SUBJECT: APERLO, Luigi

TO : RC, Region III

1. As requested by Lt Col The Lord Forrester, my Staff Officer, today interviewed Dr. Calenga, Secretary to the Minister of the Interior of the Italian Government to obtain available information regarding the above individual, whose name is understood to have been proposed by the Italian Government for appointment to the position of Prefect of Naples.

2. I append the information obtained:

a. Aperlo, who was born in Sardinia, and whose age they think is between 45 and 50, was a junior official of the Ministry of Interior (on the administrative side) until he left, some 15 years ago.

b. After leaving government employment, he entered into an electrical business in Naples, in which he succeeded, and established himself in a good business position. He is said to be a wealthy man.

c. The Ministry of Interior here, did not make the suggestion, and they have only learned about it informally.

d. It is said that the proposal for Aperlo's appointment emanated from Dr. Philipson, the President of the Council of Ministers. It is further understood by the Ministry, that Aperlo was sounded with regard to the proposal and is reluctant to assume the office, if, indeed, he did not, in fact, reject the offer.

3. The foregoing scanty information is all that can be obtained for the reason that the Ministry have no official knowledge of the matter and no further details. It is stated, however, that Aperlo is "a good man".

4. I have no particulars of his exact address other than the belief that he resides, and is, in Naples.
