Notes for use of Major A. R. Thackrah

I. So-called theories or principles of fascism, as applied to local government

- a. s. doctrine of leadership - which really is in fact dictatorship.
" " corporative state - which is in fact compulsory regimentation of labour.

II. How were fascist principles applied to local government?

- (a) by abolishing all the former democratic, elected bodies;
(b) by substituting a single man with sole power to rule the *locality*;
(c) by setting up local councils which were:-
(i) constituted on a cooperative basis; and
(ii) purely cumulative.

III. Short Description of Fascist system

(a) in the Commune

- (i) The Podesta - substituted for the former sindaco - new name implies "power", the old one "election".
Podesta was appointed by R.D. - could be suspended by Prefect - removed by R.D. - no appeal allowed.
(ii) The Consulta - fascist law fixed minimum and maximum numbers according to population of commune. Within these limits Prefect fixed actual number of Consulta and decided which syndical associations should nominate Consultative and how many each association should name. Thus prefect had great influence over constitution of Consulta.
Consulta had no powers - merely consultative.
On more important matters, specified by law, Podesta was required to take the opinion of Consulta.
In other cases, he might refer to Consulta if he chose.
In no case was Podesta bound by advice of Consulta

- (b) in the Province
 - (i) The Preside - substituted for former Presidente - nominated and removable by R.D. - could be suspended by Prefect.
 - (ii) The Rettorato - numbered 4 to 8 according to size of province - appointed and removed by Decree of Minister of Interior. Rettorato differs from Consulta, in that definite powers conferred on it over major questions of provincial administration BUT Preside had power to act in cases of urgency.

(c) The Giunta Provinciale Amministrativa

- (i) Mention very briefly place of G.P.A. in local government system.
- (ii) Fascists
 - Inspector, Intendente di Finanza and Ragioniere Capo; bureaucrats thus outnumbered citizen members.
- (iii) Citizen members, instead of being elected, were nominated by Secretary of N.P.F.

IV. How did the fascist system work out?

- (a) The holders of all local government offices - Podesta, Consultori, Pretori, Rettori - were appointed from above. In practice, they were all nominees of P.N.F.
- (b) There was no real representation of the people. The Consulta and Rettorati was a mere blind. They were all good fascists and in practice, exercised no effective power.
- (c) The entrusting of the administration to one man - the Podesta and the Pretore - led to gross corruption and favouritism.

V. It is one of the primary functions of AMG to abolish all these offices - Podesta, Consulta, Pretore, Rettorato - and to see that the titles are no longer used. To continue to use the term, e.g., Podesta, implies to the Italians that the old, rotten fascist methods are also being continued.

