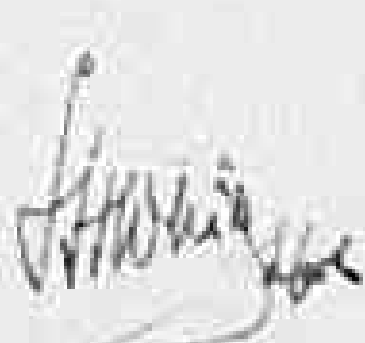
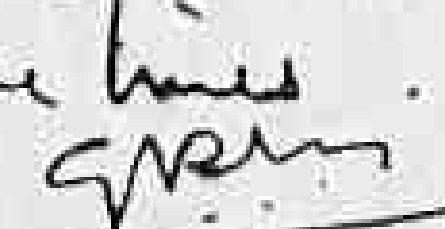

SUBJECT : Note of Interview - Naples Prefettura.

DATE : 8 February 1945

PRESENT : Col. Simson, Zone Commissioner, Naples
Major R.R. Temple, Local Government S/C.

1. I informed Col. Simson that my visit was in the nature of a courtesy call since I was making a formal call on the Regional Commissioner, pursuant to the Chief Commissioner's orders and that I wished to present the compliments of Col. Spicer, and talk generally of local government matters.
2. Col. Simson spoke in general about the fact that not enough opportunity is given to the Italian to run their own show--there is too much meddling on the part of Military Government officers. He said he preferred to let them take the initiative and step in when things just don't go right.
3. The new Sindaco--FREGANIELLO--is all right, but although he doesn't know it, he is really a puppet for AMG. Col. Simson did not think very much of the Prefect of Naples--SELVAGGI--and he said he can't make a decision without being constantly driven to do so. He persists in postponing action on a matter. He has a brilliant academic mind, but straddles things because he wished to avoid displeasing any side. Col. Simson thinks that SELVAGGI is planning to continue his governmental career in a foreign post as ambassador to some country and consequently he is discreet in his handling of governmental matters. Col. Simson himself gets along very well with SELVAGGI, but if the Allied Commission didn't take an active part in the management of the province, it would fall apart due to SELVAGGI's procrastinations.
4. Col. Simson is strongly in favor of local elections because it would give a definite basis for representation in the various Giunte. He does not anticipate unusual disorders. The compilation of election registers in Naples was completed in December while the Commissario Prefettizio was in office. He said, however, with the extension of the right to vote to women revisions are being made.
5. So far as the other provinces in the Zone are concerned, he said they can really run by themselves. The situation there is pretty good.
6. He thanked me very much for coming in to talk with him and asked me to present his compliments to Col. Spicer.

1. The Administrative Section A.C.C. Headquarters has brought to our attention a copy of a letter No. 2234 dated 1 August 1944 from the Minister of the Interior to the Interior Sub-Commission on the subject of the promotion of Avv. Francesco Selvaggi to Prefect First Class.

2. The Admin. Section has also sent us a copy of Administrative Order, Region III, No. 15 dated 14 July 1944 by which you announce this promotion.

3. We do not have any record of your having submitted to this Headquarters your proposal to promote Mr. Selvaggi.

4. Appointments to a particular grade and promotion to a higher one are made in accordance with Italian law, which is the cause of the enquiry of the Italian Minister of the Interior to this Headquarters about this promotion.

5. It is requested, therefore, that you inform us of your reasons for having issued such an order.

1. I enclose a copy of the Minister of Interior's letter no. 2234 dated 1 August to Interior Sub-Commission, together with copy of the Order of RD, Region III, therein mentioned. Copies of English translation of both documents are also annexed.

2. You will observe that the Order purports to promote avv. BELVAGGI to Grade III in the Italian Civil Service. This is not only contrary to international law and ultra vires the Allied Control Commission: it is contrary to the understanding in such matters between the Italian Government and the Commission, and to Executive Memorandum No. 12 (Revised edition of 12th June 1944).

3. The Order places this Section and particularly the Interior Sub-Commission (which negotiated with the Italian Government the agreement as to the use of the title "Prefetto Reggente") in an embarrassing position and gives the Italian Government just cause for complaint against the Allied Control Commission.

4. You will observe from Sections 1(b) of the Order that it is to cease to have effect when the Province of Naples ceases wholly or in part to be under Allied Military Government. As the major part of the Province was transferred to the Italian Government's control on 20th July, the Order ceased to have effect on that date. I should nevertheless have been prepared to recommend that the Order ought to be rescinded, in order to clear the Commission with the Italian Government. To do so, however, would raise difficult questions of law as to the power of the Commission and its officers to make even rescinding Orders after the transfer of territory on 20th July.

5. I propose, with your concurrence, to inform the Italian Government that the Order is not legally effective and that the Commission will treat it as never having been made. I also propose - and again with your concurrence - to cause an enquiry to be made of the Regional Commissioner as to his reasons for issuing such an Order.
