Other officials. The position is as set out in Form "A". The Prefect is quite definite that he does not require any senior officials. He can fill any other vacancies locally.

6. Zeculari Provinciali. The members have not been nominated yet in spite of pressure from the IC. The Prefect promised to let the IC have the names today and said that the first meeting would take place in 10 or 12 days. I stressed the importance of this and pointed out that the GIA could not be appointed until the Deputazione met. The Prefect agreed that the appointment of the GIA would be decided at the first meeting.

7. Gigliotti Comitati were established in every commune. They had been nominated by the GIA and approved or disapproved by the Prefect as necessary.

8. Comitati were in all communes. They had been nominated by local GIA and, if approved, appointed by the Prefect's decree. A few had resigned recently and were being replaced.

9. Segretari Comunali. Every commune was being looked after by a Segretario Comunale. There were 162 career Segretari and 23 non-career ones who were all trained in law. The small communes had one Segretario looking after two Comuni.

10. Preparation of Electoral Lists. The first lot of forms had arrived and been distributed in good time and the work had commenced on the 15th July. The IC had supplied the transportation necessary for the distribution. The second lot of forms for the preparation of the sectional lists had just arrived. The IC asked the Prefect to let him know how much transport would be required, and when, and he would provide it. Most communes had already sent their lists to the

10. Preparation of Local Council Lists. The first lot of forms had arrived and IC had supplied the transportation necessary for the distribution. The second lot of forms for the preparation of the sectional lists had just arrived. The IC asked the Prefect to let him know how much transport would be required, and when, and he would provide it. Most communes had already sent their lists to the Casellari Giudiziari.

11. Extensions of time. About 13 communes had asked for extensions. He had a long discussion about this. About 20 communes had their records destroyed and these were occupied by the French until 10th July. The others wanted extensions on account of the "work involved" or the "local situation". I stated that I did not think these latter reasons would be sufficient to obtain a grant. The extensions asked for, however, were surprisingly short—10 to 15 days.

12. Canelari. Both are in good order and the records are intact. The Prefect, however, seemed to anticipate delay here as he said they had not sufficient officials and the salaries offered were not such as to attract suitable persons. The IO said that he and the H.Q. had had an interview with the procurator del Lago and they did not think there would be any delay. Incidentally, I have found that most officials in connection with the preparation of the electoral lists are much more inclined to concentrate on possible causes of delay outside their control than to strive to stick to the portions of the time-table which are solely their responsibility.

13. The Prefect has adopted a similar expedient to that described by the Deputy Director in Areacita Province. The Province has been divided into 29 Zeros and a special Inspector—one of the career Segretari Comunali—has been appointed for each zone to keep an eye on the preparation of the lists and to report to the V.P.I. when he comes round. I told the Prefect I considered this an excellent idea, especially in such a large province as Cuneo.

14. The Provincial Committee Commission is functioning. The Prefect held a meeting with the members and he and the Legal Officer are looking into the conditions of their appointment.

15. With the exception of the appointment of the Deputazione Provinciale and the G.E.A., local government appears to be functioning well in the province of Cuneo. The preparation of the electoral lists appears to be well in hand and I do not think there will be any delay in that connection. I told the H.Q. these opinions and stressed the importance of the Deputazioni and the G.E.A.
