1. The PC characterized the Prefetto Reggente, Avv. Tosi, as an excellent man who is cooperative, loyal and energetic. He is a prominent lawyer who had been nominated by the CIN as Prefect. He is independently wealthy; in fact, he turns over his salary as Prefect to charity. The PC said that Tosi does not care to remain as Prefect and wants to return to his law practice. He will stay in the position, however, as long as AMI is there, but wants to give up the job as soon as AMI can release him. Major Warren said that he should like to have Tosi replaced by a career Prefect about two weeks before the territory is turned over, in order that Tosi be relieved of his job before AMI actually pulls out.
2. The relationship between AMI and the CIN is very good. All the Communes have received the electoral material that had been sent out to the provinces. The Cancellieri Giudiziali in the province are intact.
3. No Rappresentanze Provinciale has been established as yet, although there is a President of the Provincial Administration who is entitled "Commissario Straordinario". The latter appointed the 4 citizen members of the GIN. I informed the Prefect and PC that it was imperative that the Rappresentanze Provinciale be established immediately and that it nominate the 4 citizen members of the GIN. The Prefect said that he has asked for names from the CIN; none have been forthcoming. However, he assured me that the Rappresentanze Provinciale would be established this week. Thereafter, the 4 citizen members of the GIN would be confirmed by the Rappresentanze.
4. There are 4 "mandamenti" in the province. The Prefect expects to establish 6 Electoral Commissions and 4 Sub-Commissions.
5. An Electoral Office has been set up in active charge of Consigliere CERLINI, supervised by Vice Prefect Vicario JOLICI. The population registers are in good shape, and in fact no extensions of the time-limits are expected to be filed. 2463
6. All of the 116 Communes in the Province are covered by Segretari Communi. The Vice Prefect JOLICI has sent out a questionnaire to them dealing with the position as to the completion of election registers.

The letter appointed the 4 citizen members of the CIN. I informed the Prefect and PC that it was imperative that the Deputazioni Provinciale be established immediately and that it nominate the 4 citizen members of the CIN. The Prefect said that he has asked for names from the CIN; none have been forthcoming. However, he assured me that the Deputazioni Provinciale would be established this week. 5. An Electoral Office has been set up in active charge of Consigliere GERLINI, supervised by Vices Prefect Viesrio JXX. The population registers are in good shape, and in fact no extensions of the time-limits are expected to be filed. 248 1/2
6. All of the 116 Communes in the Province are covered by Segretari Comunal. The Vices Prefect JXX has sent out a questionnaire to them dealing with the position as to the compilation of election registers.
7. The first report on the status of the election registers has been prepared by the Prefect and will be forwarded through channels to this office and thence to the Ministry of the Interior.
8. 85 Sindaci have been formally appointed. The remaining 31 have not as yet been formally installed. I urged that this be done immediately, perhaps by an order appointing them "en bloc". Substitutions might be made thereafter. I proposed upon the Prefect the desirability of having all persons who participated in the compilation of the lists legally installed in order to obviate the possibility of any technical objections to the validity of the lists being raised. The situation with regard to the appointment of Giunta Comunale is the same as that with regard to the Sindaci, namely 85 have been formally appointed--31 remain to be confirmed in office.

FOR JUNE 1945

VARESE: Local government continues to function well. The Prefect has shown great courage and has been exceptionally loyal to AMG, although he threatened to resign because of the interference of CLN. This Prefect was originally appointed by CLN prior to our arrival, however, they have now turned against him because he will not always follow their advice. A new manager of the Ufficio Trasporti has been appointed, and things seem to be going well in this division. However, tires are badly needed, and they have been working under great handicap for lack of petrol.
