EXTRACT FROM LOMBARDIA REGION REPORT
FOR JUNE 1945

PAVIA: The administrative machinery of the Province and its communes was greatly improved during the month. Intensive efforts were made throughout the Province to ensure maximum agricultural production. Excellent progress was made in the organization and control of transport. Food collections, especially of last year's wheat, and currently produced milk, butter and cheese were much greater than had been anticipated. Food exports were finally programmed and these exports are on a very large scale. Distribution of food within the Province was well organized, but at times motor fuel was so limited that the larger cities were down to one day's supply of flour. Leadership in the direct public welfare program is as yet inadequate. The amounts of relief extended thru the E.C.A.'s were but a small fraction of the needs, particularly of refugees, the families of internees, and the families of those in confinement. Many projects for public works were being presented and approved, but the Genio Civile estimated that there were less than two hundred men actually working for contractors at the end of the month.

1. I stepped off at Pavia on my way back to Milano, at the request of Capt. Newfeld, Col. Polotti's Executive Officer, particularly to ascertain the personnel needs of the Prefettura.

2. The Prefect, Prof. BORDANI, is a CIN designee who was Professor of Economics at the University of Genova and is a very intelligent man. The IC said he was a very capable administrator, but is terribly over-worked, because of the lack of trained officials in the Prefettura. He is a young man, apparently very much interested in the good administration of his province and very eager to do all he can. He seemed to have a healthy, tolerant political outlook.

3. There is urgent need for a Vice Prefect and a Capo di Gabinetto. There is a person acting as Vice Prefect but he is a political man designated by the CIN without any knowledge of government administration. I assured the IC and Prefect that on my return to Rome I would immediately set the wheels going to secure a trained Vice Prefect Inspector and Consigliere to act as Capo di Gabinetto.

4. I then discussed the problems involved in the compilation of electoral lists. The names of nominees for Deputazioni Provinciali have been received. It is expected that the body will be appointed within the week.

5. All the communes have Segretari Communi, most of them career. There are Giunta and Sindaci in all the communes also. However, in the case of the Giunta, they do not conform in size to the law. The Prefect is in the process of regularizing them and having them approved by the IC. Most of the Sindaci have already been approved by the IC. All were found in office, having been appointed by the CIN when ANI took over. Changes are gradually being made. The Prefect and the IC make tours of the communes in order to ascertain problems. With the shortage of staff, the IC is hard put to it in effecting a careful scrutiny of selections of the CIN for the various communal offices. IC said he was so anxious to have the two career officials as quickly as possible that if we would signal him when they are ready to leave, he will send a vehicle for them.

6. Forms showing the personnel as well as the local government situation were left to be completed and forwarded to this HQ.
