SUBJECT : Preparation of Electoral Lists;
Lack of Transport - Province of SONDRIO

TO : RC LOMBARDIA (Copy to RC SONDRIO)

1. The Prefect of SONDRIO, in his report dated 23 Oct 45, makes the following statement:

"Inspections were made using chance means such as bicycle or walking as we have no adequate transport. As the bad season is coming we shall not be able to make frequent inspections except in those Communes which can be reached by train".

2. It is disturbing to find, at this stage, that the Prefect is unable to perform a most important function in the preparation of Electoral List. May RC Sondrio please be asked to urge the Prefect to requisition the necessary transport for the inspection of all communes in order that the proper control and assistance may be given the preparation of the Electoral Lists. There must be no question of a possible delay in the holding of elections because a few small communes have failed to complete their lists.

SUBJECT: Survey of Sondrio Province - 19 July 1945

1. The Prefect said that he was in need of a Vice Prefect Inspector, 2 Consiglieri and 2 segretari. I informed him that arrangements already had been made to dispatch a Vice Prefect Inspector and outlined the procedure for securing personnel below that grade. The Provincial Commissioner characterized the Prefect CONTI as a very good man, but who has a disproportionate view as to what is important. The Vice Prefect Vicario has the legal grade of Vice Prefect Inspector and is a typical career functionary, but seems to be quite energetic and interested in his work. He has set up the Electoral Office, to which he has assigned Dott. CARLUCCI and Dott. MANZONI, both Vice segretari. Dott. CARLUCCI, although a non-career recent appointee, impressed me as being a capable official. The organization of the Prefettura reveals a serious lack of trained officials. In fact, the Vice Prefect Vicario and the Capo di Gabinetto are the only trained men on the administrative side. Consiglieri Dott. MANZONI does not report to the office--he is subject to suspension. The Prefettura is also weak on the accountancy side. The Rag. Capo (US 40) is old and ill and Dott. CONTI, ragioniere, is not well also. This lack of Consiglieri explains why the CPA has not been able to be properly constituted, although the 4 citizen members have been appointed.

2. The Delegazione Provinciale has been established. In the 78 Communes, Giunta Comunale and Sindaci are functioning. All of them have been confirmed "en bloc" by the E., but not all have received formal notice of their appointment by the Prefect. The Prefect was urged to do this immediately. All of the Communes are covered in whole or part by Segretari Comunali. There is a lack, however, of some trained officials. Some instructions have been sent to 2458 Communes, but not all the electoral material has been distributed as yet. I urged the necessity of distributing all the material immediately and not to await responses from the Communes as to what they need.

3. Electoral Commissions have not been established as yet. There are 5 "mandamenti" in the province.

4. Almost all the population registers are intact, but 3 Communes have reported that they are destroyed. The records in the Cassellari Giudiziali have not been destroyed. Relations with the CLN are outwardly good, although the PC says there may be some undercover work going on. Incidentally, I noticed that the stamp of the seal of the Prefettura of Sondrio had in its center a five-pointed star with the initials "C.L.N." inside the star. The PC said that he had given definite instructions that the CLN initials be obliterated from the stamp and repeated his order to the Capo di Gabinetto.

All of the Communes are covered in whole or part by Segretari Comunali. There is a lack, however, of some trained officials. Some instructions have been sent to 2458 Communes, but not all the electoral material has been distributed as yet. I urged the necessity of distributing all the material immediately and not to await responses from the Communes as to what they need.

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5. The Prefect seems to be a capable and efficient official, but seemed to lack interest in the matter of compiling election lists. This task had been delegated to the Vice Prefect as it has in other provinces. In the case of this province, however, the Prefect took part in our conference, but left soon after to attend another meeting and never returned. The Provincial Commissioner stressed the importance of the job of preparing the election registers as a No. 1 task. I suggested that he speak to the Prefect personally since the latter was not present when the IC made his remarks.

EXTRACT FROM LOMBARDIA REGION REPORT
FOR JUNE 1945

SONDRIO: A.M.G. supplies arriving fairly steadily. Public health is good. Iodised salt and powdered milk needed badly.

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
