The Prefect of Salerno has pointed out to the Ministry what/the difficulties of this office because of the lack of personnel of 1st category, difficulties which will augment with the transfer of dott. Gabriele SANTORO, appointed, as you already know to the Prefecture of Ancona.

to
The same Prefect has therefore asked the Ministry/ substitute as soon as possible the above official, who carried out at the Prefecture inspective functions.

The Ministry deems advisable to employ at the Prefecture in question the Vice Prefect dott. Emilio Petrocelli who is included in the list of officials of group A) at disposition, transmitted with a letter of the 18th of January, same file number, who is not capable of giving useful service in uncomfortable residence.

The proposal adapts itself, moreover, to the criterium that we have already explained, of using in the Prefectures under the jurisdiction of the Italian Government those elements which are not approved by the Commission for the provinces under the administration of the Allied Military Authorities, putting, at the same time, at the disposition of the Allied Commission an equal number of officials which we can recuperate in the Prefectures which have been handed over to the Italian Government.

The dott. Petrocelli, would substitute in that case, at the Prefecture of Salerno dott. Santoro who has been put at the disposition of the Ministry to be employed in a province still under the jurisdiction of the Allied Military Government.

SUBJECT: Interview with MASTROBUONO, Gaetano.

DATE : 14 November 1944

1. MASTROBUONO called upon me and indicated that BERRITI had spoken to him and instructed him to come in to see me. He said he was quite interested in the job, that he had no personal ties which would keep him confined to Rome, and that he had many friends among the Allies and felt honored to have the opportunity of cooperating with them.
2. I discussed the nature of the position with him and gave him a few samples of the report that we would like to have on the condition of local government in the provinces he visited. I indicated that although he would be working directly for the Italian Government, still we would take a great interest in the results of his inspections. I indicated that he was to call upon the Regional and Provincial Commissioners, whose assistance he would certainly receive.
3. MASTROBUONO impressed me as a person who would take to his job with enthusiasm because of his familiarity with the system of local government and his interest in the establishment of democratic bodies.

SUBJECT: Interview with H.E. BERNINI regarding the position of Prefect of Salerno and that of Inspector General.

DATE : 14 November 1944.

(also present: Cav. CASERA)

1. I took up with BERNINI the proposal to appoint MASCOLO as Prefect of Salerno. I explained that I sympathized with the desirability of having a person of competence in Salerno, especially since the latter knew and was known in the Province. However, what disturbed me was the fact that the office of Inspector General would again be vacant. I mentioned that Col. Spicer had attached great importance to the position and would be very disappointed to know that the second nominee never actually got on the job of inspecting the southern Province and returning reports about them. He wondered whether they viewed the position as one of importance at all.
2. I pointed out that it was inadvisable to keep changing the incumbents in this job, but that it was desirable to find somebody who could hold the position for a relatively long period of time.
3. BERNINI agreed that it was a desirable thing to keep one person in the position and then asked what we thought about RAYONE. He said that RAYONE was a much more capable man than MASCOLO. I said I agreed with him there, but that I doubted whether RAYONE would be available for some months in view of his concern over his family and his own health--conditions for both having been rather bad during the past year. BERNINI stated that he believed I was right and said that he thinks he has a man who would meet all the requirements. This person, he said, had been approved by us for promotion from Vice Prefect to Prefect and since he was a bachelor, he did not have the personal worry which would be possessed by a person whose job took him away from home for long periods of time. Besides, this man possessed an enthusiasm for such a job. This person's name was ANTONIOBINO, Costano. I suggested that ANTONIOBINO come in to see us so that I could judge him for myself.
4. I told BERNINI that the Allied Commission would give its consent to the appointment of MASCOLO as Prefect of Salerno if we had the assurance that ANTONIOBINO, if acceptable, would be kept on this job of Inspector General for a reasonably long period of time. BERNINI assured me that that would be so. I then asked BERNINI to send in the formal nomination of ANTONIOBINO for the position of Inspector General, and we would reply both to that proposal as well as the one involving MASCOLO as Prefect of Salerno.

SUBJECT: Interview with FAYONE, TOMASO.

DATE : 13 November 1944

1. He lives in Florence now--has no home and lives in a yard as a refugee. He intends to take his family to Rome, and is looking for a home.
2. Put at disposition by Ministry--as Ispettore Generale--would involve inspection of prov. also.
3. His health is not good--was imprisoned and in hiding for a long time. He would not be able to start duties for some months--must bring his family down, etc.
4. Prefers a province in the south, but will go where ordered by the Ministry. He wants to return to Rome and bring back his family.
5. He was dismissed by the Republican Government. Escaped from Trento to Florence--refused to collaborate with Germans--arrested by Fascists and put in jail.