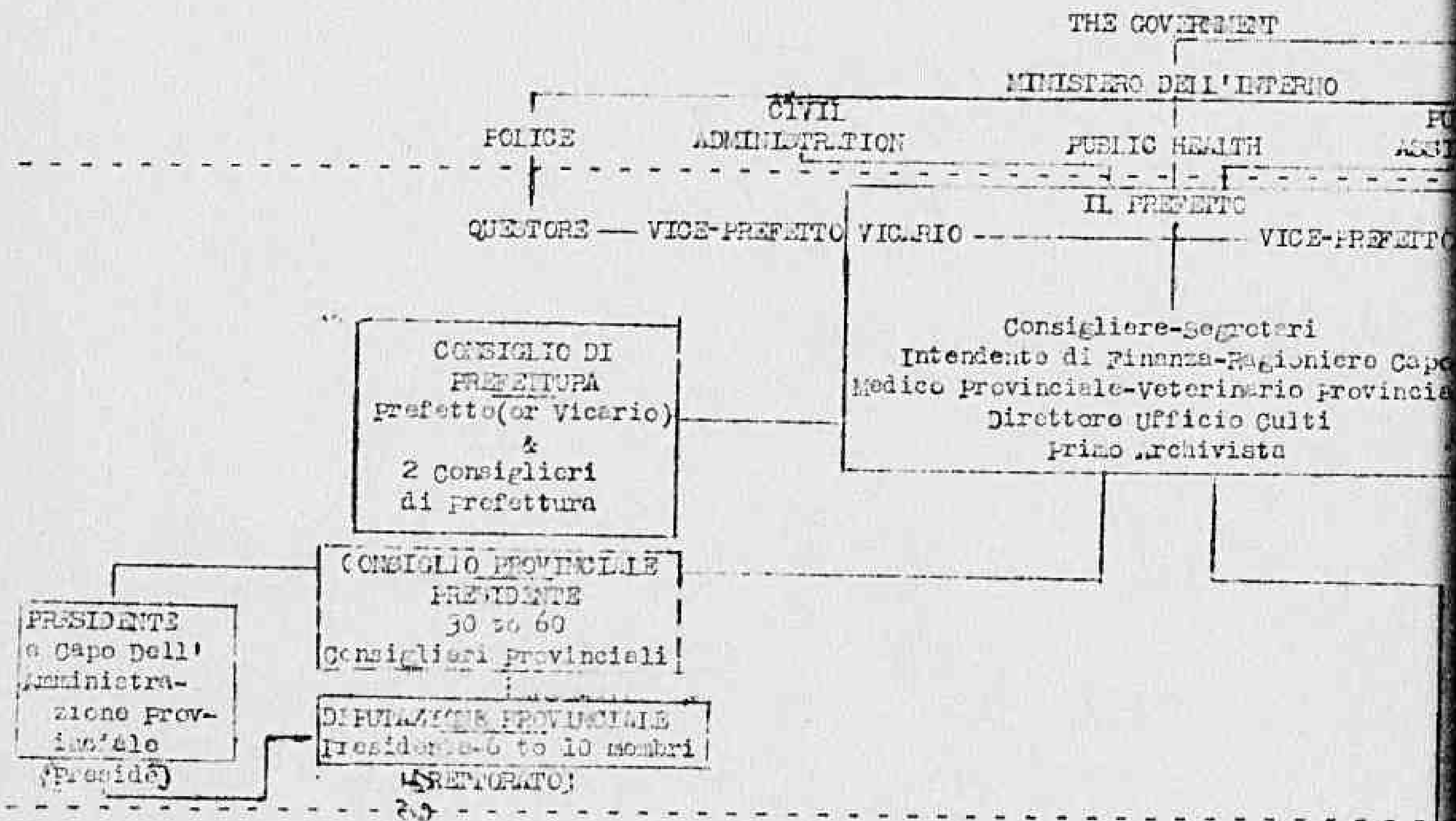

CHART OF ITALIAN LOCAL GOVERNMENT



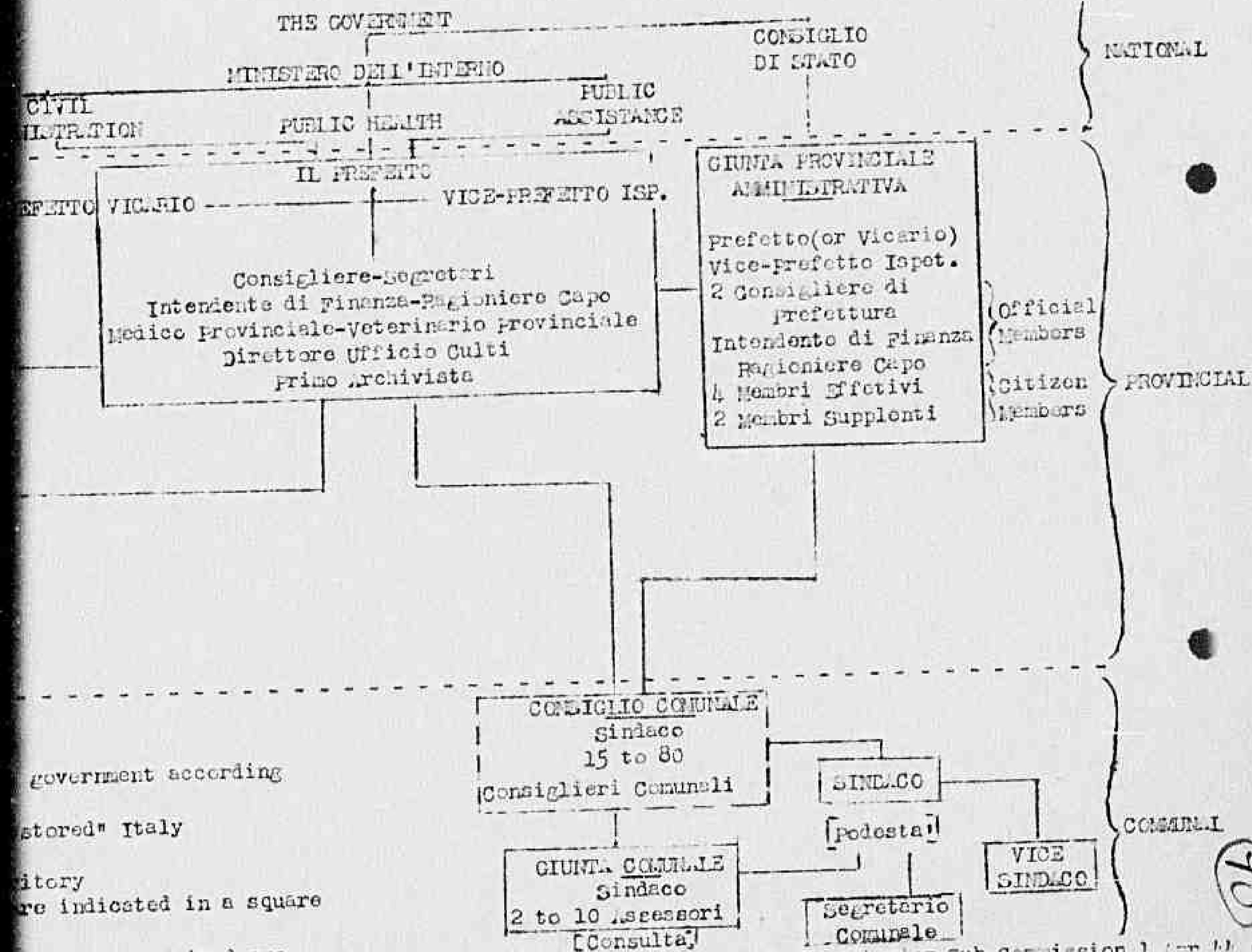

