"With regard to this, at next Thursday's Council of Ministers, I shall give definite orders to the effect that no government appointment be made without previous agreement with the Commission".

2. The Chief Commissioner's letter of 13 March to Marshal Badoglio had contained the following relevant amplification:

"Usually, I should be glad if you will impress upon all the members of your government that they should, in turn, consult the appropriate authorities in the Allied Control Commission before making any senior appointments in their own departments either at the seat of the Italian Government or in those provinces under Italian jurisdiction".

3. I attach a schedule of the senior appointments referred to which were considered by the Vice President, Administrative Section, to be regarded as senior appointments.

4. I should be grateful if you will bring to the notice of the appropriate sub-Commission should there be departure from this agreement.

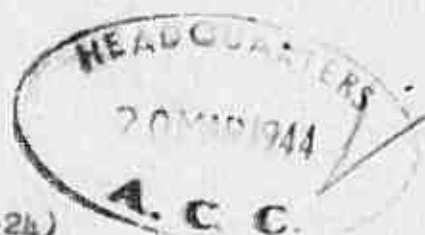