IMPRESSIONS:

6. A seriously minded man--apparently one who has suffered. He had a worried look, apparently due to his concern for his family. Seems honest and straight-forward in the presentation of his views.
7. Apparently he is not to succeed MASCOLO as Ispettore Generale with view of inspecting prov. and comm.

SUBJECT: Interview- Ministry of Interior.

DATE : 11 November 1944 - 1030 hours

PRESENT: H. E. BERGUTI
Gov. CAMERA
Capt. Williams

1. I referred to the Ministry's proposal to appoint MASCOLO to be Prefect of Salerno and explained our feeling about the proposal and the terms in Minute No. 3. BERGUTI said they were particularly anxious to send MASCOLO who was well-known in the neighborhood and thought highly of, both by the political parties and by people generally. For a few months before the appointment of INGROSSO to be Sindaco of Naples, he had been Vice Commissario Prefettizio of the city (the Commissario being SOLIMENA) and had done very well. He was known to PALERMO, the Under Secretary for War and BERGAMI, the Under Secretary for Alimentation (Ministry of Interior)--both Neapolitans--who had a high opinion of him. He was known in Salerno as having been Director General, Public Health, when the Government was there.
2. As regards his being one of the Prefects held in reserve for the north, BERGUTI suggested one PAVONE to replace him. We do not know this Prefect: but BERGUTI spoke very highly of him, both for his anti-fascism and efficiency. According to BERGUTI, he was imprisoned by the Germans at Regina Coeli, where he laid 15 days under sentence of death before managing to escape. He has just been completely cleared of espionage charges by the Commission.
3. BERGUTI demurred to the suggestion that MASCOLO should be sent to Salerno on the understanding that we could pull him out for the north later, and on the assumption that it would only take him two or three months to put the administration on the right track again. He agreed that it would not take very long for MASCOLO to set things going again: but he said Salerno was a particularly difficult province and if PAVONE was acceptable to us, it could not matter whether we had him or MASCOLO. He also said that the double move--first to Salerno and then to the north--would be very inconvenient for MASCOLO's family.
4. As to MASCOLO being Prefetto Ispettore, BERGUTI's attitude was that he had been one of those reserved for the north before being appointed to this post: that if we could agree to one of our northern Prefects being Prefetto Ispettore, surely we could agree to his going to Salerno.
5. He arranged that PAVONE should come and see us on Monday morning, 13 November, and that CAMERA should send us the usual biographical particulars of him today--and that we would consider the proposal further after we had made the acquaintance of PAVONE when we would either write the Ministry or see BERGUTI again.

6. My impression is that BERRUTI does not attach much importance to the position of Prefetto Ispettore. He does, however, attach the greatest importance to getting MASCOLO personally to Salerno. In view of this and subject to PAVONE being acceptable, I don't think we can press our objections further. It is the Italian Government's territory, after all: and it is we who have been pressing for VOLPE's replacement. PAVONE will have to be screened, of course.

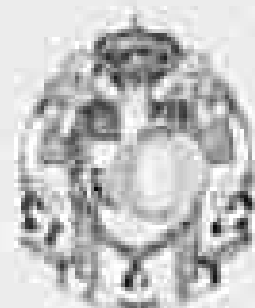
Referring to the above letter, the Ministry agrees with this Commission in deeming it necessary to appoint in Salerno a young and active Prefect.

3. The economic life of this Province, and particularly the food situation, is not a happy one. The agencies concerned, CONSORZIO, UFFICIO, SUPPLI and Consiglio della economia obviously lack co-ordination and control. When the suggestion is made that these domestic problems be presented to the Prefecture, the answer invariably results in a shrug of the shoulders. The hopelessness is only too apparent.
4. Since the formation of Salerno Zone on 28th August 44, the Prefect has made no attempt to establish any kind of liaison. At present the Prefect is enjoying a leave of a fortnight at a time when, it is the considered opinion of this Headquarters, all of his time and energy should be devoted to the welfare of the people and the re-establishment of the economic life of this important Province. Further be proceeded on this leave of absence without a word of warning to A.C.C. This information was ascertained purely by accident.

5. It can be stated without fear of contradiction that the Prefect has visited very few, if any, of the 145 Communes to ascertain for himself the actual living conditions of his eight hundred thousand people.

With the exception of signing decrees which are prepared by subordinate officials, the Prefecture have little or no knowledge of the success (or lack of) of the grain and potato schemes. The indifference, lack of serious interest and the loose control over the whole situation is appalling.

6. Under the existing conditions, the task of turning over to the Italian officials the responsibility of local Government, is well nigh impossible and certainly sufficient to give great concern for the welfare of the common people.

Therefore it is strongly recommended that the present Prefect be immediately replaced by a younger and more energetic man. It may be less disturbing if the Vice Prefect, Cav. Uff. MANCINI Dott. Antonio, be appointed Prefect for the Province. Cav. MANCINI is a career official of long standing, is 51 years of age and it is felt will be a stronger personality which is very urgently needed at present.