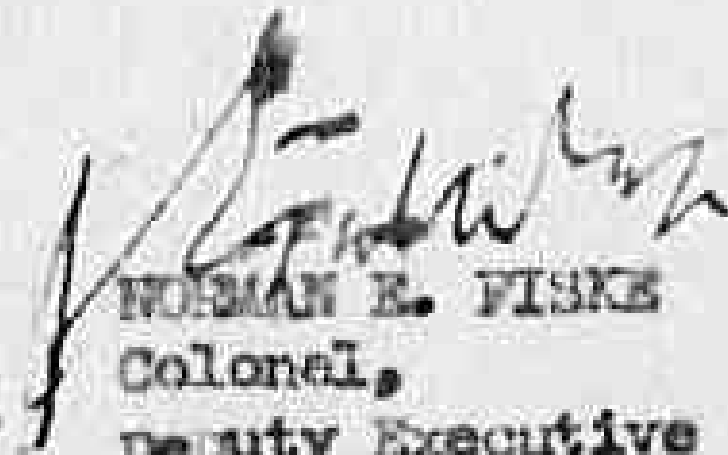

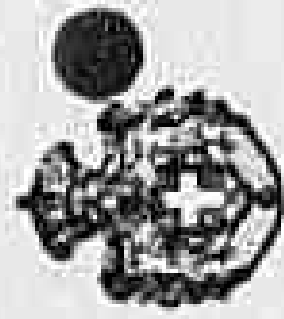
